In response to public comment on an item that is not on the agenda, the Committee is limited to: • briefly responding to statements made or questions posed by members of the public, or • requesting staff to report back on a matter at a subsequent meeting, or • directing staff to place the item on a future agenda. (Government Code Section 54954.2(a).)
