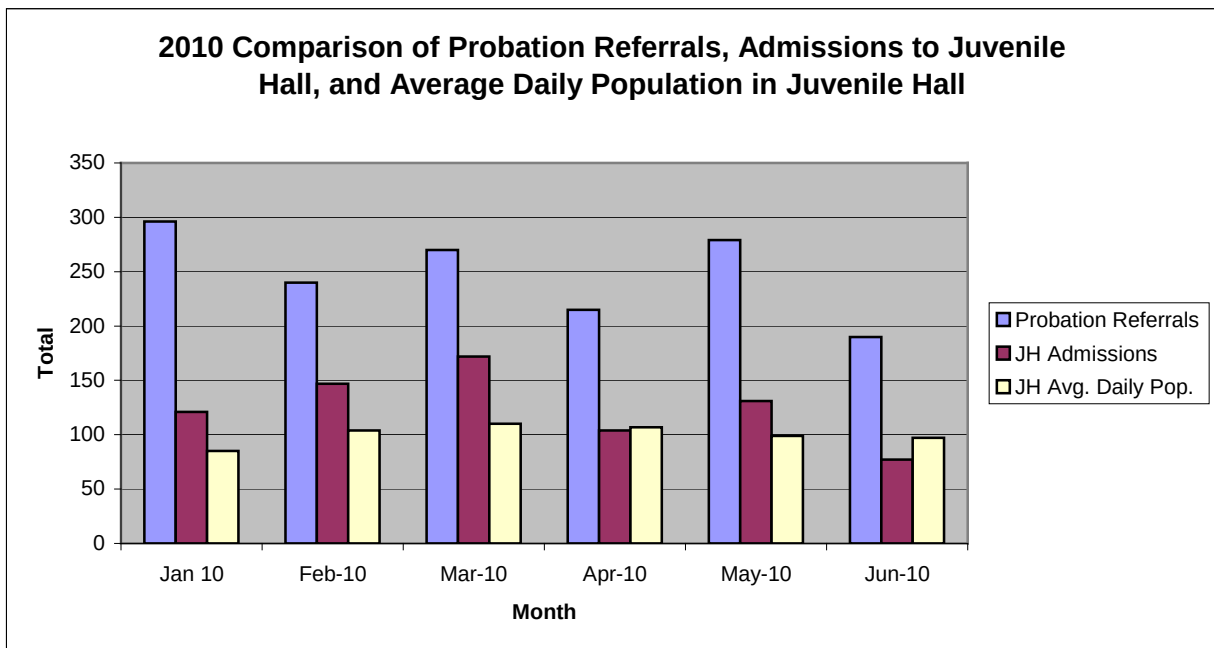

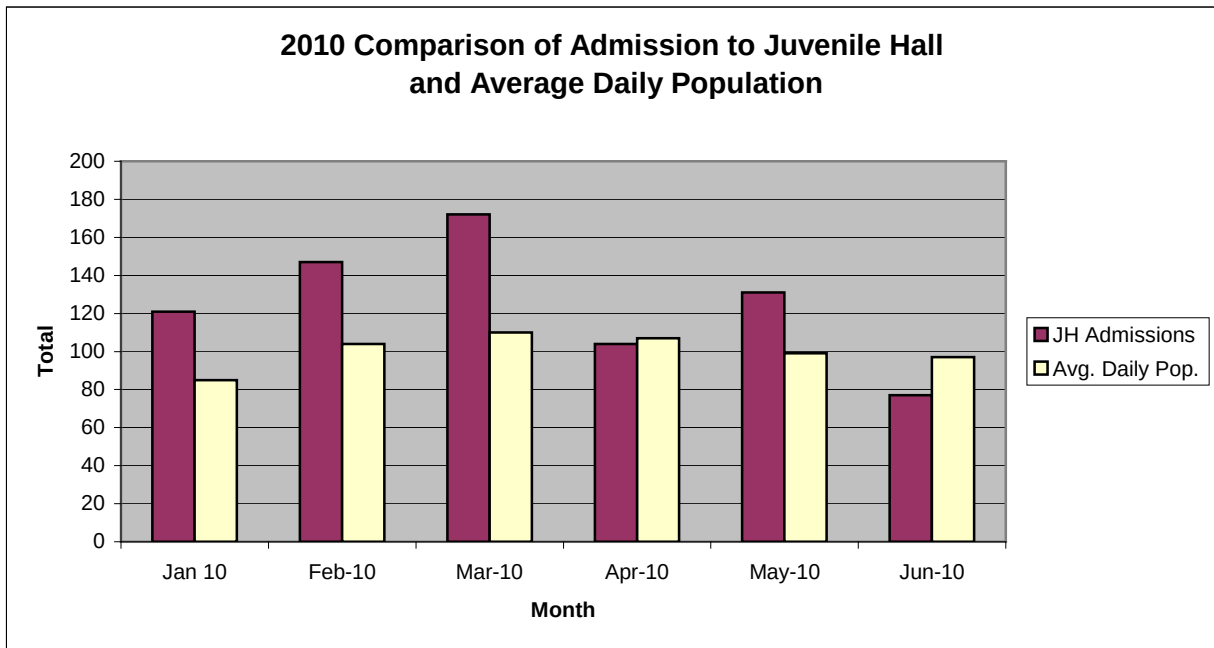

