PROCESS

Round One: The panel evaluated the work of 12 artists selected from the 2015/16 Prequalified Artist Pool using the following criteria and numeric scoring system (1=low score):

- Artistic Excellence (1-10)
- Appropriate for Project Goals (1-10)

After tallying the scores, it was determined that six artists fell within a competitive range for further consideration.

Round Two: The panel discussed the strengths and weaknesses of each of the six remaining candidates, then ranked them 1 – 6 in order of preference (1=high score).

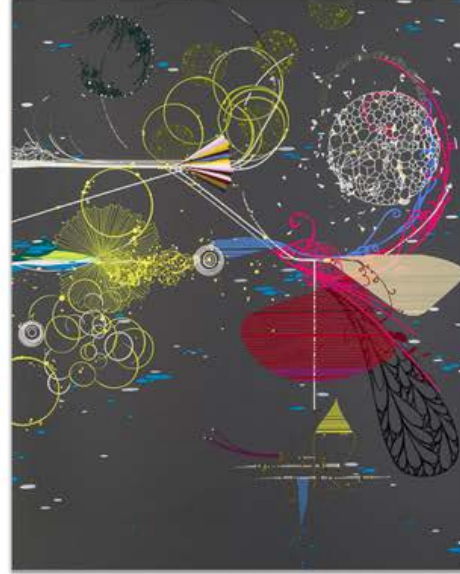
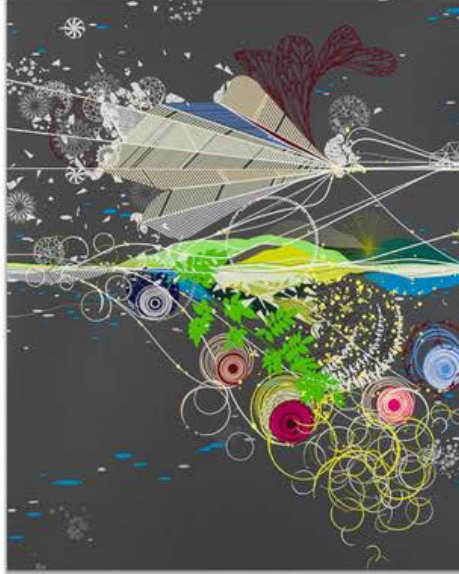
The following three artists received the highest scores:

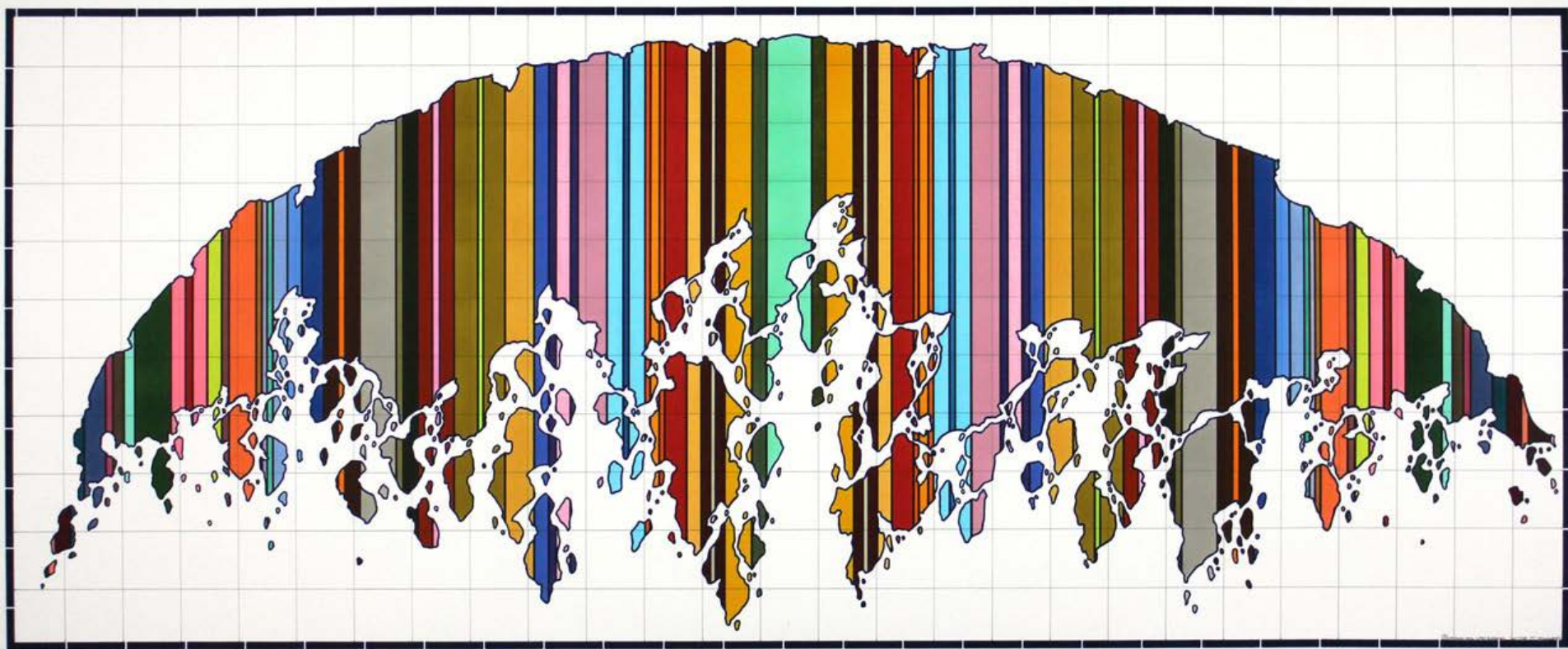
