I. INTRODUCTION

A. Statistics

Attached is the Office of Citizen Complaints' statistical report for the 2016 second quarter. The OCC received an adjusted total of 159 complaints of police misconduct or failure to take action and closed 138 complaints this second quarter. It sustained allegations of misconduct or failure to take action in 14 complaints against San Francisco Police officers, which is a 10% sustained rate. The OCC mediated 13 cases, which is a nine percent (9%) mediation rate.

B. Transparency

As was previously stated in the OCC's First Quarter 2016 report, in addition to investigating complaints of police misconduct or neglect of duty and providing policy recommendations, the OCC's mission includes informing the public about and engaging them in the work of the OCC. By the close of the second quarter, OCC investigators were investigating four (4) officer involved shootings resulting in fatalities. The OCC continued its enhanced community outreach efforts which it began in earnest in the first quarter of 2016. Community members and the media requested greater transparency from the OCC through OCC staff participation on panels, attendance at community meetings and hearings to describe the OCC's role in addressing complaints of police misconduct and neglect of duty. Sections VIII and IX, of this report, Outreach and Policy, respectively, describe in brief the OCC's outreach to and involvement with community members and stakeholders to enhance community/police relations and to improve police policies.

During the second quarter of 2016, the OCC continued to interact with the Blue Ribbon Panel on Transparency, Accountability, and Fairness in Law Enforcement

(hereinafter Blue Ribbon Panel). In the OCC's first quarter report, we advised that during the first quarter of 2016, the OCC's work with *pro bono* staff to the Blue Ribbon Panel included responding to their requests for information, and holding meetings with them, as well as providing testimony at one of the panel's hearings. During the second quarter, the OCC attended the final hearing of the panel where they presented preliminary findings.

During the second quarter as in the first quarter, the OCC responded to information requests from and held meetings with representatives from the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) of the United States Department of Justice as they worked on a collaborative reform initiative with the San Francisco Police Department.

C. Officer Involved Shooting Jurisdiction Clarified – Proposition D

During the second quarter, the OCC continued to provide technical assistance to Supervisor Malia Cohen of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors on the ballot measure which she authored, Proposition "D", that clarified the OCC's jurisdiction to investigate all officer involved shootings, not just those that were the subject of complaints. The OCC Director testified at Board of Supervisors' committee hearings and at a Ballot Simplification Committee hearing on the impact of the measure. The Director and her staff provided interviews to the print, television and radio media on the impact of the measure on the OCC. At the June 7, 2016, Presidential Primary election Proposition D received 194,464 "Yes" votes, nearly 81% of the votes cast for it; the largest number and percentage of Yes votes of all measures on the San Francisco ballot.

II. ORGANIZATIONAL AND BUDGET MATTERS

A. Staffing

By the close of this period, 16 permanent line investigators (8124) staffed the OCC, but only 13 of them had full caseloads during this quarter. One permanent line investigator, who was working on an officer-involved shooting case, did not have a full caseload at the close of the second quarter. Two other permanent line investigators, who were acting senior investigators during the second quarter, had very small caseloads. Of the two acting senior investigators, one continued to fill the vacancy created when Senior Investigator Erick Baltazar was promoted to the deputy director/chief of investigations position in August 2013. The other acting senior investigator continued to fill the vacancy created when a senior investigator, who had been on a long term leave, retired. By the close of the second quarter, there were five investigator vacancies; two line investigators and three senior investigators. The OCC's budget provided for 18 line investigators, four senior investigators, and a deputy director/chief of investigations. By the close of the second quarter, 18 employees staffed the 23 investigator positions.

During the second quarter, one 8124 Investigator resigned effective May 23, 2016. The 1632 Senior Account Clerk retired on June 30, 2016. John Alden was hired to fill the 8177 attorney position effective May 31, 2016. Aaron Zisser was hired as a temporary 8177 attorney on June 27, 2016. During the second quarter the OCC interviewed and offered three 8126 Senior Investigator positions to three internal candidates, Steve Ball, Sherry Fletcher and Sara Mauder. They were hired to begin on July 1, 2016. The OCC also recruited and hired Carlos Villarreal as an 8124 Investigator to begin on August 1, 2016. Mr. Villarreal was hired to fill the vacancy created from the 8124 investigator's resignation in May. The OCC also began recruitment for a 1632 Senior Account Clerk. During the second quarter, the OCC's clerical unit remained understaffed due to a clerk typist who had been on leave since 2014.

B. Technology

During the second quarter, Information Systems Business Analyst, Chris Wisniewski, (hereinafter "IS Analyst") and the Department of Technology completed OCC's much needed network upgrade. Mr. Wisniewski also prepared special reports for the DOJ COPS project, *Reuters* and the Blue Ribbon Panel. The Information Systems Analyst also worked with vendors on a fiscal year-end purchase and projections for the Mayor's Office regarding OCC's growth and future needs. As always, he assisted investigators and other staff with technical aspects of their work.

C. Training

During the second quarter, the OCC Director, and three (3) investigators attended a National Association for Civilian Oversight of Law Enforcement (NACOLE) training hosted by the Oakland Citizens' Police Review Board (CPRB). The training was "*Profiling: Developing a Mechanism to Identify, Quantify, and Investigative Profiling Allegations Against Police*".

D. Budget

As previously reported in the OCC's First Quarter report, after consideration by the San Francisco Police Commission, the OCC submitted its proposed budget to the Mayor's Office on February 22, 2016. The Mayor's office informed OCC it would not take the 1.5% reduction that was requested of all Departments but instead the Mayor's budget would include five (5) full time equivalents (FTEs) in additional staffing of four (4) 8124 journey level investigators and one (1) 8126 senior investigator to handle increased officer involved shooting cases. The Mayor's budget also included enhancements to the OCC's professional services, training, materials and supplies and work order account line items amounting to \$276,158. A new vehicle was also approved. During the second quarter, the OCC Executive Director testified before the Board of Supervisors Budget and Finance Committee in April and in June. The Board of Supervisors Budget and Finance Committee approved the

recommended enhancements in the amount of \$1,744,993 for an OCC 2016/2017 budget of \$7,770,373. This increased the OCC's baseline budget by \$1,744,993. OCC is waiting for the budget to be adopted in August.

III. INVESTIGATION OF CASES

A. Case Inventory

By the end of the 2016 second quarter, the OCC opened 160 new cases with an adjusted total of 159 opened cases¹, and closed 138 cases. During this period, the OCC closed 21 less cases than its unadjusted opened cases. The OCC closed the quarter with 396 pending cases, which are 24 more pending cases than the close of the second quarter in 2015. By the end of the 2016 second quarter, there were 216 pending cases from 2016, 169 pending cases from 2015, seven (7) pending from 2014, two (2) pending cases from 2013 and two (2) pending cases from 2011.

B. Caseloads and Disposition of Cases

With only 13 investigators assigned full caseloads by the close of the second quarter of 2016 and only 13 investigators assigned full caseloads the first quarter of 2015, caseloads were higher than best practices both years.² In the second quarter of 2015, the caseloads were 33 cases per investigator. In the second quarter of 2016, the caseloads were 28 caseloads per investigator. What is remarkable for 2016 is that by the close of the second quarter investigators managed to continue to sustain complaints exceeding those in 2015 despite their staggering caseloads. What continued to suffer as in the first quarter of 2016 was timeliness of case closures. Comparing the second quarter of 2016 to the first quarter of 2016, the average number of days to close cases increased from 188 days to 193 days. The OCC's goal is to conclude its investigations within 270 days.

During the second quarter of 2016, OCC investigators closed 138 cases with 60% of them closing within 270 days and 16 of them, which had no sustainable allegations, took more than a year to close. This differs by five (5) percentage points from the first quarter of 2016 where the OCC closed 21 more cases, with 65% of them closing within 270 days. The number of days to close sustained cases was similar between the first and second quarters of 2016. In the first quarter of 2016, only two (2) of the 17 sustained cases were closed within 270 days. In the second quarter of 2016 only two (2) of the 14 sustained cases were closed within 270 days.

C. Sustained Cases

The number of sustained cases in the second quarter of 2016, 14, a 10% sustained rate, combined with the number of sustained cases the first quarter of 2016, 17, resulted in a 10% sustained rate.

The ongoing impediments to prompt completion of sustained cases are attributable to at least three factors: 1) Larger than best practices caseloads for investigators resulting in longer times to complete investigations, 2) Several high profile and complex investigations, and 3) increased policy work for the policy analyst attorney who also serves as an advice attorney on sustained cases and sustainability reviews.

During the second quarter of 2016, there were sustained allegations of neglect of duty in all 14 of the sustained complaints. None of the neglect of duty allegations were for failure to collect traffic stop data. Thirteen of the 14 sustained complaints had at least one sustained allegation that was identified by the complainant. In the one case with only an added allegation sustained, due to the state mandated peace officer privacy protections, the complainant was not advised of the finding on the added allegation.³ In the remaining 13 cases, the complainants were notified that the complained of officer(s) had been found to be in violation of SFPD policies but the complainants were not notified the nature of the officer's discipline or other corrective action, again due to state mandated peace officer privacy protections.

Additional sustained allegations included unwarranted action and conduct reflecting discredit. (Appendix A, pp. 9-18.)

D. Chief of Police's Adjudication of OCC Sustained Cases

When the OCC Director forwards a sustained case to the Chief of Police, she can either recommend that the Chief of Police file charges with the Police Commission and after meeting and conferring with the Police Chief the OCC Director can file charges on her own with the Police Commission if the Police Chief declines her request.

