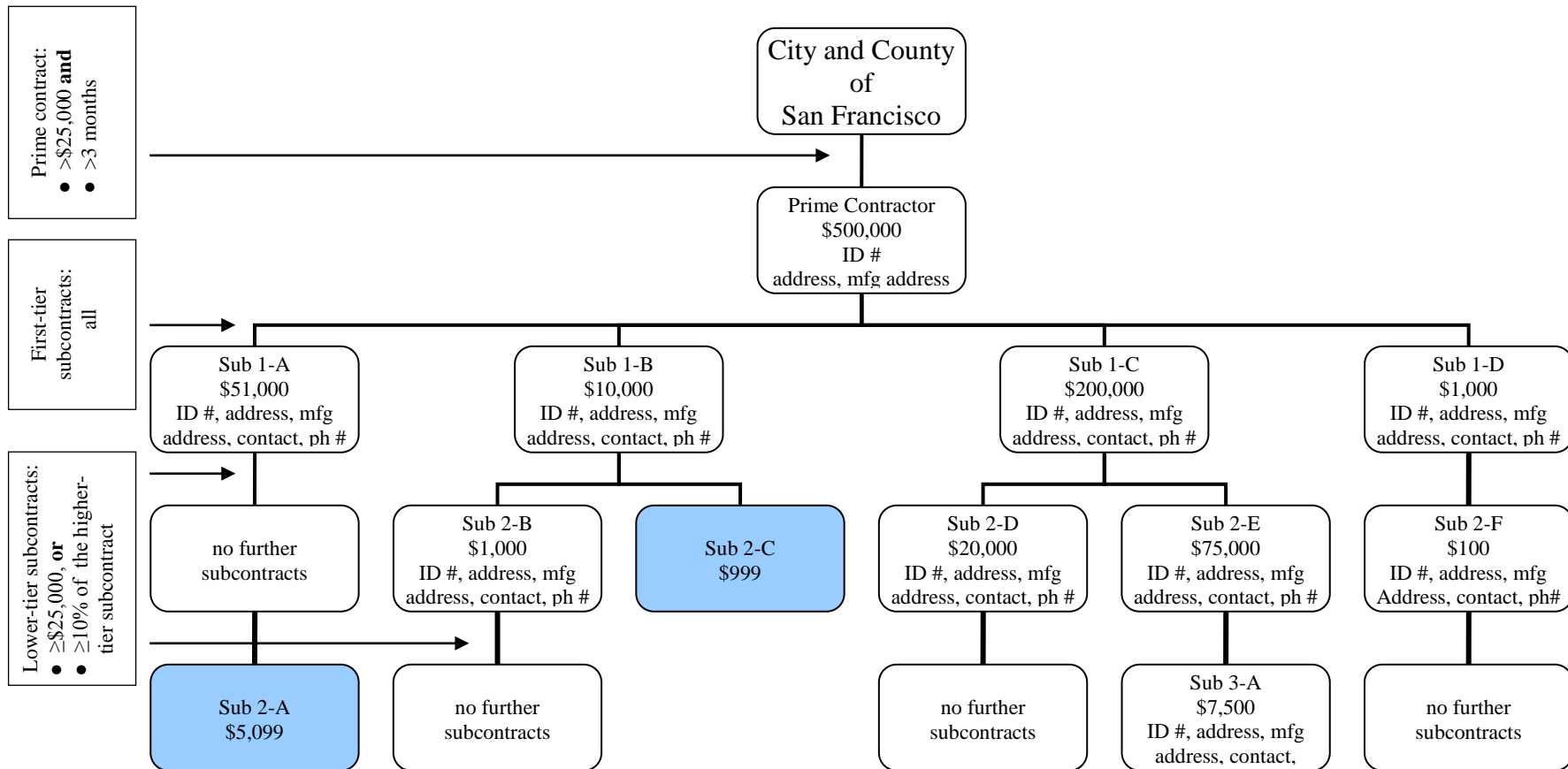




Sweatfree Contracting Ordinance Supply Chain Information Form



In this sample diagram, San Francisco has a one-year contract for \$500,000 with Prime Contractor for garments. The contract is covered by the Sweatfree Contracting ordinance, which is Chapter 12U of the City’s Administrative Code.

The prime contractor must provide the City with information about all subcontracts and subcontractors **except the shaded subcontracts and subcontractors.**

In the first tier of subcontractors, all subcontracts meet Chapter 12U’s definition of “subcontract” and must be disclosed. In the second tier, the shaded boxes are subcontracts that do not meet the definition because they are less than \$25,000 and less than 10% of the applicable first-tier subcontract with the Prime. (The prime indicated “no further subcontractors” below Sub 1-A because Sub 2-A’s contract is exempt.) The other second-tier subcontracts are covered subcontracts because even though they are less than \$25,000, they are at least 10% of the applicable first-tier subcontract with the Prime. The third-tier subcontract is also a covered subcontract because it is 10% of the higher-tier subcontract.
