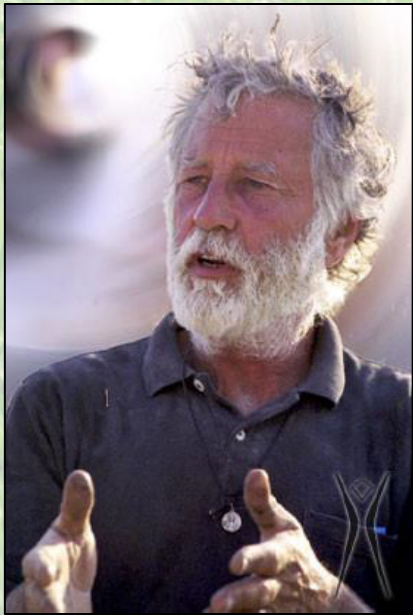


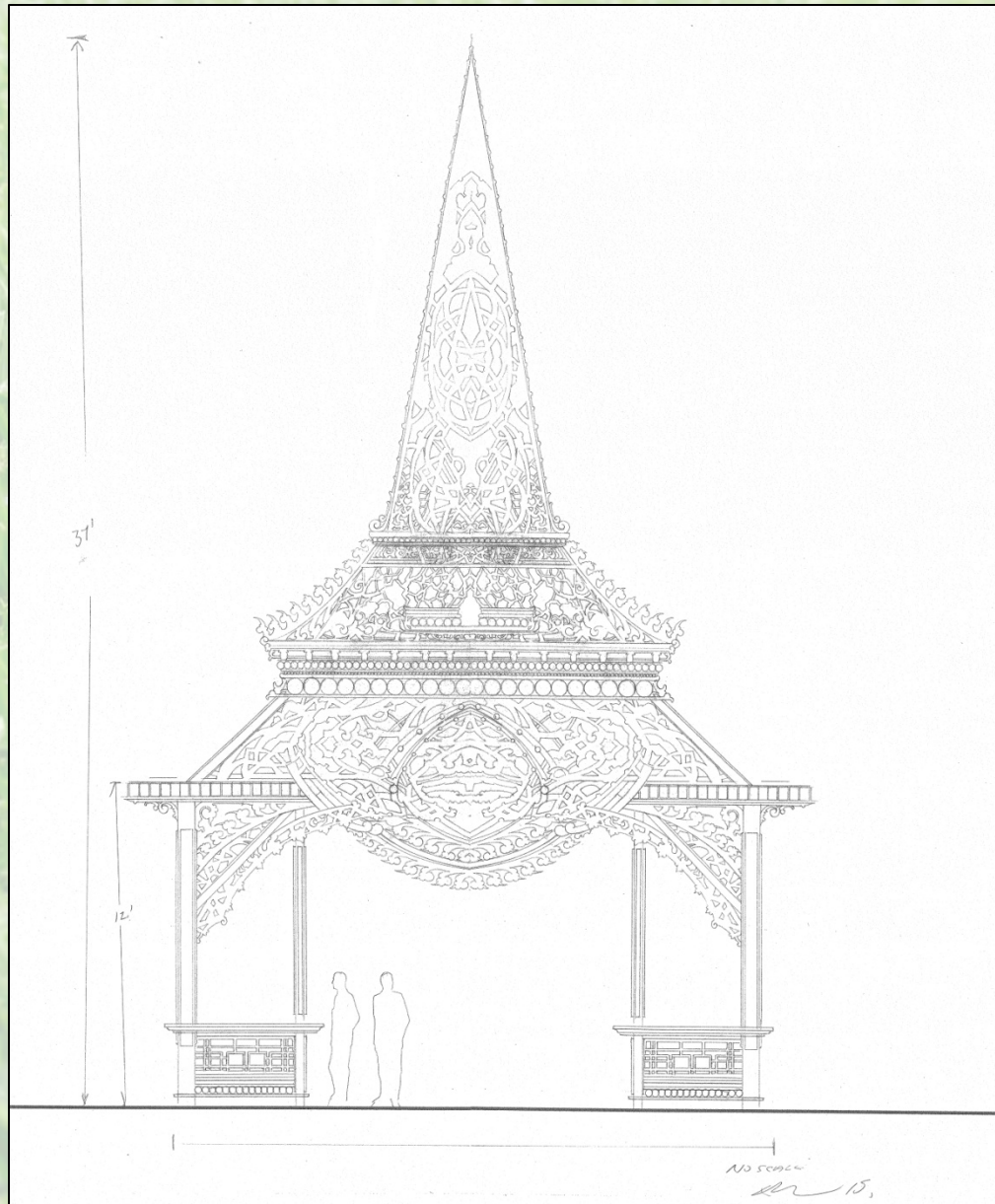
David Best

- **Born in San Francisco, and graduate of the San Francisco Art Institute**
- **Renowned for sculpture, painting, mixed media, and ceramic works**
- **Works have been displayed in major collections such as the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, and the diRosa Preserve**
- **Conveys a deep respect for inclusion and community activation**

Proposed Installation



- **Designed by David Best to commemorate the tenth (10th) anniversary of the inaugural installation at Patricia's Green**
- **A testament of the Hayes Valley revitalization after the Loma Prieta earthquake in 1989, and subsequent rebirth as a cultural and economic center**
- **Proposed installation has been approved by the Operation's Committee of the Recreation and Park Department and will be placed upon the Consent Calendar at an upcoming Rec and Park Commission meeting.**
- **The sculpture will be 37' tall and approximately 15' wide. It will be made from sustainable materials that have been treated with a fire retardant.**