Alternatively, the OCC Director can determine that a case warrants ten days or less of suspension. The Police Chief determines the level of discipline in OCC cases that the OCC Director determines would warrant no more than ten days of suspension and are adjudicated by the Chief of Police. The Chief of Police determines whether or not to sustain the OCC's findings and what discipline to impose. The OCC Director recommends discipline to the Chief of Police but the Chief of Police determines whether in his opinion the sustained allegations are merited, and if so, what level of discipline or corrective action he will impose. While police officers may appeal the

Chief's discipline to the Police Commission, neither the Charter section 4.127 nor the Administrative Code provide for the OCC Director to appeal the Chief's decision. During the second quarter, the Chief of Police proposed discipline in 21 OCC sustained cases as follows:⁴

In April 2016, Chief Suhr made findings and proposed discipline in three cases investigated by the OCC and determined by the OCC Director to have sustainable allegations. The OCC's findings and the Chief's proposed discipline are as follows:

1. In violation of DGO 1.03, section I.A.5.D., an officer neglected his duty when he failed to prepare an incident report of a crime he observed. The officer also violated DGO 2.01, section 25 for failing to prepare a written report and in violation of DGO 5.04, the officer neglected his duty when he failed to prepare a report of a request for a private person's arrest. **The officer received a written reprimand and was retrained.**
2. An officer was in violation of Department policies, procedures and training regarding the LoJack stolen vehicle detection process and felony vehicle stops when he unlawfully detained, handcuffed and arrested the complainant. Had the officer followed procedures, the unlawful arrest would not have occurred. The officer was also in violation of DGO 5.03 when he failed to issue a Certificate of Release to the complainant. **The officer received a written reprimand and was retrained.**
3. In violation of DGO 1.03 (l) (A) (5) (d), Duties of Patrol Officers, Attention to Duty, DGO 9.06. section III. B., Vehicle Tows, an officer failed to fully complete an inventory of a towed vehicle when he towed the complainant's vehicle pursuant to a criminal investigation. **The officer was admonished and retrained.**
4. In violation of DGO 2.01, General Rules of Conduct, Rules 9, Misconduct, and 14, Public Courtesy, an officer used harsh and discourteous language when he and his partner conducted a "well-being" check of complainant's home in response to a neighbor's call identifying the complainant's home as one where a man and woman were possibly in an altercation. After the officers conducted the sweep, they learned the neighbor incorrectly identified the complainant's home as one where there were people fighting as no one else was present in the complainant's home. During the check, the complainant was agitated and

confused about police presence in his home, and rather than the officer patiently explaining that he was responding to a domestic violence call and needed to do a sweep, told the complainant, “Shut up and listen to me,” and “Shut up, I’m done with you.” **The officer was admonished and retrained.**

5. In violation of DGO 5.20, Language Access Services for Limited English Proficient Persons (LEP), officers failed to obtain a Cantonese interpreter for complainant, who was the driver, in a pedestrian/automobile accident. The pedestrian did not appear to be injured and the complainant was cited for talking on her cell phone while driving. While the officers claimed no interpreter was needed, one of the officers, during his OCC interview, admitted the complainant was speaking in “broken English” and that they used the complainant’s juvenile sons and one of the complainant’s friends to interpret. Moreover, the call from the Department of Emergency Management was through a Cantonese interpreter. The officers responded to the call with this knowledge. **The officers were admonished and retrained.**

6. In violation of DGO 6.09, Domestic Violence, an officer failed to properly investigate the complainant’s allegations that her husband violently attacked her when she told him she was filing for a divorce. The officer failed to arrest the complainant’s husband despite evidence supporting probable cause including that the husband had assaulted the complainant by threatening her, had battered the complainant by twisting her thumb, and had taken her phone and erased evidence to prevent the complainant from reporting the husband’s abuse to law enforcement in violation of Penal Code section 591.5. **The officer was suspended.**

In May, 2016, then Chief Gregory P. Suhr made findings and proposed discipline in two cases and Interim Chief of Police Toney Chaplin proposed discipline in one case investigated by the OCC and determined by the OCC Director Joyce M. Hicks to have sustainable allegations. The OCC’s findings and the Chief’s proposed discipline are as follows:

1. In violation of DGO 5.20, Language Access Services for Limited English Proficient Persons (LEP), an officer failed to advise the complainant of her right to a Russian-speaking interpreter causing him to provide inadequate police services to the complainant. **The officer was admonished and retrained.**

2. A sergeant was sustained for three counts of neglect of duty as follows:
 - a. Seizing a cell phone belonging to the complainant but failing to prepare a property receipt form and to issue the complainant a property receipt in a timely manner, in violation of DGO 6.15, property processing.
 - b. Handcuffing the complainant but failed to issue him a Certificate of Release, in violation of DGO 5.03.
 - c. Failing to properly process property by seizing a cell phone belonging to the complainant but not documenting the seizure of this evidence or establishing and documenting a chain of custody, in violation of DGO 6.02 and the SFPD Field Training Manual.

The sergeant received a written reprimand and retraining.

3. In violation of DGOs 1.03 and 2.01 an officer failed to investigate and failed to make required written reports of a crime or incident requiring police attention. Complainant complained that the complained of officer inadequately responded to her request for assistance after in her absence and on civil standby other officers permitted her ex-boyfriend into her apartment and he took her property. The complained of officer admitted the complainant told him that her ex-boyfriend had taken some of her belongings during a civil standby. Instead of investigating the complainant's allegation of theft, the officer referred her to the district station and to the OCC. The officer failed to investigate the alleged theft of the complainant's property and failed to document the incident in an incident report. **The officer received a written reprimand and retraining.**

In June, 2016, Acting Chief of Police Toney Chaplin proposed discipline in seven (7) cases investigated by the OCC and determined by the OCC Director Joyce M. Hicks to have sustainable allegations. The OCC's findings and the Chief's proposed discipline are as follows:

1. In violation of DGO 5.08, when plainclothes officers issued the citation for double parking, the officers failed to immediately request a marked backup unit. Also in violation of 5.08, Non-Uniformed Officers, two plainclothes officers issued a traffic citation for double-parking on 7th Street close to Market Street.

The officers received written reprimands and retraining. The OCC also recommended a written reprimand and retraining for one officer who had no previous history of discipline but the OCC recommended a one-day suspension and retraining for the officer because the officer had previously been admonished for violating DGO 5.08.

2. The sustained allegations arose from a probation search of the complainant and his wife. Allegations were sustained against an inspector and a sergeant as follows:
 - a. In violation of DGO 7.04, Children of Arrested Parents, the sergeant failed to document and could not recall whether he advised FCS of a 14-year old in the home.
 - b. In violation of DGO 5.03, Certificate of Release, the sergeant failed to retain the certificates of release.
 - c. In violation of DGO 6.15, Property Processing, the sergeant and inspector failed to properly document the seizure of cash.
 - d. In violation of DGO 2.01, Written Reports, the sergeant wrote an inaccurate report.

The sergeant and the inspector each received a written reprimand and retraining. The OCC also recommended a written reprimand for the inspector and the OCC recommended a two-day suspension for the sergeant.

3. The sustained allegations arose from a contact between two sergeants and one of the complainants after the officers saw the complainant push someone.
 - a. In violation of DGO 6.15, Property Processing, a sergeant failed to return complainant's money when there was no evidence it was contraband.
 - b. In violation of DGO 1.04, the sergeant failed to properly supervise.
 - c. In violation of DGO 2.01, the sergeant failed to maintain knowledge.
 - d. In violation of Department Bulletins 14-205, Report Writing, and 14-206, Supervisor Report Writing Responsibilities, the sergeant wrote an inaccurate and incomplete incident report.
 - e. The sergeant's platoon commander, another supervisor, failed to properly supervise.
 - f. The sergeant searched a vehicle in violation of the Fourth Amendment of the United States Constitution.
 - g. In violation of DGO 2.01, Rule 14, Discourtesy, the sergeant used profanity

The first sergeant received a two-day suspension. The second sergeant received a written reprimand. The OCC recommended 3-days suspension for the first sergeant and a written reprimand for the second sergeant.

4. In violation of DGO 2.01 and the Report Writing Manual, an officer wrote an inaccurate and incomplete traffic collision report. **The officer received an admonishment and retraining. The OCC recommended a written reprimand.**

5. In violation of DGO 2.01 and the Report Writing Manual, an officer wrote an inaccurate and incomplete traffic collision report. **The officer received an admonishment and retraining. The OCC recommended a written reprimand.**
6. In violation of DGO 5.04, Arrests by Private Persons, an officer failed to prepare an incident report documenting that the complainant had requested a private person's arrest. **The officer received a written reprimand and retraining. The OCC also recommended a written reprimand.**
7. In violation of DGO 5.03, Investigative Detentions, paragraph A, Certificate of Release, an officer failed to issue the complainant a certificate of release after detaining the complainant for over an hour. **The officer received a one-day suspension. The OCC also recommended a one-day suspension due to the officer's previous history of discipline.**

IV. COMPLAINTS OF NOTE

A. Officer-Involved Shootings

In the second quarter 2016, the OCC received two (2) officer-involved shooting complaints which resulted in the death of the suspects; one involving Luis Gongora and one involving Jessica Williams. Four (4) officer-involved shooting complaints remained open at the end of the second quarter 2016. The OCC continued to investigate the Amilcar Perez-Lopez and the Mario Woods officer-involved shootings, both of which resulted in the death of the subjects.

B. SFPD Department General Order 5.15, Enforcement of Immigration Laws, Related Complaint

In the second quarter 2016, the OCC received a complaint regarding a Limited English Proficient man who was taken into custody by two Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents outside a police station immediately after being released by SFPD.

C. Destruction of Homeless Encampment at 18th and Shotwell Streets

In the second quarter 2016, the OCC received a complaint regarding the destruction of homeless encampment at 18th and Shotwell Streets. The complainant alleged that the San Francisco Police Department targeted members of the homeless encampment to intimidate those who witnessed the shooting of Luis Gongora.

D. Facebook Posting by One of the Officers who Shot and Killed Alejandro Nieto

At the end of the second quarter 2016, the OCC continued to investigate a complaint regarding one of the officers who shot and killed Alejandro Nieto. After a federal jury found that the officers did not use excessive force when they shot and killed Alejandro Nieto in 2014, one of the officers involved in the shooting allegedly posted a comment on his Facebook stating, “Smiling. Ugh how about burning down his house and tazing his friend who pressed charges.”

