Annette Jannotta

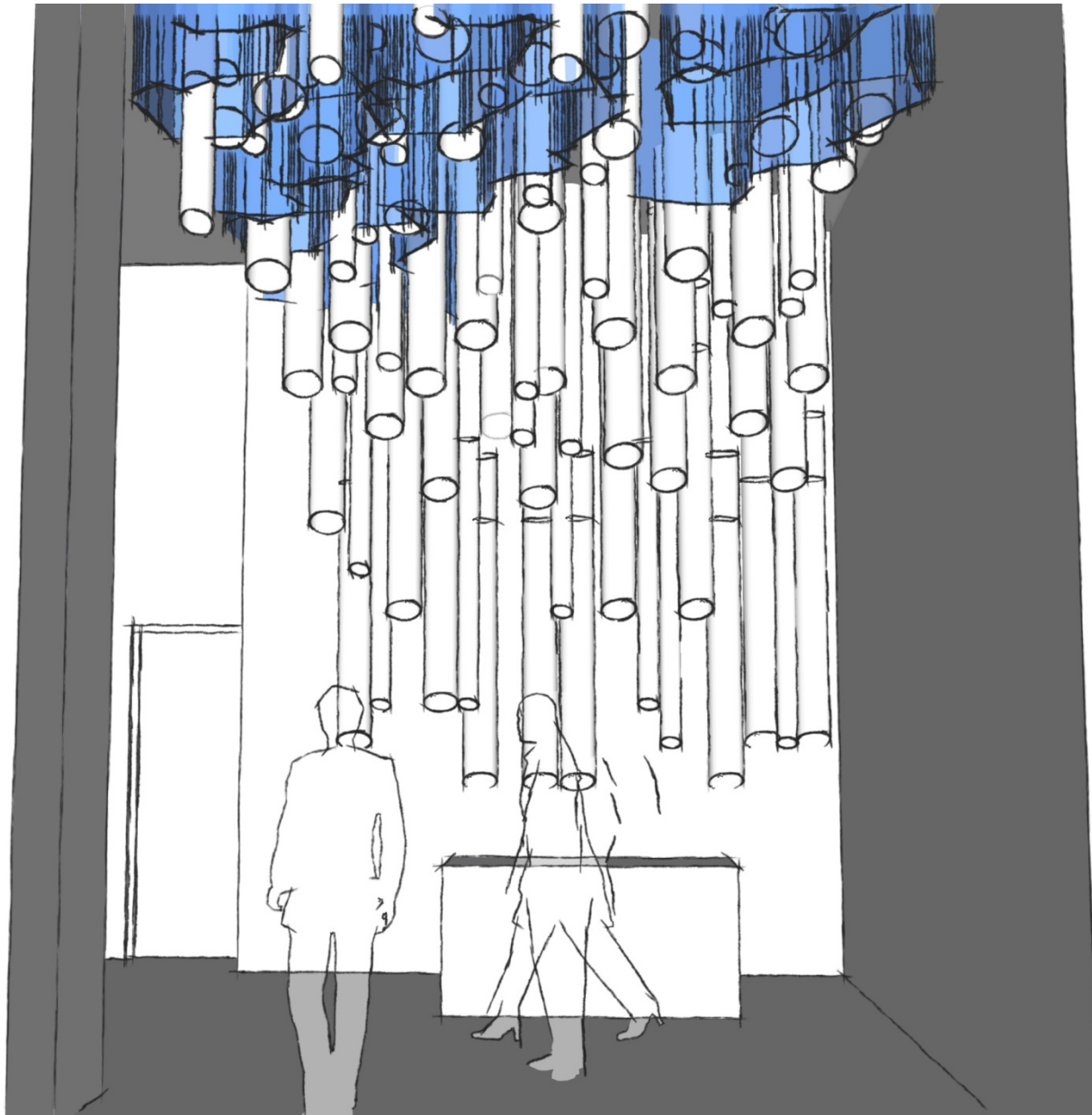
- An architect with over 20 years of interiors experience

