Greetings, Poll Workers!

We hope you've had a fantastic summer and are gearing up for another Election!

The 2014 Consolidated General Election will be held on November 4, 2014. This is going to be an exciting one. The Department is expecting about 60% voter turnout for this election.

What's on the Ballot?

This is a pretty big Election for San Francisco and for the State of California. The following offices are going to be on the ballot:

State Offices:

- Governor
- Lt. Governor
- US Congressional Rep
- Secretary of State
- State Assembly
- Attorney General
- and more...

Local Offices:

- Assessor-Recorder
- Public Defender
- Board of Supervisor districts 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10
- Board of Education

- Community College Board
- BART Board of Directors, district 8.

Ballot Measures

Although signatures are still being counted and verified, there are a few measures that may be on the ballot that are sure to stir some controversy. A few noteworthy examples: there may be a measure that would tax sugary beverages, the "Golden Gate Park Athletic Fields Renovation Act" which would redevelop a portion of an athletic field in Golden Gate Park, and one that is sure to generate some voter interest, a measure that would raise San Francisco minimum wage to \$15/hr over the next few years.

It should be an exciting Election, and since we're expecting nearly as much voter turnout as we had during the 2012 Presidential Election, we'd like to urge all our poll workers to work with us again.
