**PROJECT ADDRESS:** BUILDING 624 – West Field Road, San Francisco, California 94128

### **DESIGN CONCEPT**

The proposed airport building 624 will be used as a maintenance garage with supporting administration spaces. Although the function of the building itself is utilitarian, the building design does not need to look simplistic to reflect its program. The concept is to utilize and create a pre-engineered building which also contributes to the surrounding neighborhood context and creates intrigue towards the site. We propose to use landscaping and differentiating materials to compose a textural, alive and appealing pedestrian experience. In order to acknowledge the location of the building which is situated on the air operations side and also the landside of the airport, we looked to create a form which alludes to the idea of flight in the form of a butterfly-life roof structure. To create a sensation of floating we used ribbon windows surrounding the building to “lift” the roof from the main building. To contribute to a cohesive campus style setting we used certain references from Building 632 which is the newest building next to the proposed site. The signage, though different in color from Building 632 will be the same design. The materials proposed for this building are familiar with the airport and compatible with the surrounding buildings.
