TITLE: San Francisco International Airport, Terminal 1 Redevelopment, Clerestory Art Glass opportunity

Date: April 11, 2017



PROJECT OUTLINE: The project is a replacement terminal and concourse facility for San Francisco International Airport Terminal 1 including Boarding Area B and C. The end of the terminal opens to a large open 'end of pier' with generous seating, numerous cafés and restaurants, and approx. 6 gate lounges. The ceiling is sculpted architecturally with recessed lighting, which supports the glass clerestory. The glass clerestory composes 750 square feet of glass (10' height x 750' length column to column) and surrounds 3 sides of the space. The clerestory has been decided upon for a public art opportunity.

PROJECT GOALS:

- Activate the abundant light in the space
- Add color and movement to the space
- Highlight the architecture of the terminal

BUDGET:

The overarching project budget is \$810,000. The artist’s contract budget will be \$700,000. The SFAC will install the artwork under a separate contract for approx. \$100,000. There is \$10,000 of other project related costs.