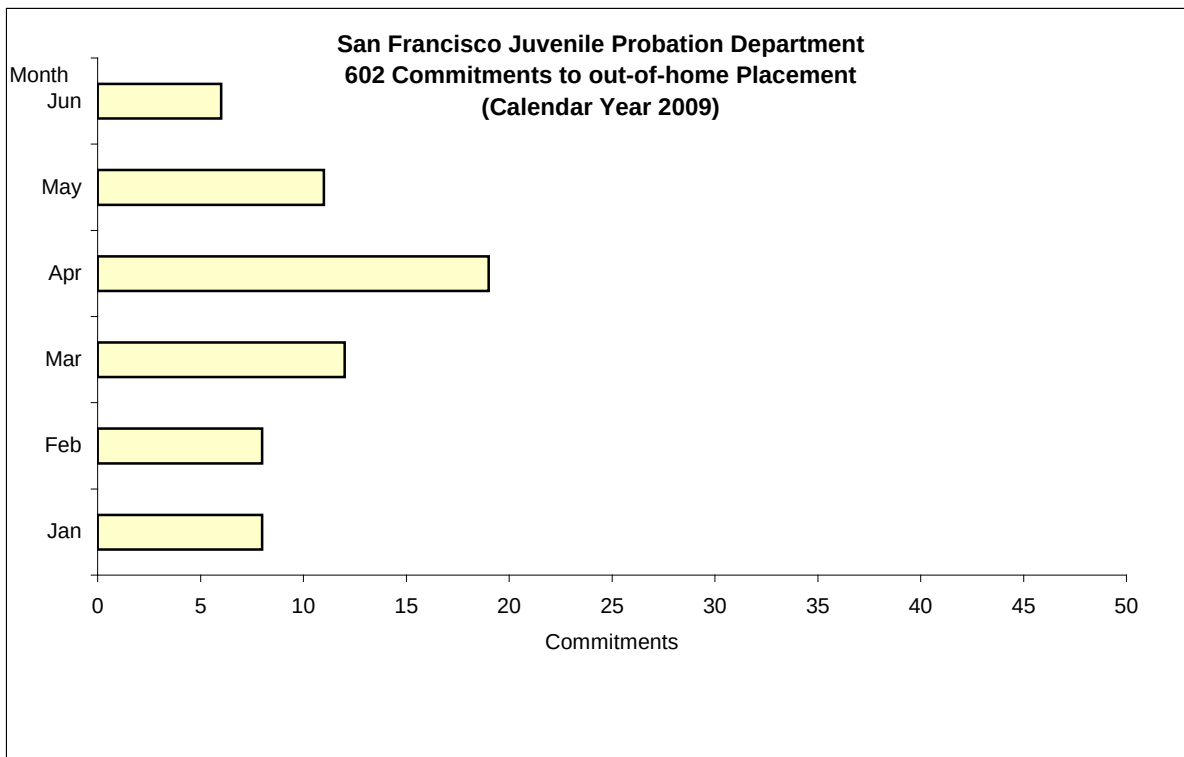


Out-of-Home Placement¹