E. SFPD’s Detention of a Disabled Man With Prosthetic Leg

At the end of the second quarter 2016, the OCC continued to investigate complaints regarding SFPD’s detention of a man with prosthetic leg. An 11-minute video of the incident was posted on numerous websites.

F. Single Room Occupancy Hotels

At the end of the second quarter 2016, the OCC continued to investigate two complaints filed in 2011 involving multiple officers regarding unlawful entries and searches of single room occupancy (SRO) hotel rooms. Other allegations in these complaints include unlawful search of persons, unlawful detentions and arrests, failure to properly process property including laptops and cameras, failure to investigate, failure to supervise and inappropriate behavior.

G. San Francisco Woman Shot and Killed by Her Ex-boyfriend

At the end of the second quarter 2016, the OCC continued to investigate a complaint regarding a San Francisco woman who was shot and killed by her ex-boyfriend before he fatally turned the gun on himself. The woman was shot in her home where there were a series of calls for help involving the same address.

H. Racist and Homophobic Text Messages by Members of the San Francisco Police Department

At the end of the second quarter 2016, the OCC continued to investigate a complaint regarding racist and homophobic text messages by members of the San Francisco Police Department.

V. STATUS OF CURRENT OCC CASES – THE ‘KEANE’ REPORT

By the end of the 2016 second quarter, staff had completed intake on all its 2015 cases and had closed 76% of them, leaving 25% of the 2015 cases pending. At the end of the 2015 first quarter, staff had also completed intake on all its 2014 cases and had closed 85% of them, leaving 15% of the 2014 cases pending

VI. LEGAL UNIT

Five attorneys staff the OCC's Legal Unit under the supervision of Executive Director Joyce Hicks. Attorneys Ines Vargas Fraenkel and R. Manuel Fortes are the OCC's two trial attorneys but they also conduct sustainability reviews and review sustained reports for form and legality, prepare legal opinions and manage records requests including subpoenas, Pitchess motions and Sunshine Ordinance and Public Records Act requests. Attorney Donna Salazar staffs the OCC's mediation and outreach programs and her work is outlined in sections VII and VIII of this report. Attorney Samara Marion conducts the OCC's policy work and also conducts sustainability reviews and reviews sustained reports for form and legality. Her policy work is outlined in section IX. The fifth attorney, John Alden, began his tenure toward the end of the second quarter. His work includes providing training to the investigators, conducting sustainability reviews and reviewing sustained reports for form and legality, preparing legal opinions, and providing policy analysis.

During the second quarter, the Legal Unit reviewed, revised, and submitted seven (7) sustained reports for approval by the OCC Director, each of which involved one or more sustained allegations against one or more officers. Additionally, Deputy Director Erick Baltazar reviewed, revised and submitted seven (7) sustained reports for approval by the OCC Executive Director.

The OCC's trial attorneys prosecute police misconduct cases in matters investigated and determined by the OCC to be misconduct or failure to perform a required action. They present cases to the Police Chief when officers object to proposed discipline of up to ten days suspension. They present cases before the Police Commission when the proposed discipline is greater than ten days suspension up through termination.

During the second quarter, Attorney Fortes defended two cases on appeal involving two (2) officers at the Chief's Hearing level as follows:

Case number 1

Facts:

The officer investigated a call regarding a graffiti incident. He detained a juvenile female. He failed to request a female officer to search the female. He failed to use a Spanish translator and failed to provide the starting and end mileage when transporting the juvenile to CARC.

Allegation:

1) ND for violation of DGO 1.03, Duties of Patrol Officers for failure to notify Communications Division when he arrived at the scene; 2) ND for violation of

DGO 5.20, Language Access Services; and, 3) ND Violation of DGO 7.01, Juvenile Detention procedures.

Discipline Imposed:

The officer received a disciplinary reprimand and order for retraining, which were confirmed after the Chief's Hearings.

Case number 2

Facts:

The officer responded to a battery call in front of a hotel. He failed to properly investigate the incident and provide assistance to the complainant. He told the complainant that he would collect video evidence and prepare an incident report, but did neither.

Allegations:

1) ND for violation of DGO 2.01, Rule 1 – Attention to Duty, Rule 9 - Misconduct, and Rule 25, written reports; 2) ND for violation of DGO 1.03, failure to make a report; and, 3) ND for violation of DGO 5.04, failure to make an arrest by a private person.

Discipline Imposed:

The officer received a disciplinary reprimand, which was confirmed after the Chief's Hearings.

VII. MEDIATION

During the second quarter of 2016, the OCC mediated 13 cases, a 9% mediation rate compared to 12 cases in 2015, an 8% mediation rate.

During this quarter, Ms. Salazar was contacted by the Columbus Ohio Police Department regarding the possibility of initiating a police/citizen mediation program in that jurisdiction. The Mediation Coordinator also met with staff from the Department of Justice's Community Relations Service to discuss police/citizen mediation programs.

The Mediation Program continues to provide a forum for officers and civilians to have a frank discussion regarding the complaint, as well as serves as an educational experience for all participants.

VIII. OUTREACH

During the second quarter of 2016, the OCC was engaged in local outreach activities as well as networking with other agencies on a state and national level.

The Director and members of the OCC staff attend all Police Commission meetings. In addition to the regular meetings during the second quarter of 2016, there were several special meetings held in Chinatown, Ingleside, and the Western Addition neighborhoods regarding proposals for amending the Department General Orders regulating use of force.

In May, the Director, staff attorneys and several investigators attended the Public Defender's Summit on use of force by law enforcement and less than lethal weapons.

The Deputy Director and Senior Investigators made presentations to a class of cadets and a class of PSAs at the San Francisco Police Academy during this quarter.

As stated in section VII, above, Mediation Coordinator, Donna Salazar, attended an event sponsored by the Peninsula Conflict Resolution Services on the use of ADR in improving race relations in communities, and a UC Berkeley Extension mediation class. Ms. Salazar also attended two community sessions, in the Western Addition and Visitation Valley neighborhoods. These were part of a continuing series of meetings sponsored by the Re-entry Counsel on Racial and Ethnic Disparities in various communities.

In June, Staff Attorney Manuel Fortes and Investigator Helen Calderon staffed a table at the Juneteenth Fair in the Fillmore District.

Additionally, Director Hicks and Attorney Fortes continued serving as members of the Bar Association of San Francisco Criminal Justice Task Force.

The OCC continues to be a resource for oversight agencies statewide and nationally. Agencies frequently consult with OCC regarding its unique model of civilian oversight, its police/citizen mediation program, its policy work regarding juveniles, language access, children of arrested parents and most recently, domestic violence.

IX. POLICY ANALYSIS

Policy work is an essential aspect of the Office of Citizen Complaint's mission. The San Francisco City Charter requires the OCC to present quarterly recommendations concerning SFPD's policies or practices that enhance police-community relations while ensuring effective police services. Policy attorney Samara Marion leads the OCC's policy work. During the second quarter the OCC proposed a Police Commission Resolution on the Police Department's collection, analysis, and reporting upon sexual assault forensic evidence that was unanimously adopted. The OCC worked extensively with community stakeholders and representatives from the

San Francisco Police Officers Association and submitted a draft Use of Force policy that the Police Commission unanimously adopted. The OCC also continued to advocate that the Police Department address the OCC's 19 recommendations it made in September 2015 in response to the President's Task Force on 21st Century Policing.

During the second quarter, the OCC worked to implement fully its August 2015 policy recommendations about the Police Department's sexual assault evidence protocols and communication with sexual assault survivors. The OCC's recommendations originated from its investigation of a sexual assault survivor's complaint that established that during a period of twenty-two months, the Department did not contact the complainant or provide her the results of DNA testing until she complained. The OCC worked with the Police Department's Special Victims and Forensic Units to assist in the drafting of Unit Orders to comply with the collection and analysis of sexual assault forensic evidence as outlined in Penal Code §680, the "Sexual Assault Victims' DNA Bill of Rights." In April, the OCC drafted proposed Police Commission Resolution 16-28 to require the Police Department to provide biannual written reports about its collection and analysis of sexual assault kit evidence and reporting of results to sexual assault survivors. On April 20, 2016, the Police Commission unanimously adopted Resolution 16-28, "Semiannual and Annual Report to the Police Commission about the Department's Collection and Analysis of Sexual Assault Kit Evidence and Reporting of Results to Sexual Assault Victims."

The OCC worked extensively on the proposed Use of Force policy throughout the second quarter. In a written memorandum to the Police Commission on April 6, 2016, the OCC provided recommendations and research addressing three core Use of Force principles: 1) minimal reliance on force; 2) mandatory use of de-escalation and other tactics when feasible before an officer's use of force; and 3) restricting an officer's pointing of a weapon at an individual to circumstances likely to escalate to requiring lethal force.

At the Police Commission hearing on May 4, 2016, the OCC recommended enhancing the proposed Use of Force policy by:

- Incorporating the introductory paragraph community stakeholders had previously submitted that emphasized safeguarding human life, rapport-building communication, crisis intervention, and de-escalation principles before resorting to force;
- Emphasizing minimal reliance on the use of force;
- Requiring de-escalation and use tactics before using force when feasible;
- Prohibiting shooting at vehicles unless the threatened deadly force is by a means other than the moving vehicle;
- Stressing proportionality as a use of force factor;

- Permitting officers to point a firearm at an individual only when the officer or another person is in danger of death or serious bodily injury;
- Including Crisis Intervention Team as first responders to mental health crisis calls;
- Stating that the reasonableness of an officer's use of force includes the Ninth Circuit and California Supreme Court factors;
- Requiring a supervisor to respond to incidents involving any weapon or significant use of force; and
- Requiring the Department to collect, analyze and report to the public detailed use of force data.

Following the Police Commission's issuance of two proposed versions of a consolidated Use of Force policy on May 30, 2016, the OCC worked closely with community stakeholders to draft a written response. On June 15, 2016, the OCC presented at the Police Commission hearing a line-edited version of DGO 5.01 (subsequently referred to as "2A") from community stakeholder representatives including the OCC, Bar Association of San Francisco, Bar Association of San Francisco, American Civil Liberties Union of Northern California, San Francisco Public Defenders Office, Coalition on Homelessness and Blue Ribbon Panel's Working Group on Use of Force and Officer Involved Shootings.

