The Qualification Panel reviewed a total of 168 submissions from artists that responded to the Office of the Bill Graham Civic Auditorium Request for Qualifications. "Yes/No" majority votes based on the two criteria of Artistic Excellence and Appropriate to Project Goals yielded 7 artists to move to be presented to the Artist Selection Panel for further review.

PROCESS

Round One:

Arts Commission staff presented the qualifications of 7 artists selected by the Qualification Panel. The Artist Selection Panel discussed the qualifications of the semi-finalists and scored each artist on the following criteria (1= low score):

- Artistic Excellence (1-10)
- Appropriate to Project Goals (1-10)

Round Two voting yielded three finalists to recommend to the Arts Commission.

RESULTS:

The following artists received the three highest ranks for the sculpture opportunity:

Joseph Kosuth 97 James Carpenter 90 Ned Kahn 85
