Of Juvenile Hall Detainees on 1/31/12 by Gender**

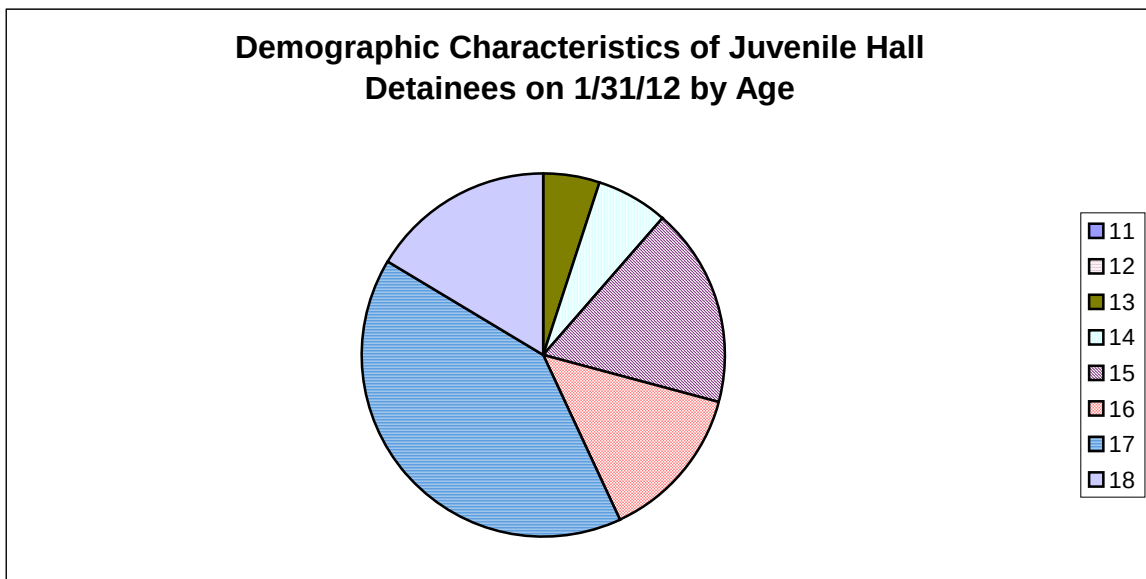

1/31/12 by Race**

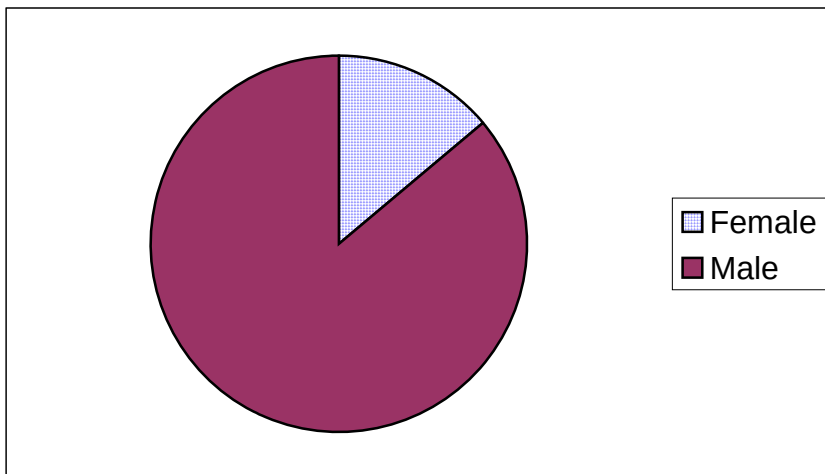

(2008-2010)