Shortly before the Commission's final vote on the Use of Force policy on June 22, 2016, the OCC and the Bar Association of San Francisco met with representatives of the San Francisco Police Officer Association about the proposed Use of Force versions. After extended negotiations, the OCC, Bar Association of San Francisco and the San Francisco Police Officer' Association provided the Police Commission a line-edited proposed Use of Force policy (Version Three) in which the OCC, the Bar Association and POA representatives reached agreement concerning 80% of the Use of Force provisions. Agreed upon provisions included that the Use of Force policy is more restrictive than the constitutional standard and state law and requires officers to use de-escalation and other tactics when feasible before resorting to force, to name a few. The parties could not reach agreement on three major provisions—carotid restraints, shooting at vehicles, and Penal Code sec. 835—and nine minor areas. After discussion and agreement about the twelve identified areas, the Police Commission voted unanimously to adopt Version Three. The Police Commission also requested the OCC's policy attorney serve as a subject matter expert during the meet and confer process with the San Francisco Police Officer Association.

In mid-June, the OCC re-initiated discussions with the Department on the OCC's Nineteen (19) Recommendations in Response to the President's Task Force on 21st Century Policing. In a September 2015 report provided to the Police Department and subsequently filed with the Police Commission, the OCC made the following recommendations:

- SFPD Should Incorporate Procedural Justice Language Into Its Department General Orders Such As DGOs 5.03 (Detentions), 5.17 (Biased Policing), and 2.01 (General Rules of Conduct) By Requiring Officers To Explain Why An Individual Has Been Detained Or Searched and Provide In Writing The Officer's Name, Contact Information, and the Complaint/Commendation Process.
- SFPD Should Design a Form To Collect Information on Use of Force Incidents Systematically and Electronically.
- SFPD Should Post Monthly Its Use of Force Data On Its Website.
- SFPD Should Analyze and Report Its Use of Force Data Annually to the Police Commission.
- SFPD Should Re-Examine its Policies, Training and Evaluation of Force Incidents In Light of the California Supreme Court Decision *Hayes v. San Diego* (2013) 57 Cal.4th 622.
- SFPD Should Post Monthly its Data Concerning Car, Bicycle and Pedestrian Stops on its Website.
- SFPD Should Analyze Its Data Concerning Car, Bicycle and Pedestrian Stops and Report Its Analysis of the Data Annually to the Police Commission.
- SFPD and OCC Should Meet Quarterly To Identify Training, Policy, and Procedure Recommendations Arising From Disciplinary Cases.
- SFPD Should Post Its Department Bulletins On Its Website.
- SFPD Should Institutionalize Its Practice of Holding a Community Meeting Following An Officer-Involved Shooting By Revising DGO 8.11.
- SFPD Should Partner With Youth Organizations To Make Presentations At Middle And High Schools On "Know Your Rights" For Youth.
- SFPD Should Provide More Resources To The CIT Program To Address Its Increased Training And Administrative Demands.
- SFPD Should Provide Interpreter Training to Bilingual Officers, Language Recertification For Bilingual Officers and Civilians, and Certification in Translation.

- SFPD Should Include Input From The OCC and Civilian Complaints When Evaluating The Effectiveness of Crime Fighting Strategies.
- SFPD Should Include The OCC In Its Development of a Non-Punitive Lessons Learned Approach to Reviewing Serious Incidents.
- SFPD Should Modify Its Written Consent to Search Policy to Include Consent Searches of the Person and the Person's Effects.
- SFPD Should Establish A Written Procedure For Searching Transgender Individuals.
- SFPD Should Incorporate Community Members Especially from African-American, Asian, Latino, Youth, Immigrant, Muslim, and LGBTQ Communities in the Development of Training Curriculum and as Presenters during Officer Training.
- SFPD Should Provide Recruits, Patrol Officers, Sergeants, and Field Training Officers Training Specific to Police Interactions with Youth.

X. CONCLUSION

Despite budget and staffing constraints, the OCC remained committed to its mission to investigate civilian complaints of police misconduct or failure to perform a duty promptly, fairly, and impartially. During this quarter the OCC redoubled its community outreach efforts and policy work to address the concerns of the public for greater transparency.

