





Out-of-Home Placement¹ Commitments of 602's Calendar Year 2010






Probation Referrals (all sources) by Month (602 W&I)


Bay Area Resident Juvenile Hall Comparison Over/Under Capacity on February 2nd, 2010

Juvenile Hall Admissions by Month Calendar Year 2010