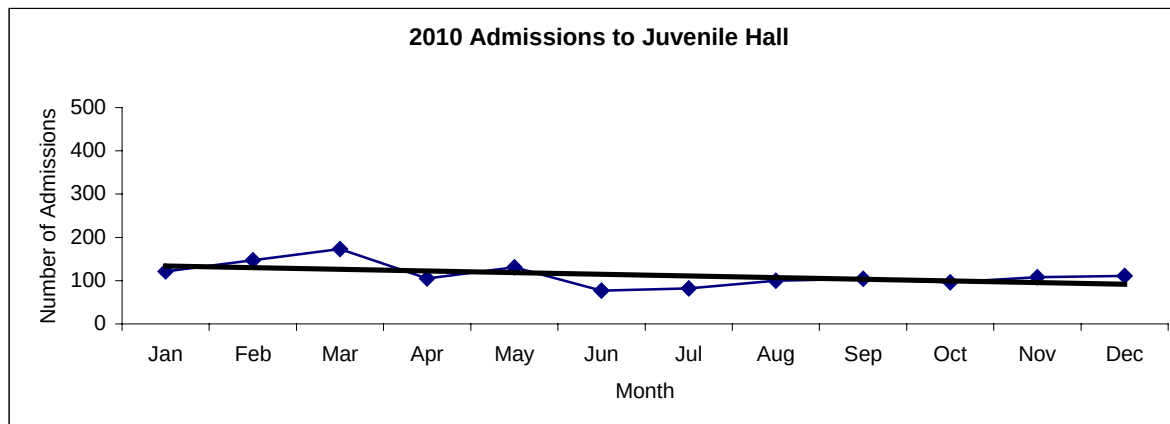

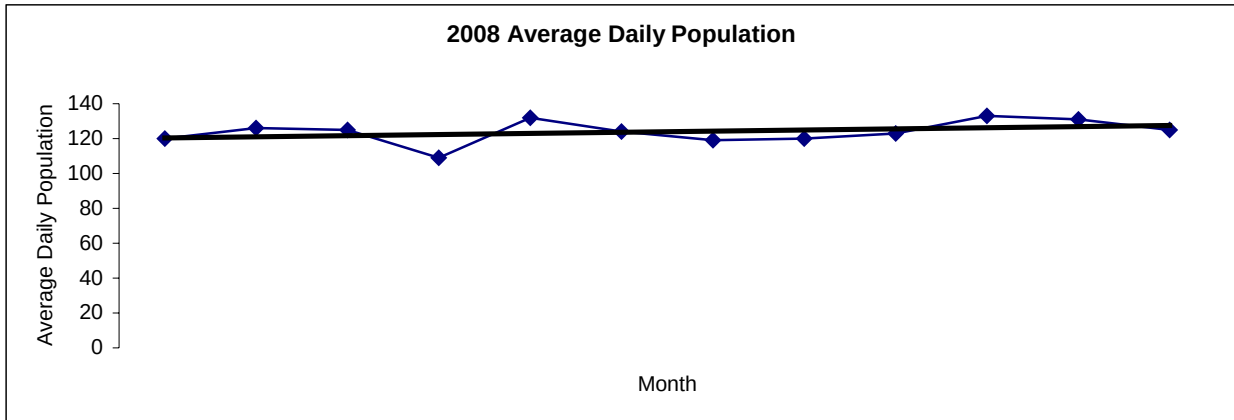

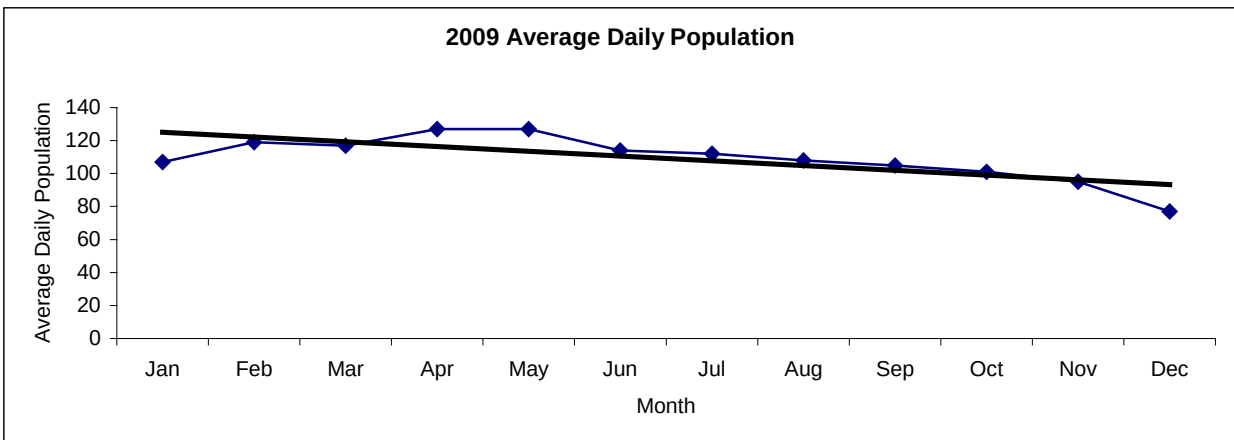

 (2008-2010)

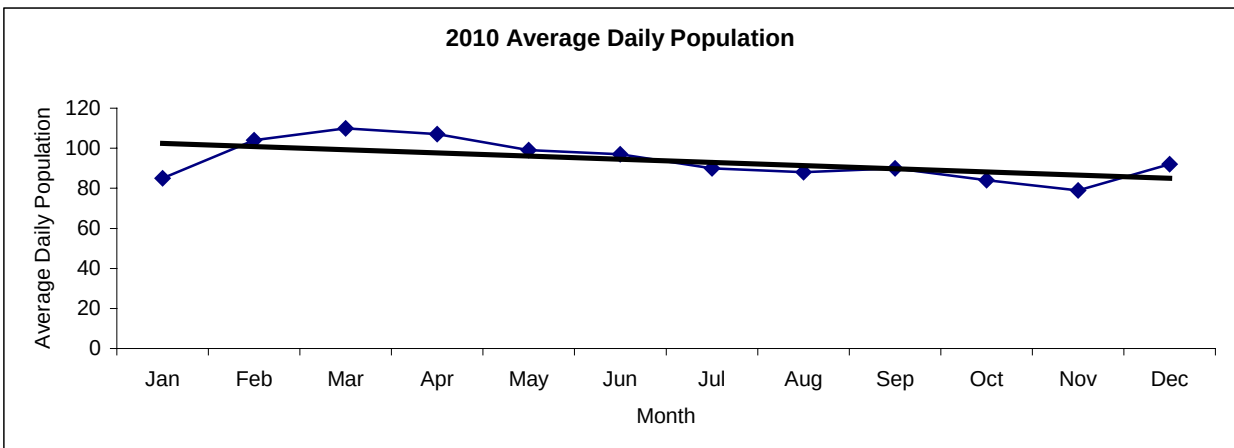
