Dear Mr. Loli:

Reports have been filed with the Arts Commission that you allegedly violated Article 24 of the Police Code on the following dates and in the following manner:

February 13, 2015 on Market Street: Selling items not of your own creation: commercially manufactured stone pipes, ceramic nudes sculptures, wood and metal pipes and wood pipes. (Please see the attached Advisory Committee reports and photos from February 13, 2015).

The above alleged violation is considered a **charge of serious violation** of the Street Artist Ordinance. Please see the attached "NOTICE TO STREET ARTISTS" describing the Arts Commission's procedures with respect to such violations.

On February 12, 2014, you met with Program Director Lazar for a Program Director's hearing and signed a statement that you would not conduct business in a disorderly, improper, or hazardous manner and that you would obey all the rules of the Street Artists Program.

Because of the nature of the charge, we will withhold issuing or renewing your certificate pending a decision by the Arts Commission's Street Artists Committee on whether to issue, renew and/or suspend your certificate.

Our decision to withhold issuance or renewal of your certificate will be listed on the next agenda of the Street Artists Committee as a "HEARING AND POSSIBLE MOTION TO APPROVE STANDARD PENALTY OF TWO MONTH SUSPENSION OF CERTIFICATE." Attached with this letter is a "NOTICE OF HEARING" to appear at the hearing.

IF YOUR CERTIFICATE SHOULD EXPIRE PRIOR TO THE

HEARING OR TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION, YOUR CERTIFICATE WILL NOT BE RENEWED UNTIL ISSUANCE OF THE NOTICE OF THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION, IF SO, TO RENEW. PLEASE BE ADVISED ALSO THAT THE COMMITTEE HEARING MAY NOT NECESSARILY BE SCHEDULED PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF YOUR CURRENT CERTIFICATE, DUE TO THE COMMITTEE'S POSSIBLE BACKLOG OF AGENDA ITEMS, LACK OF QUORUM, OR OTHER REASONS.

Should the Committee decide to suspend your certificate or should the Committee decide to deny issuance or renewal of your certificate, you are entitled to appeal the decision to the Board of Appeals within fifteen (15) days of the notice of the decision. 
This is a continuation of the monitoring of downtown area Feb 13 2015





REVIEW OF ALLEGED STREET ARTIST VIOLATION/AUTHORIZATION OF CERTIFICATION

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City and County of San Francisco On February 12, 2014, I, Howard Lazar, Program Director of the Street Artists Program met with Street Artist Manuel Loli to review the report filed with the Arts Commission alleging that the above Street Artist violated the Street Artist Ordinance on the following date and in the following manner:

- (1) December 30, 2013, December 27, 2013, December 24, 2013, October 18, 2013 at Market Street between 5th and 4th streets: Exceeding display length requirements;
- (2) December 24, 2013, December 23, 2013 at Market Street between 5th and 4th streets: Selling in a location not designated by the Board of Supervisors.

On October 16, 2013, the Arts Commission sent him a "NOTICE OF WARNING" which informed him that he had allegedly violated the ordinance on October 11, 2013 for exceeding the width requirement on Market Street between $5^{\rm th}$ to $4^{\rm th}$ streets.

On December 7, 2012, he was selling on Market Street between 5th and 4th streets in an illegal location. As Program Director Lazar approached him, he packed up and left the premises. On October 26, 2012, he was seen set up a few feet west of M-9 and said he was waiting to share with the artist in space M-9. Mr. Loli agreed to not sell until a space opened up and he covered his table.

The above Street Artist states that from now on he will abide by all of the regulations of the Street Artist Ordinance, the rules of the Arts Commission's lottery space-assignment system, and the rules and policies of the Arts Commission's Street Artists Program, and will not conduct business in a disorderly, improper or hazardous manner.

Furthermore, the above Street Artist states that he fully understands the provisions of the Street Artist Ordinance pertinent to his certification and conduct as a Street Artist.

With this assurance, I, on behalf of the Executive Director (Director of Cultural Affairs) of the Arts Commission, do hereby authorize the issuance of a certificate to the above Street Artist.

Notice to Street Artists

Section 5 of the Street Artists Ordinance allows the Director of Cultural Affairs to refuse to issue a street artists certificate or renewal if charges have been filed alleging deception or violation of the Street Artists Ordinance. The Art Commission has adopted the following procedures to implement Section 5. These procedures may be used to address violations in addition to, and may be taken with, the existing suspension-revocation procedures.

CHARGES OF MINOR VIOLATIONS OF THE STREET ARTISTS ORDINANCE:

-includes most violations of a non-violent/ non-threatening nature.

First Violation: "NOTICE OF WARNING" from Program Director.

Second Violation: "NOTICE OF INTENT TO RECOMMEND DENIAL OF CERTIFICATE OR RENEWAL" from Program Director.

Notice will offer artist an opportunity to have a public hearing with Program Director to discuss the charge. If artist agrees in writing to comply with Street Artists Ordinance, Program Director will recommend issuance of certificate or renewal. If artist does not agree in writing to comply with the ordinance, Program Director will recommend denial of certificate or renewal.

Third Violation: (when at least 1 of 3 of the incidents has been witnessed by Police or Program staff): "NOTICE OF WITHHOLDING OF CERTIFICATE OR RENEWAL PENDING HEARING" from Director of Cultural Affairs.*

CHARGES OF SERIOUS VIOLATIONS OF THE STREET ARTIST ORDINANCE

-includes violations of a violent or threatening nature and violations that significantly threaten integrity of Street Artists Program.

First Verifiable Violation: "NOTICE OF WITHHOLDING OF CERTIFICATE OR RENEWAL PENDING HEARING" from Director of Cultural Affairs.*

*Denials of certificates or renewals are governed by section 2408 of the Street Artists Ordinance. The Street Artists Program Committee will hold a public hearing on the certificate or renewal in accordance with Section 2408. A decision by the Committee and Program Director to deny certificate or renewal may be appealed to the Board of Appeals within 15 days, in accordance with section 2409 of the Street Artists Ordinance.
