

VAC Report for Muni Art Oct. 21, 2015 meeting

The Muni Art Project is a collaboration between SF Beautiful and the SFMTA. SF Beautiful proposed that artwork be displayed within the interior of five bus lines in place of advertising. Upon procuring approval from the SFMTA, SF Beautiful raised funds from various sources including the Community Challenge Grant Program.

The project was announced publicly and a prequalification panel with multiple panelists was established to review submissions and narrow it down to ten artists. The top five artists were selected by the public by popular vote through SF Beautiful's posting on neighborhoodland.com.

Although the artworks are already on display, due to a transition in staff leadership, the new SF Beautiful staff were not aware of the need for Arts Commission approval of this temporary project.