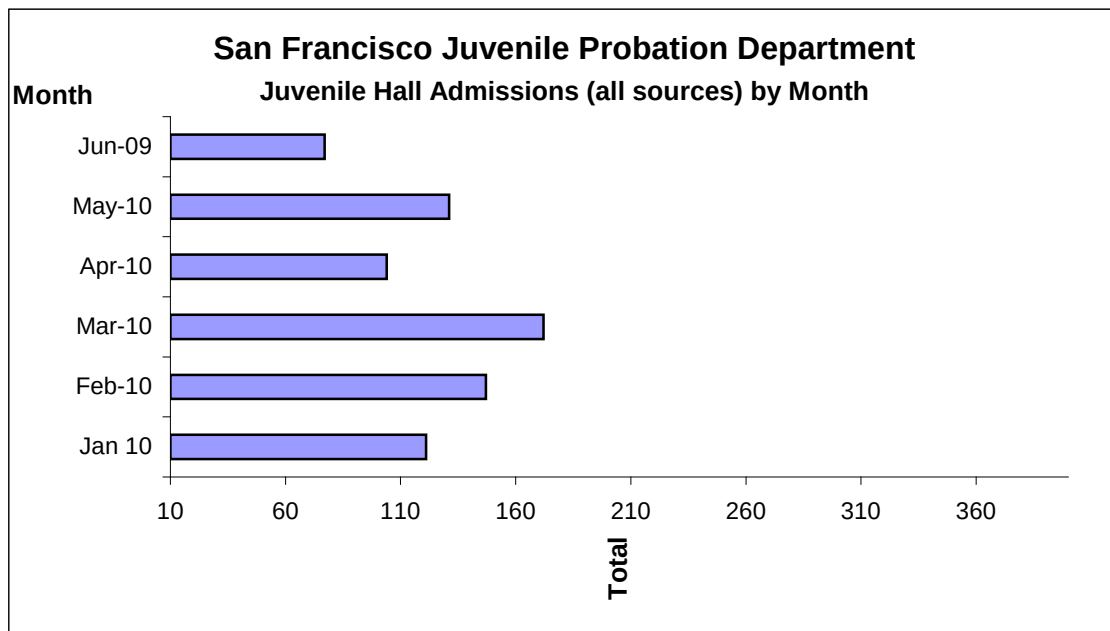
Bay Area Resident Juvenile Hall Comparison