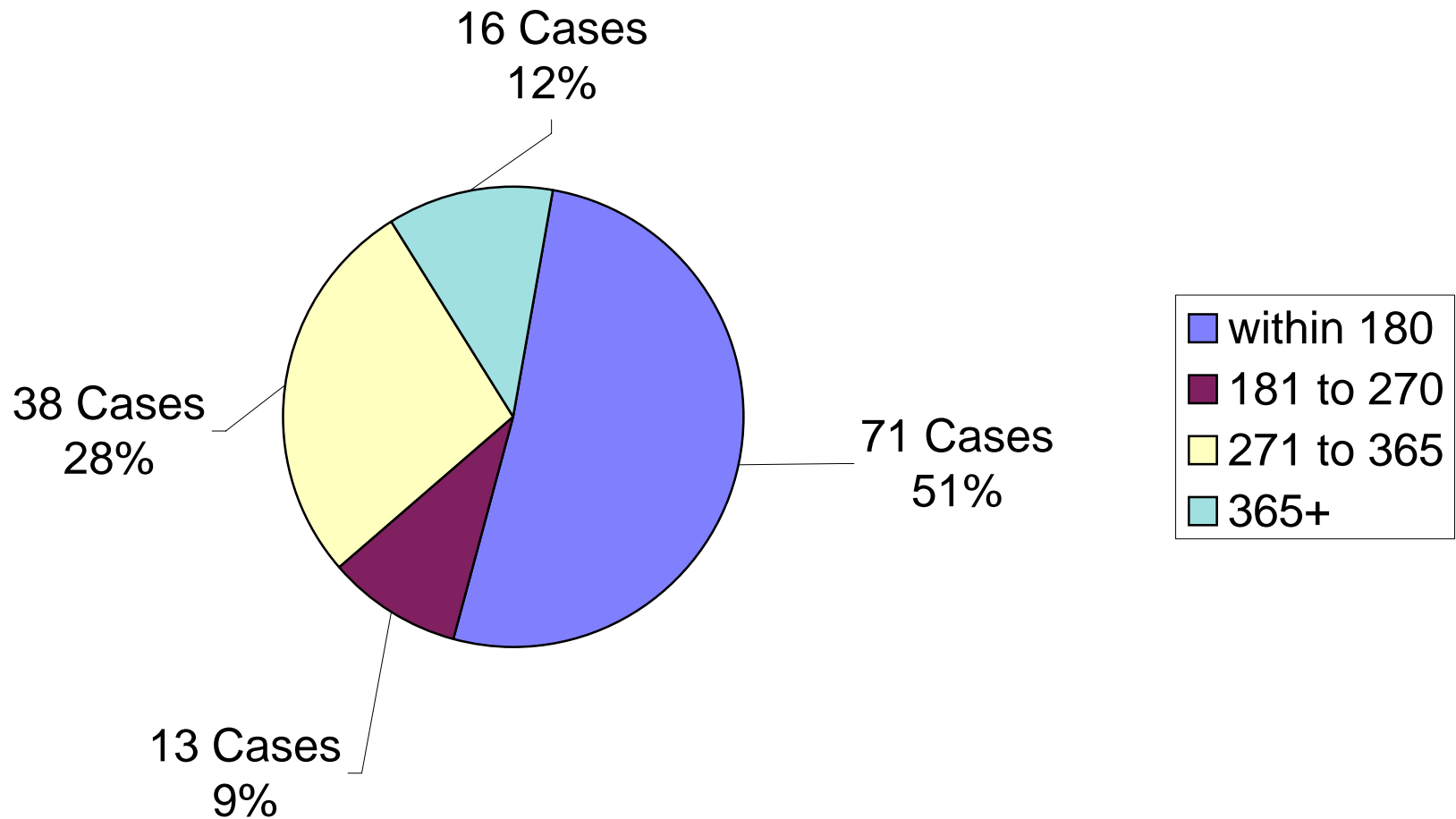

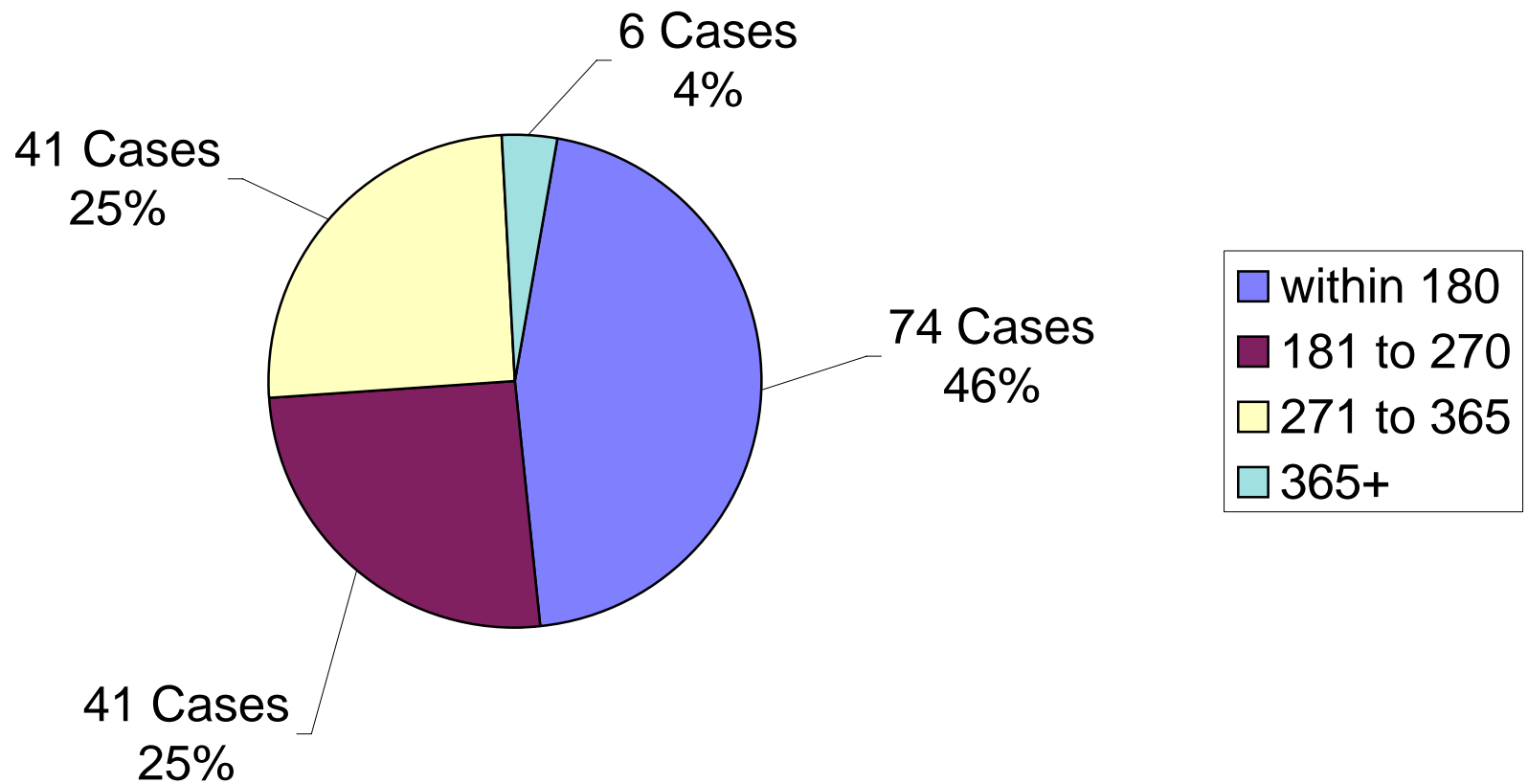

During the course of the investigation, the OCC queried the SFPD Legal Division to determine if the named officer complied with Department Bulletin 14-059 regarding collecting and recording traffic stop data information. The SFPD Legal Department replied that they had no document responsive to the OCC request even though the named officer stated that he had completed an E585 form.</p> <p>A San Francisco Police Department Subject Matter Expert (SME) was interviewed regarding Airport Bureau traffic stop data procedures for motorcycle officers. The SME stated that solo motorcycle officers are expected to complete the E585 “form” by hand and subsequently submit the form to the Records section at the airport where it is compiled. A member of the clerical staff then completes the data entry. Motorcycle officers at the airport do not have access to a Level II terminal and are not expected to enter the E585 data into the system themselves. According to the SME, the officers’ ability to comply with Department Bulletin 14-059 is limited or modified because when they complete the form they forward it to a location where the data entry is done by a clerk who has access to a Level II terminal. The form is entered into a spreadsheet by clerical staff and then emailed to the Planning Division of the Crime Analysis Unit.</p> <p>The OCC investigation revealed that there was a backlog of E585 forms at the Airport that have not been processed. The named officer completed the E585 form but it had not been processed due to the backlog. The OCC recommends the Department immediately address the backlog of E585 data entry at the Airport Bureau and institute a procedure at the Airport Bureau to ensure that stop data is entered no later than the end of the watch of the officer who collected the stop data.</p>

