Election Day - By the Numbers

We'd like to thank all of our poll workers you for serving San Francisco voters throughout the long day on June 3, 2014.

Turnout

129,399 voters cast their ballot in this election; about 29.7% turnout among San Francisco's 435,784 registered voters.

Early Voting

Over 2,000 people voted early at City Hall, where voters can visit the Department of Elections' early voting station to cast a ballot up to 29 days before Election Day.

Vote-by-Mail

Voting by mail continues to be a popular option among San Francisco's registered voters. In this Election, over 90,000 voters mailed in or dropped off a Vote by Mail ballot. Over 20% of total ballots cast were VBM ballots!

Polling Places

576 Polling Places were utilized on Election Day and as always, over 95% of them were accessible to voters with disabilities!

Pollworker Recruitment

2,459 Poll Workers worked this Election; although most were returning poll workers, we would like to recognize the nearly 1,058 individuals who signed up to volunteer for their first time. Thank you for your civic engagement!

The High School Poll Worker Program recruited a 961 students who were eager to lend a hand and learn about the democratic process.

Language Assistance

The Department made a big push to recruit bilingual poll workers. In-person language assistance was provided to voters via 1,416 poll workers; 933 in Chinese, 302 in Spanish, 100 in Tagalog, 59 in Vietnamese, 8 in Korean, and 14 in Japanese. More bilingual assistance than ever before!

Poll Worker Stipends

Did you notice anything different about your paycheck? Poll worker pay rates were raised \$10 as the Department now awards "cell phone pay" to everyone, with an additional \$5 as a "thank you" for your continued dedication and service.

Poll Worker Raffle



You likely heard about the poll worker raffle during training class. To be entered in the raffle, precinct teams had to successfully perform the closing procedure of placing write-in ballots from Insight bin #1 into the green closing bag, voted ballots from Insight bin #2 into the blue closing bag and auxiliary bin ballots into the orange closing bag, without mixing any of them together. The winning precinct will be randomly selected and the staff members at that precinct will each receive an extra \$50.

In this election, all poll workers did a great job! After evaluating the statistics from the Official Canvass (the process where all election material is reviewed), 557 precinct teams completed their duties without mixing the ballots, and were entered into the contest—that's almost 97% of 576 precincts! We held the random drawing on Thursday June 19, and Department Director John Arntz drew the winning precinct! Congratulations to **Precinct 9251, at the St Gregory Armenian Church, Youth Hall!** Each member of your precinct team will receive a \$50 check in the mail! We hope to continue the raffle in future elections!
