Project Title: *SF New City Atlas*

Project Description: Lauren Bartone creates images that borrow from topography, city life, and materials of the everyday. Her poster series is inspired by the public life of Market Street in San Francisco; both real and utopic. Over several months in 2015, Bartone collected detritus from Market Street and its surrounds. Transforming the materials of everyday life, the artist has created interpretive maps that explore a selection of issues tied to social experiences in the city: the workplace, transportation, public spaces, cultural life, our desires, and social needs.

Poster Titles and Text:

The Office This interpretive map of San Francisco uses materials found along Market Street. Receipts, workplace memos, name tags and other office space detritus represent the presence of labor and commerce in the area.

Getting There This interpretive map of San Francisco uses materials found along Market Street. Collaged Muni transfers are layered with a 1948 transportation plan that would have transformed large parts of downtown into a designated parking area. This map reimagines that area as a bicycle zone.

Culture Club This interpretive map of San Francisco uses materials found along Market Street. Museum passes, cultural guides, and gallery ephemera convey the rich and diverse array of arts and culture within the Market Street area.

Places We Share This interpretive map of San Francisco uses materials found along Market Street. Contemporary guides to shared public sites and references to unrealized historic plans for public space highlight our desire for a shared public realm to be at the center of a vibrant urban life.

A Friend in Need This interpretive map of San Francisco uses materials found along Market Street. Handwritten notes for help, social service agency flyers, and evidence of life on the street explore the ways in which our social needs become visible.

Best Wishes This interpretive map of San Francisco uses materials found along Market Street. Discarded lottery tickets, candy wrappers and cigarette boxes are transformed to reveal the way society fulfills its cravings and desires.

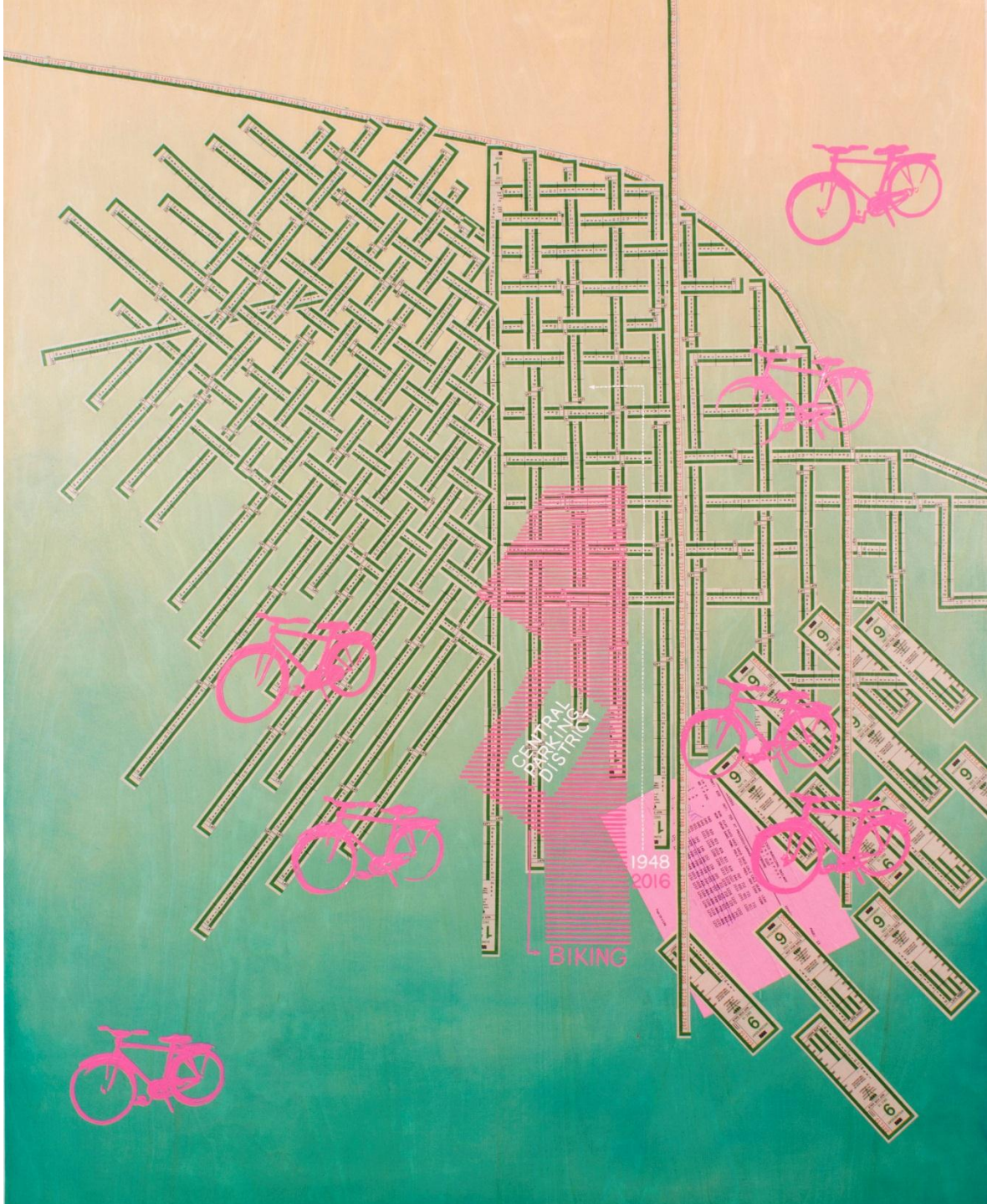