Days to Close - Cases Closed Second Quarter 2016



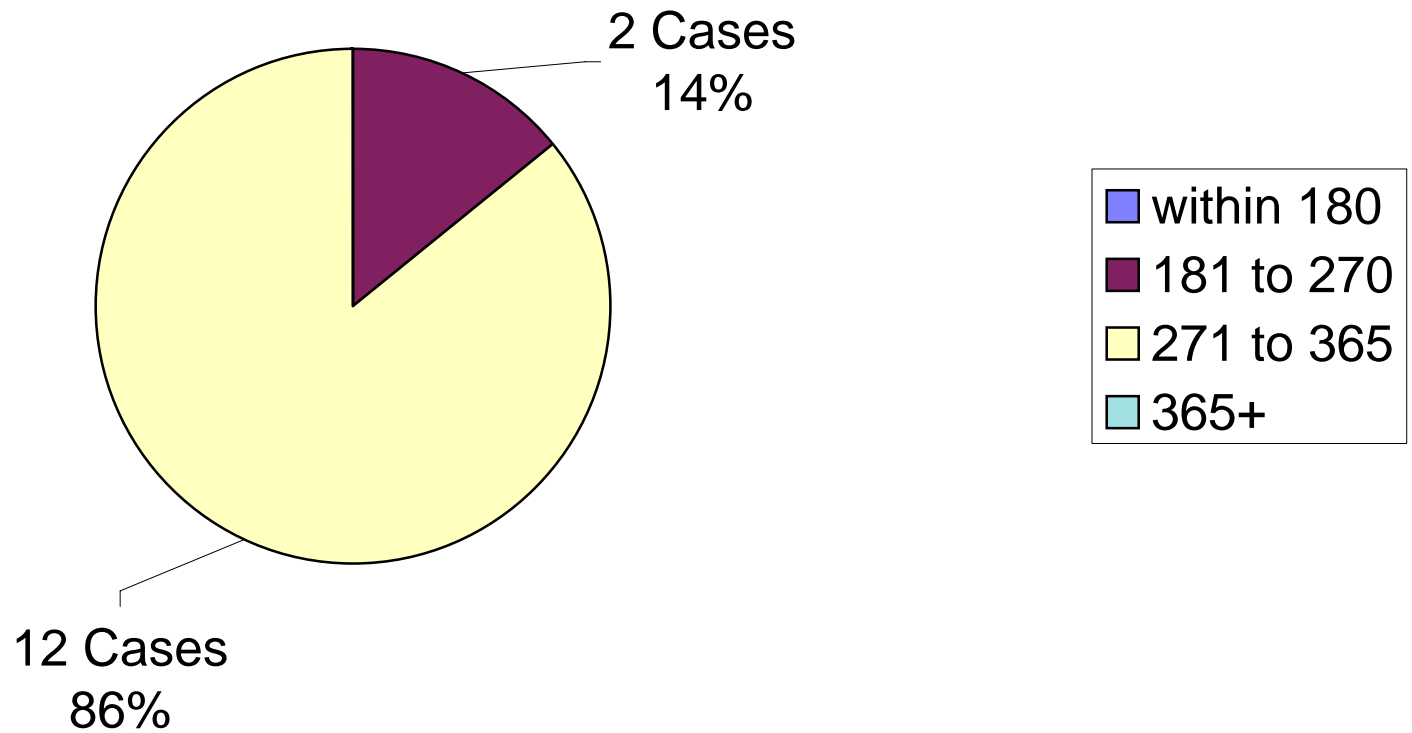

Days to Close - Cases Closed Second Quarter 2015



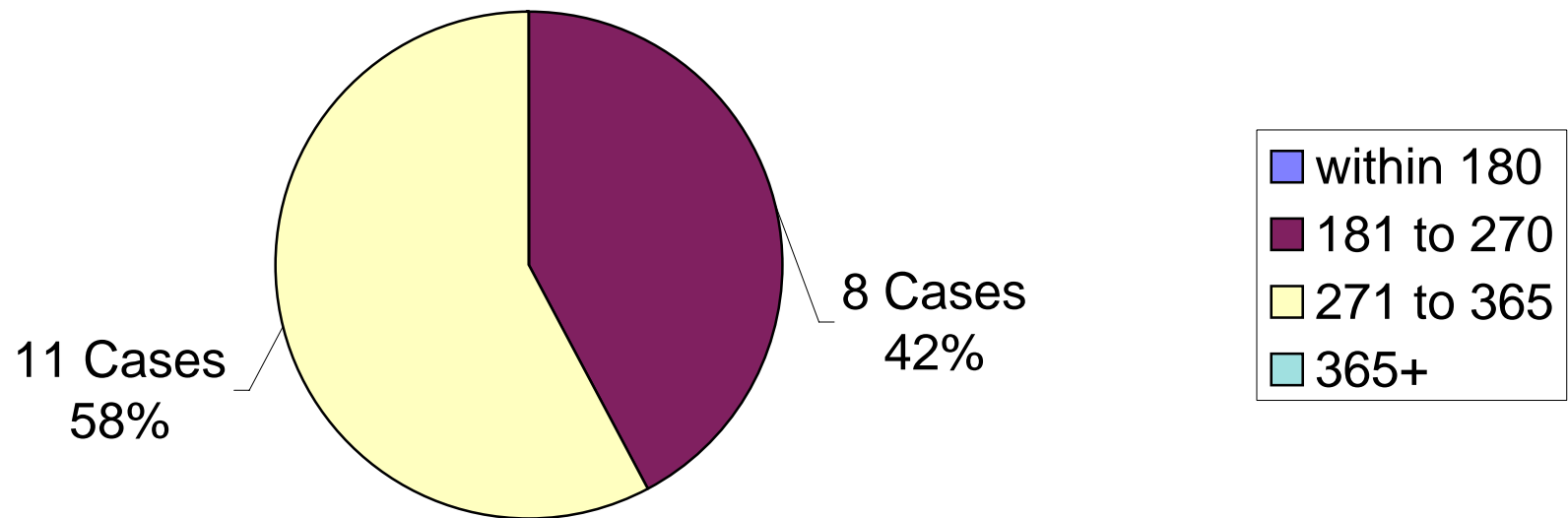

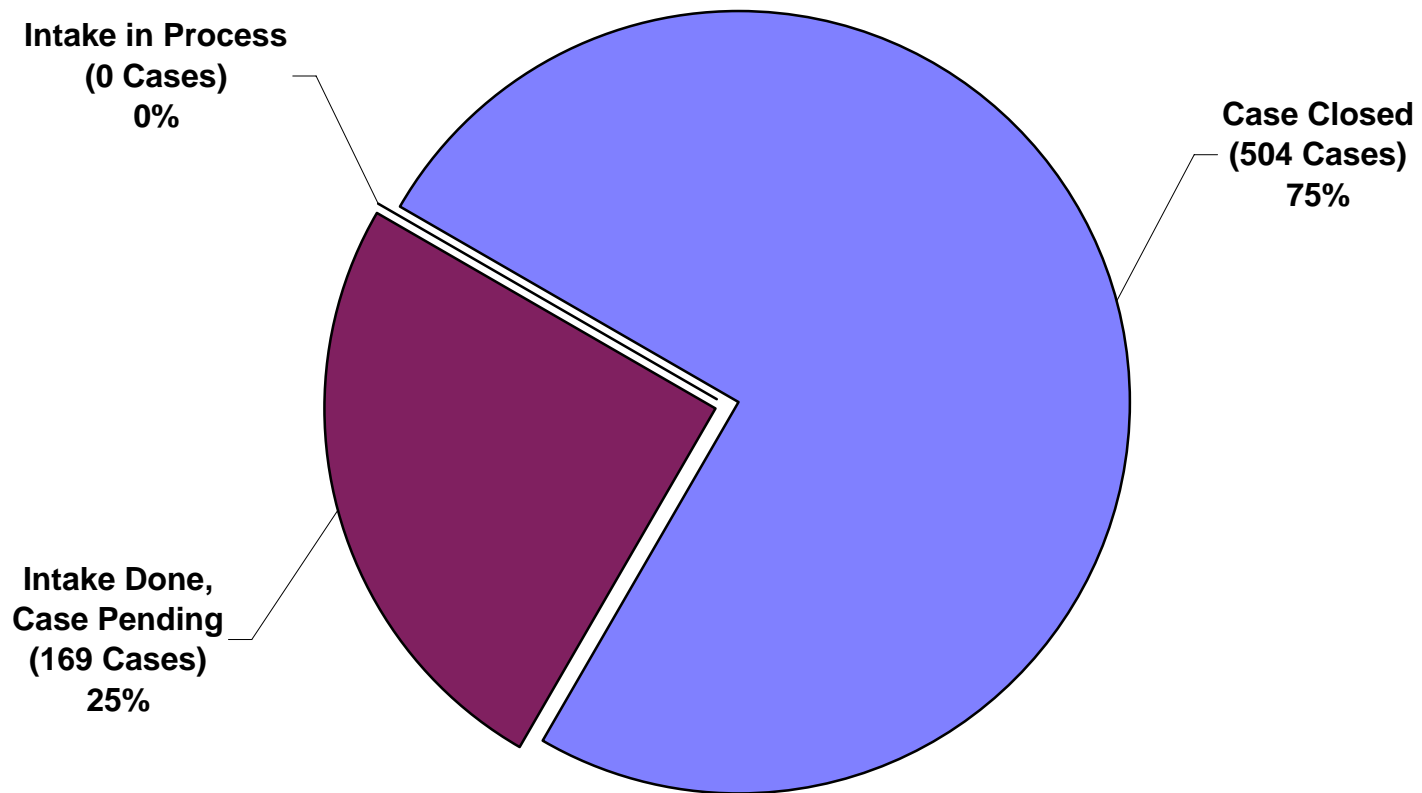