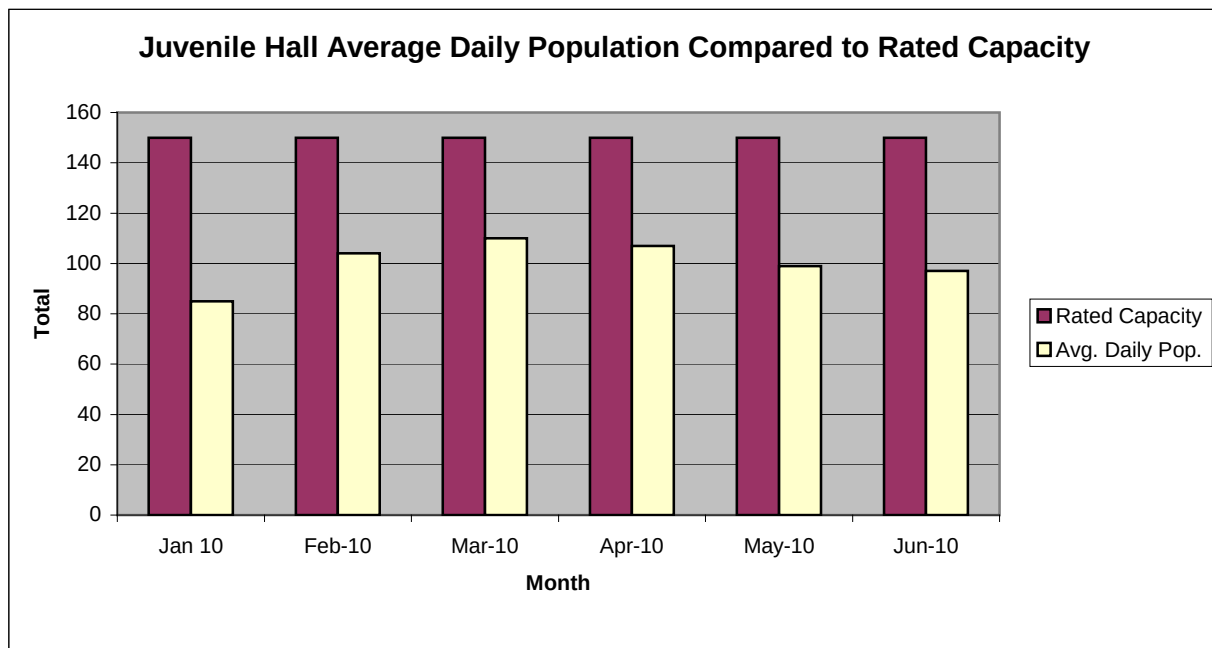

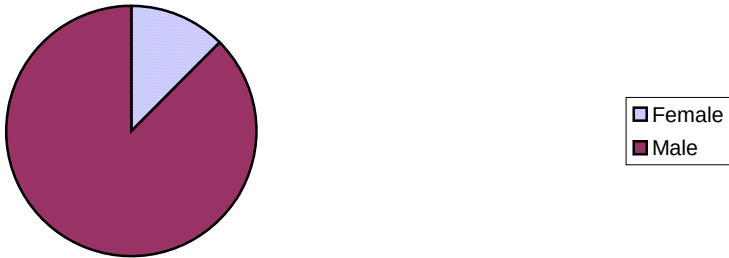

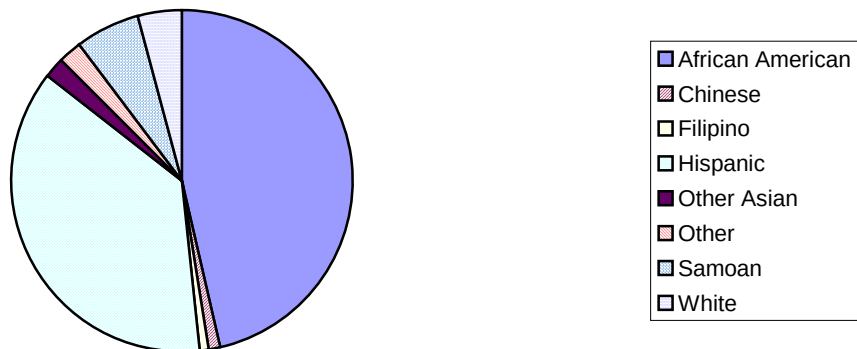

