The panelists were asked to discuss and evaluate each of the proposals on the following criteria:

- Aesthetic quality of artist's past work
- Appropriateness of the artist's past work and conceptual approach for the project/site
- Result of reference checks

The panelist then ranked the artists 1, 2, or 3 (1 = highest rank) accordingly. The artist with the lowest score is the highest ranked and therefore, selected to recommend to the Arts Commission.