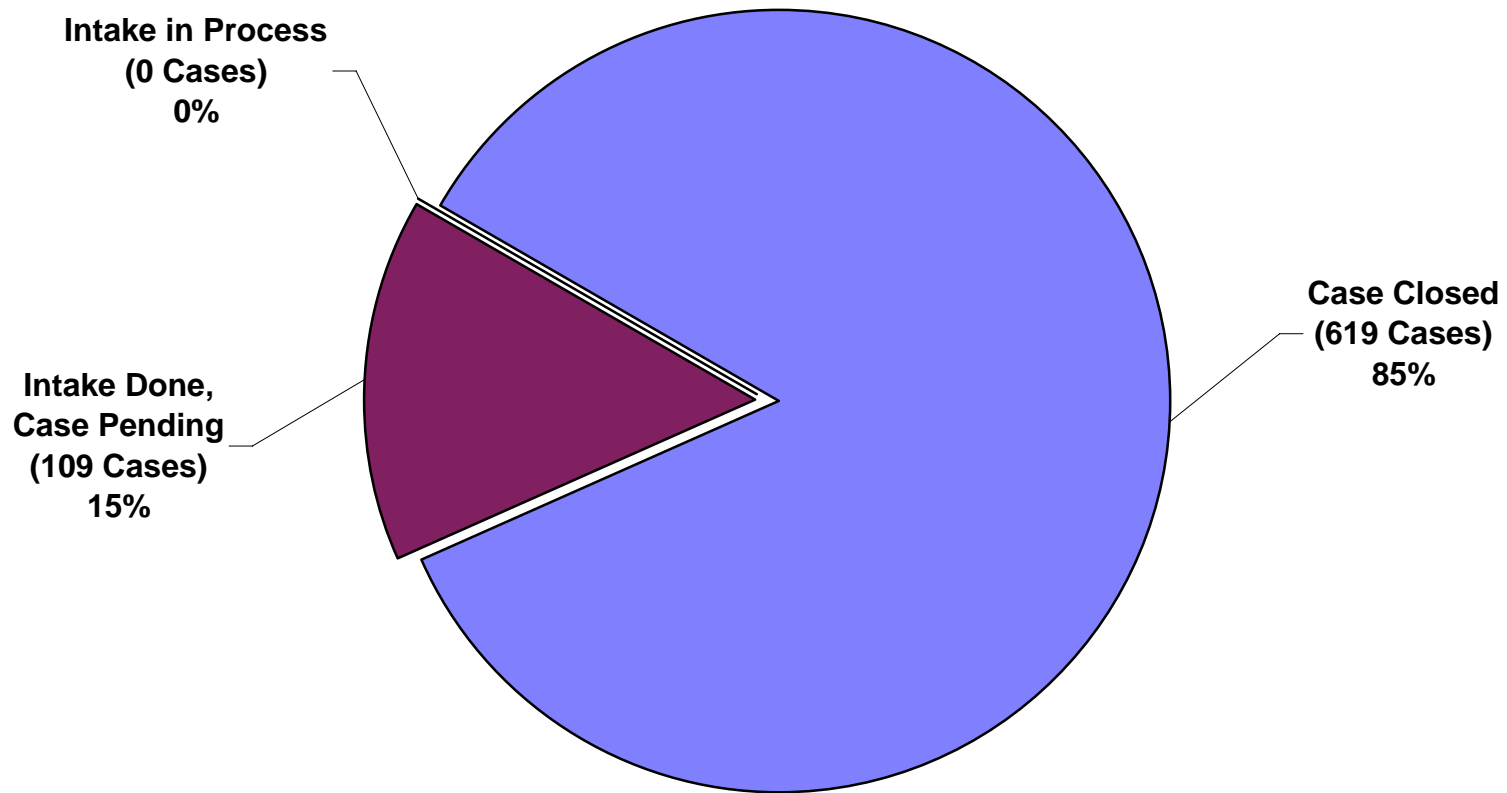
Status of OCC Cases - Year 2015

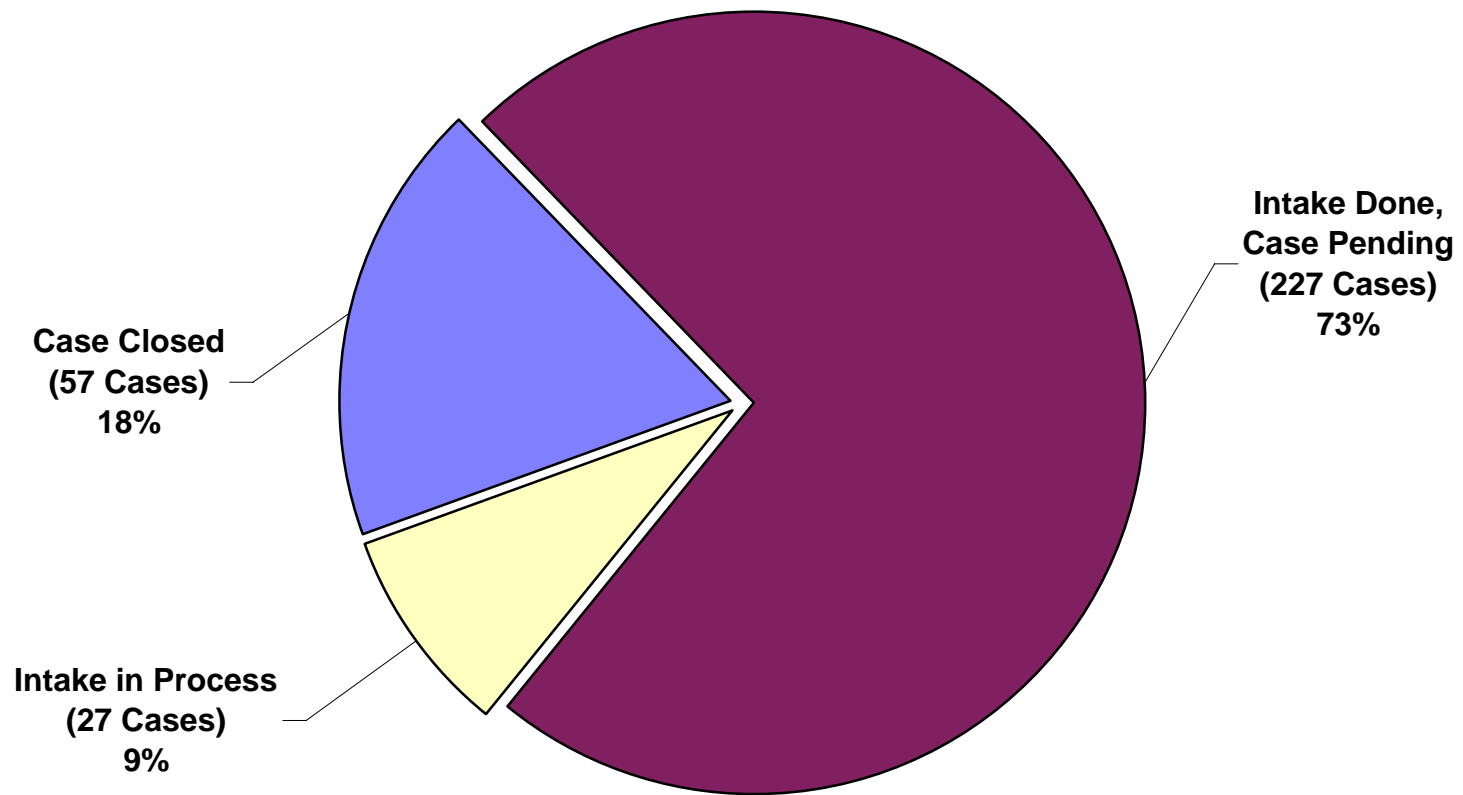

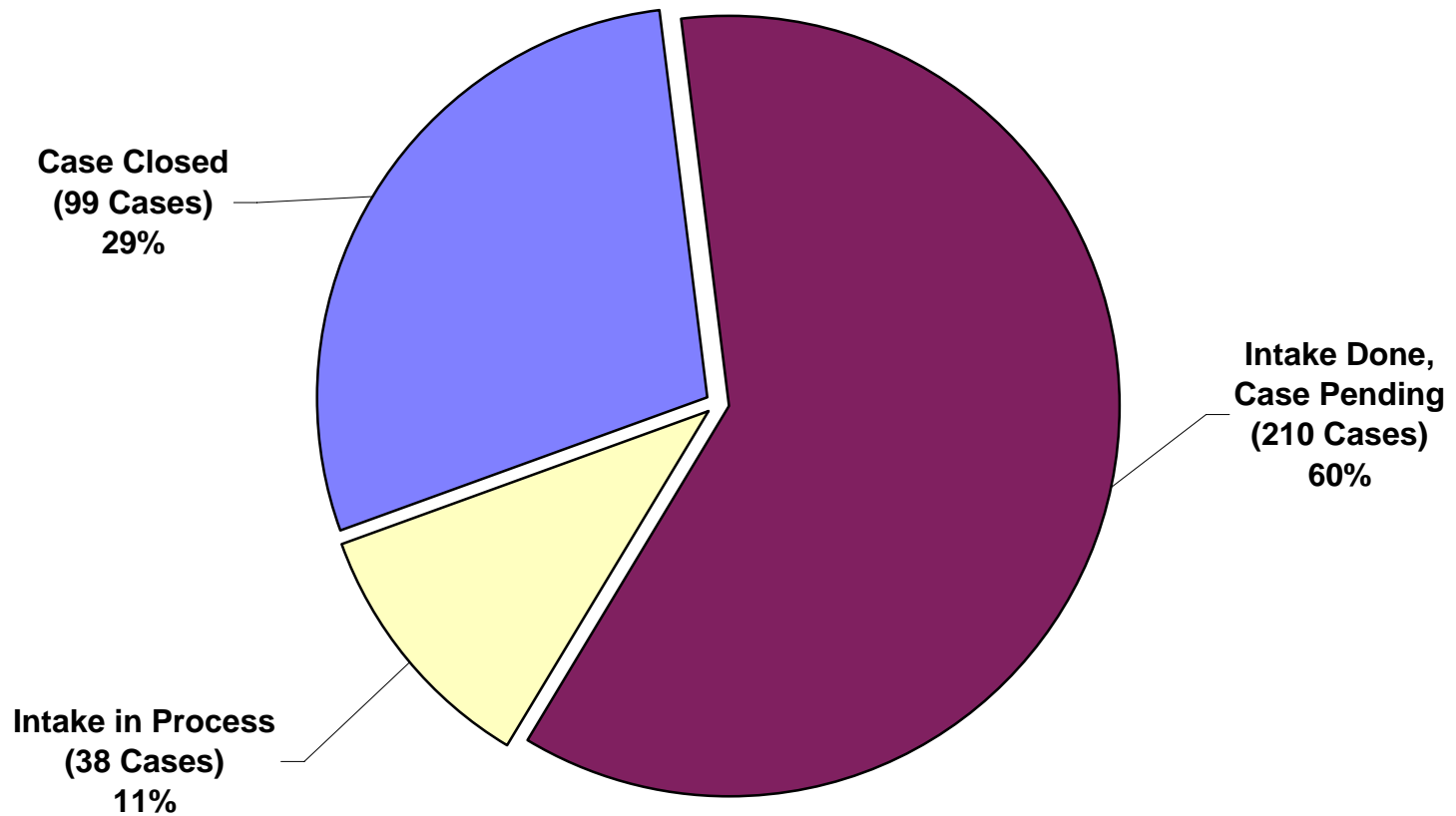
Status of OCC Cases - Year 2016

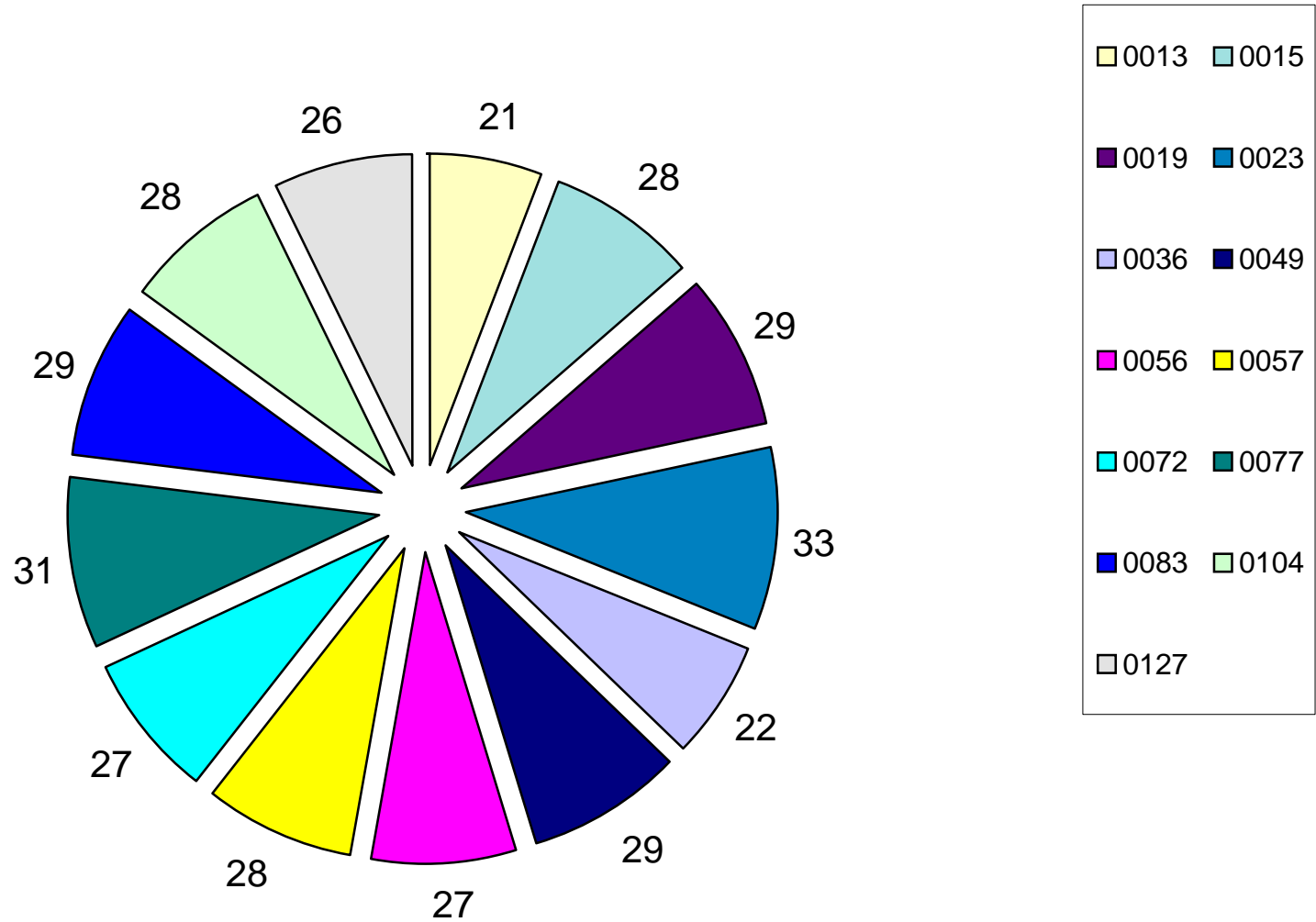

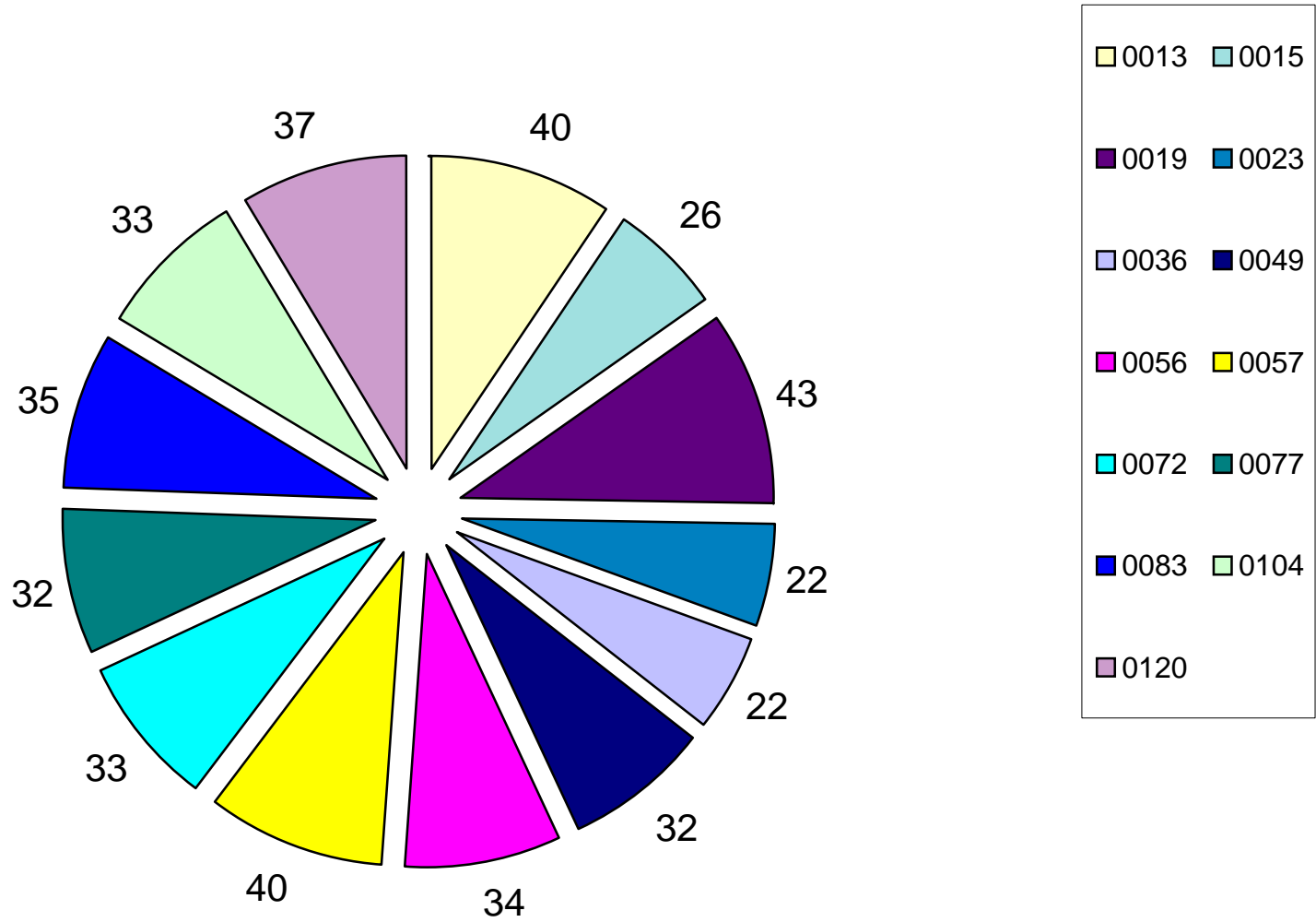

