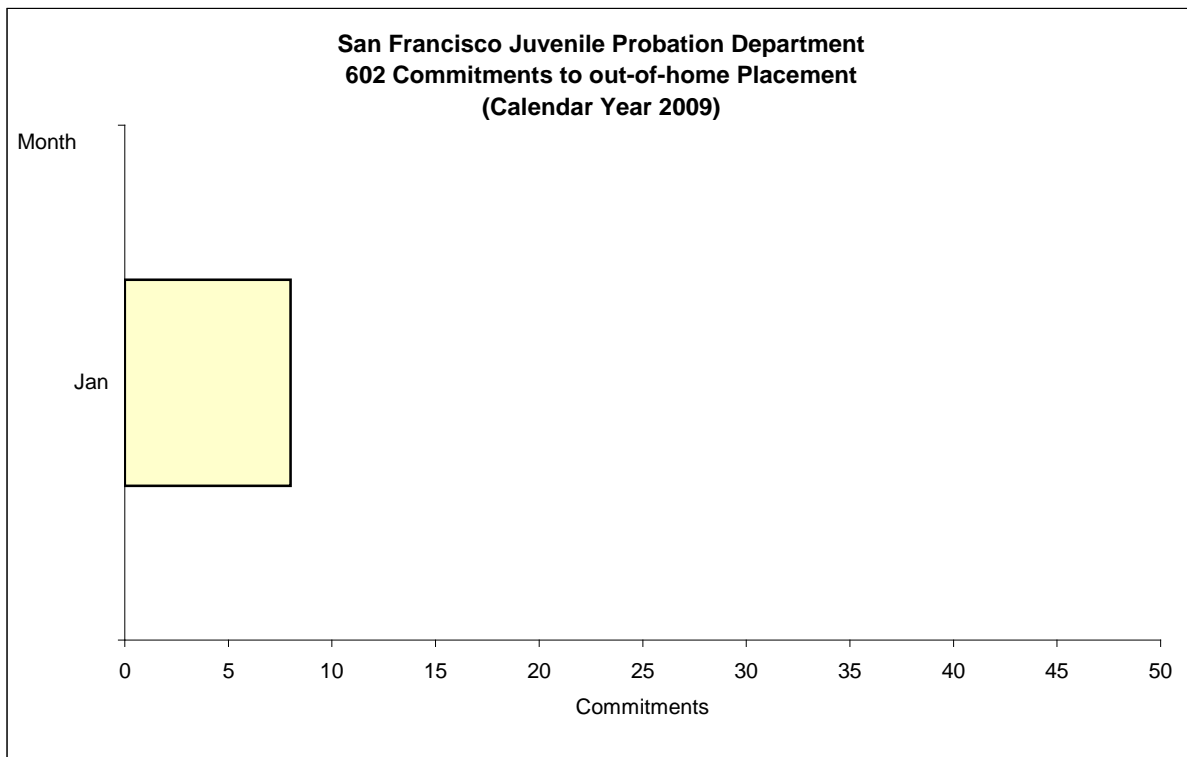

Of Juvenile Hall Detainees on 1/31/10 by Gender**

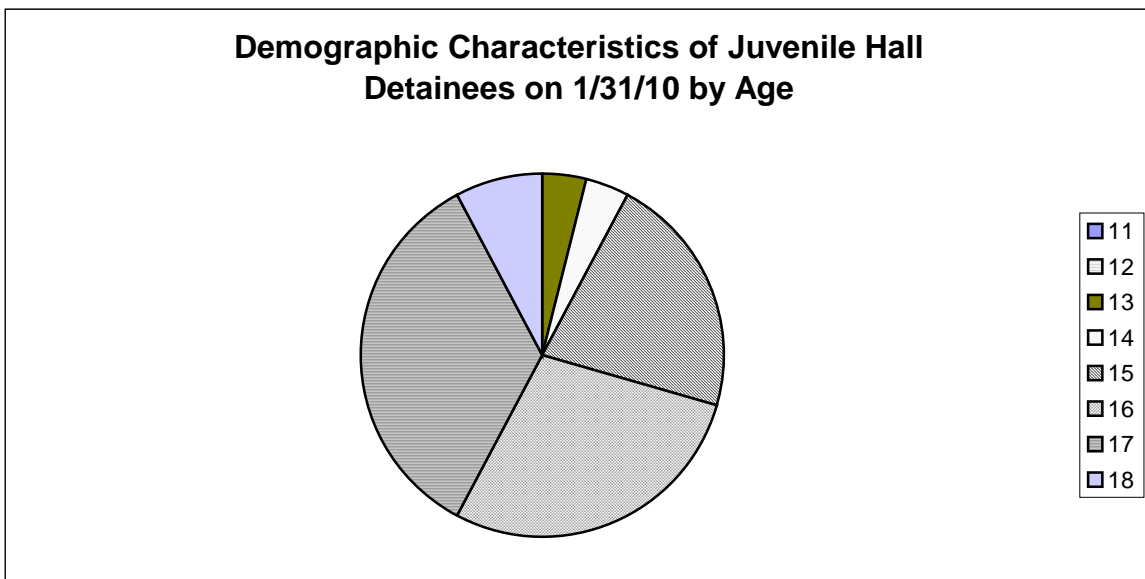