Of Juvenile Hall Detainees on 6/30/10 by Gender**

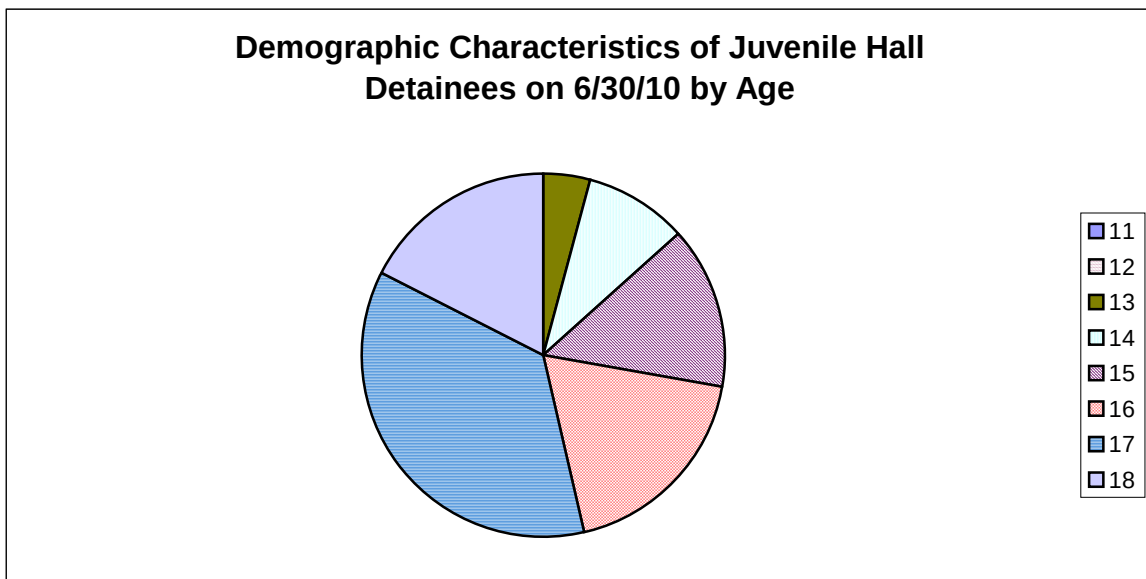

6/30/10 by Race**

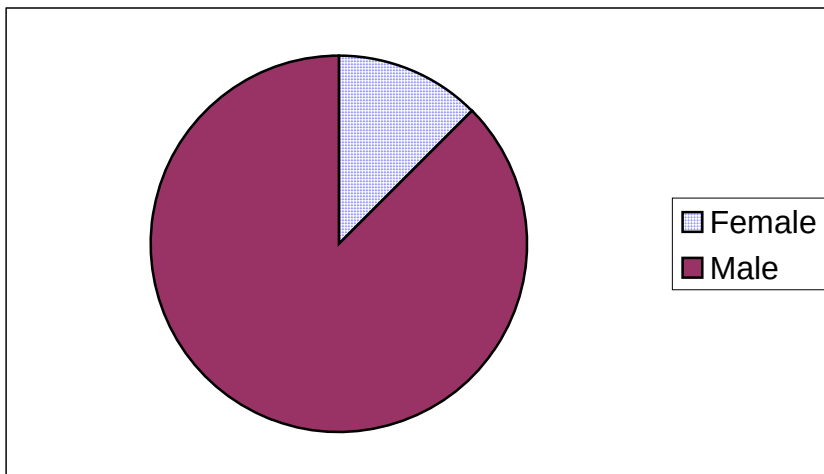

(2007-2009)

