## Plaque Locations

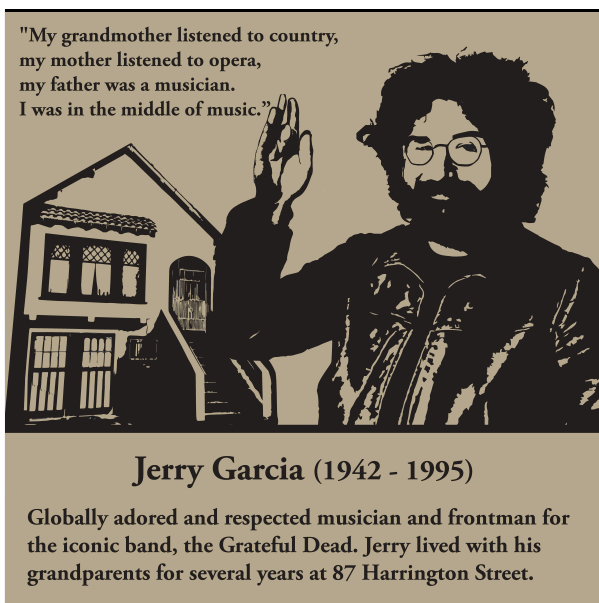
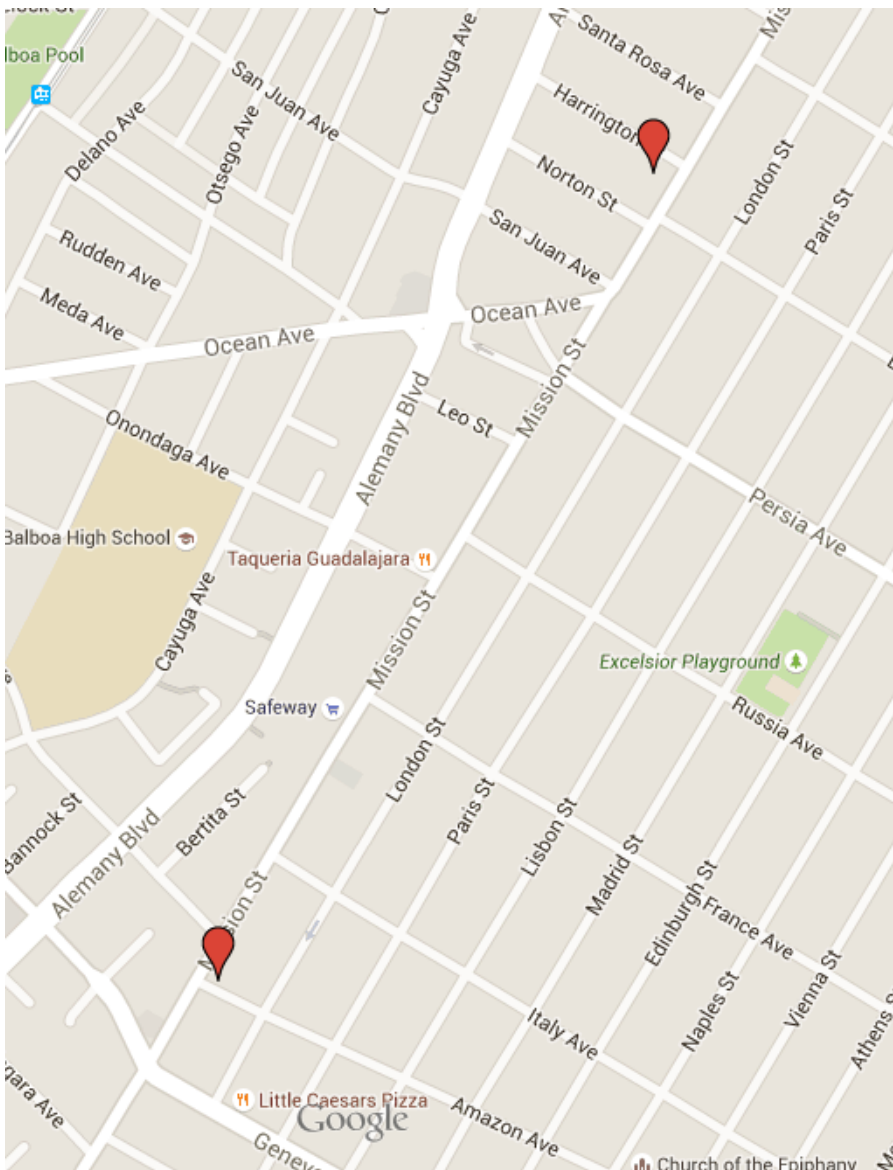
- 📍 4550 Mission - One Dollar Only

Plan to install two sidewalk plaques commemorating the childhood homes of Jerry Garcia.

The 3' by 3' bronze plaques will be on Mission Street where they will get the most foot traffic and encourage visitors to walk between the two plaques on the Mission commercial corridor.

We are working with the Garcia family on the language and design of the plaques using classic photographs from Barry Wolman and Herb Greene.

The design for the Harrington Street location includes a photo of the 87 Harrington Street house. The cover of Garcia's book *Harrington Street* featured Garcia's painting of this house.