1/31/10 by Race**

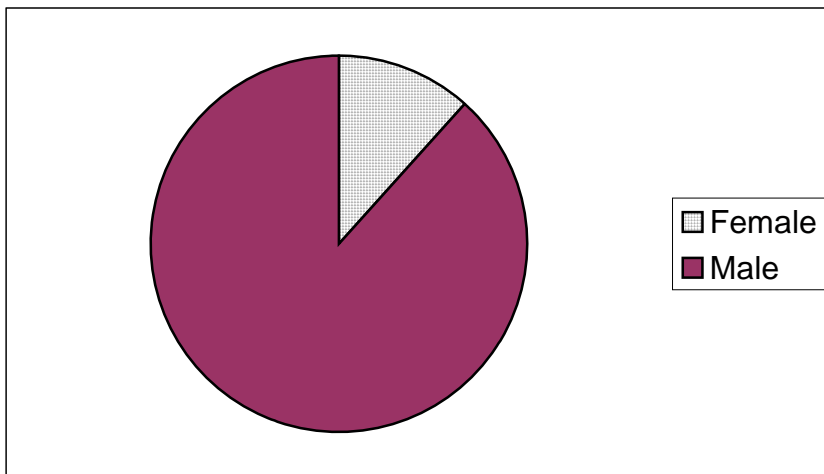

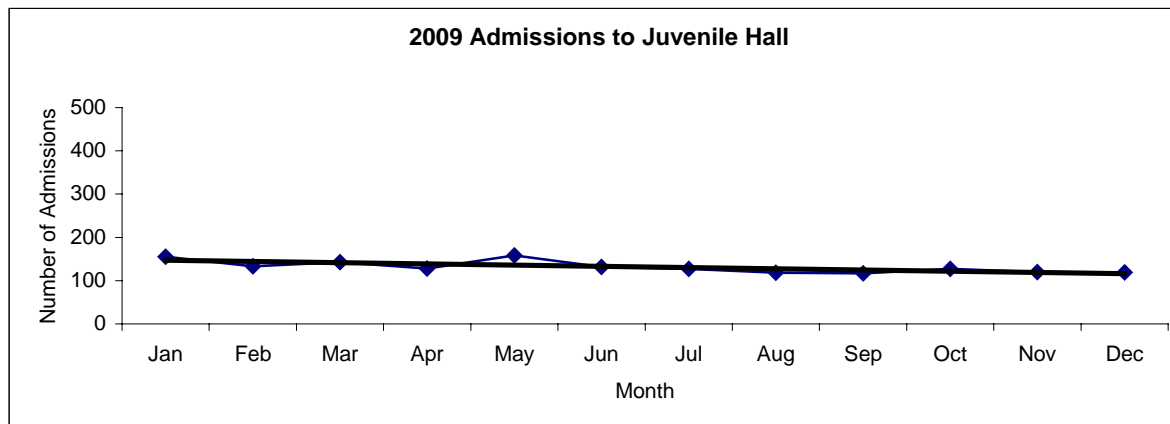