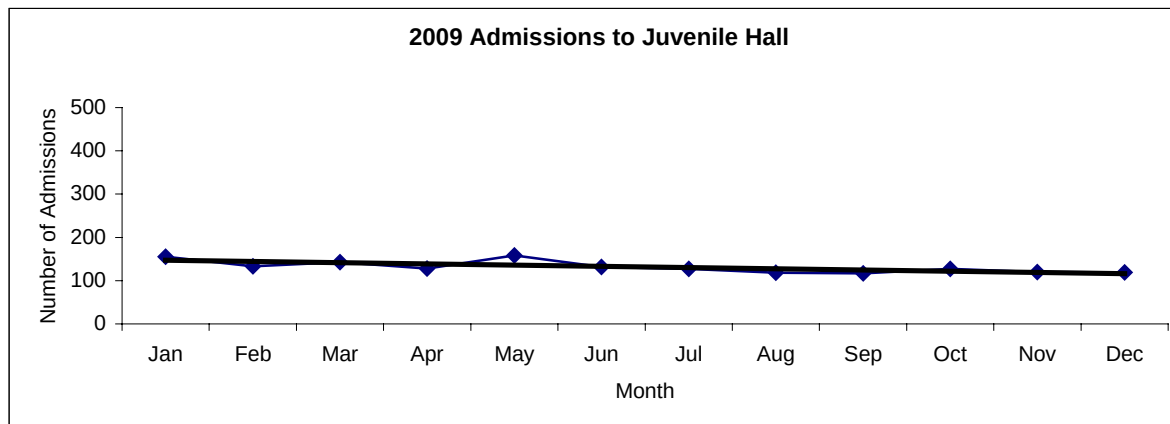

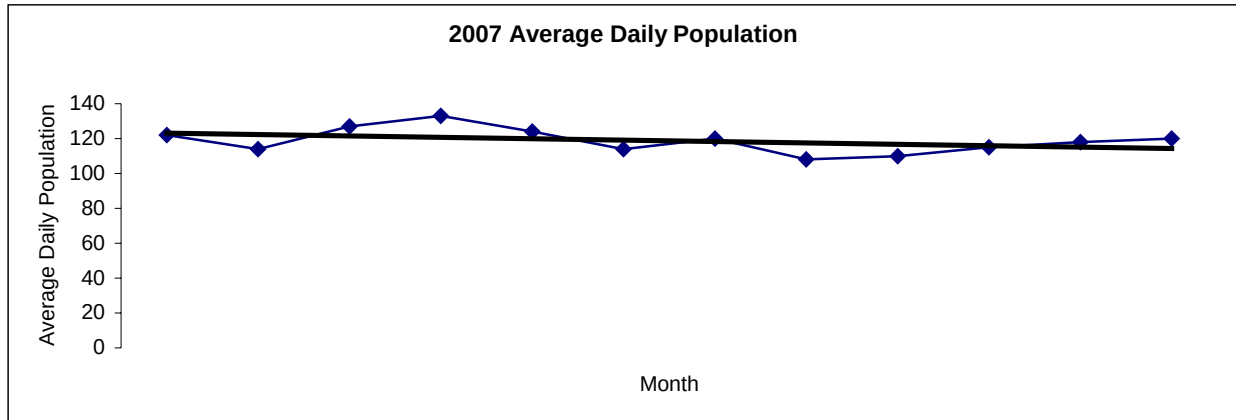

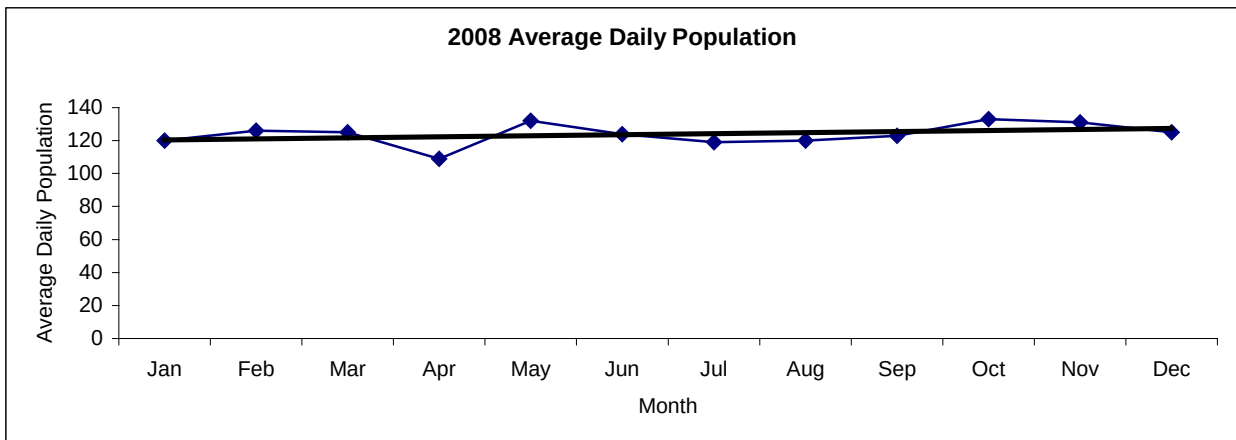