- Annette is a licensed architect in California, an NCIDQ certified interior designer, LEED AP ID&C, and a member of IIDA Northern California

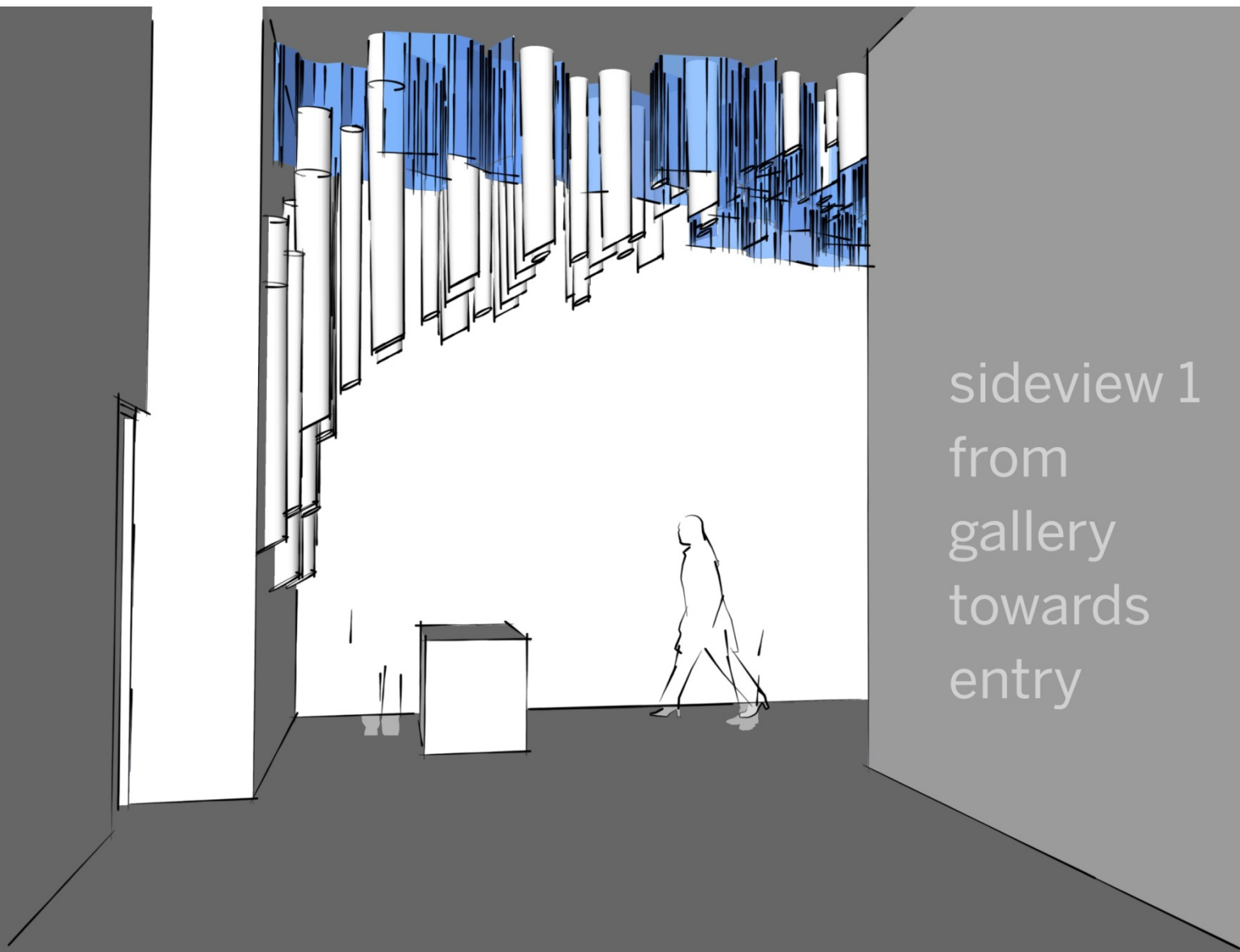
Olivia Ting