OCC Caseloads by Investigator as of 06/30/2016



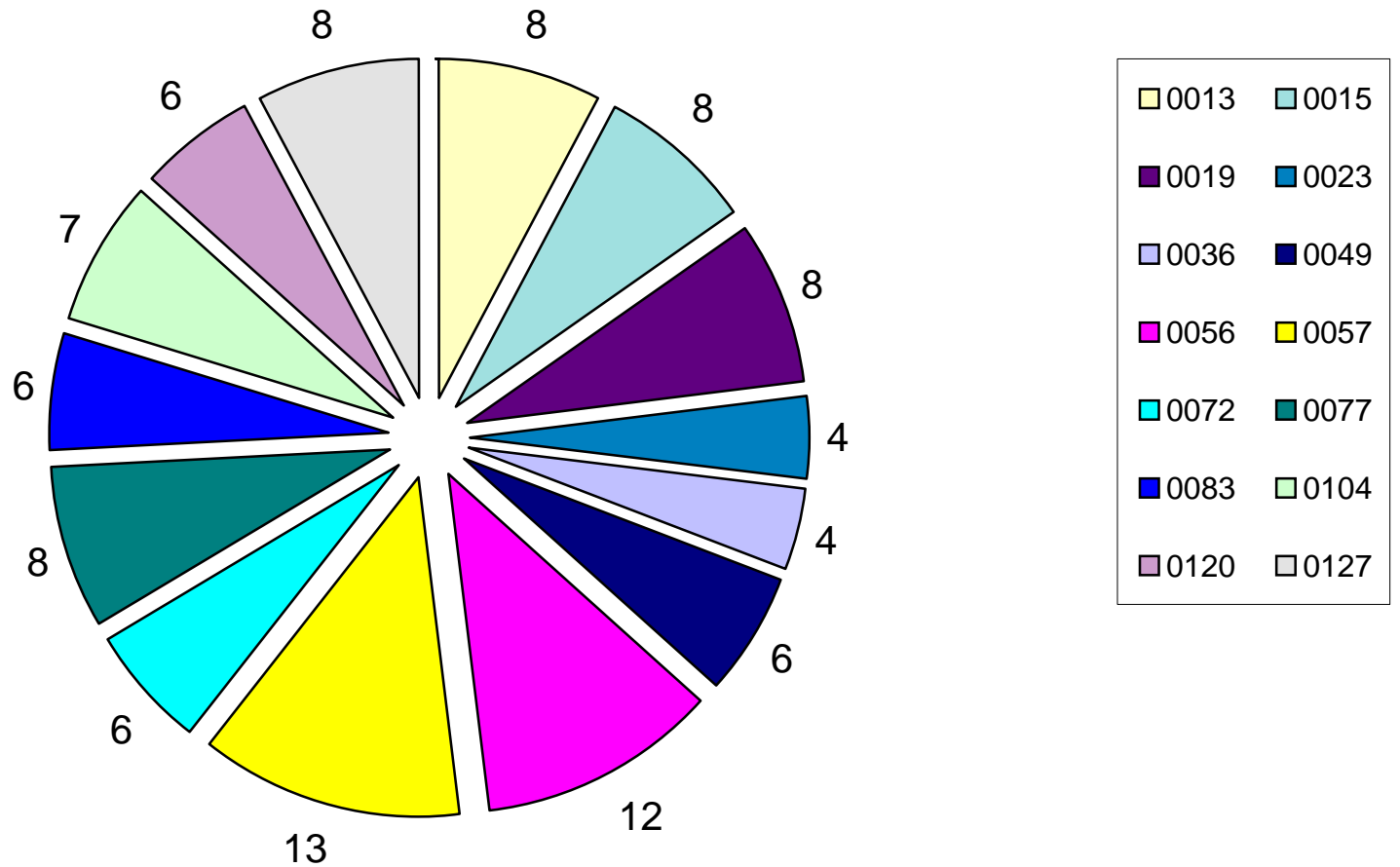

OCC Caseloads by Investigator as of 06/30/2015



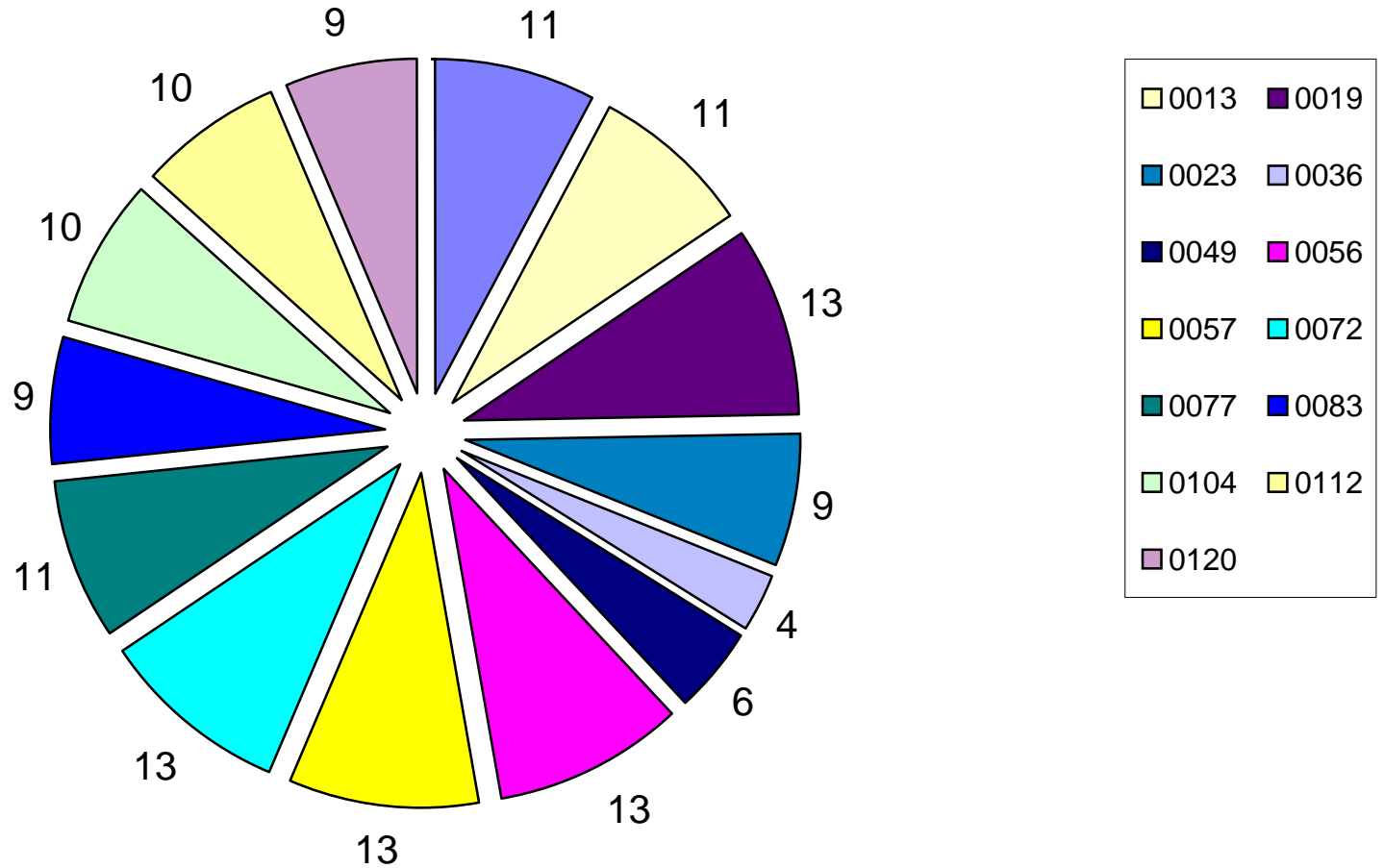

OCC Case Closures - Second Quarter 2016 by Investigator



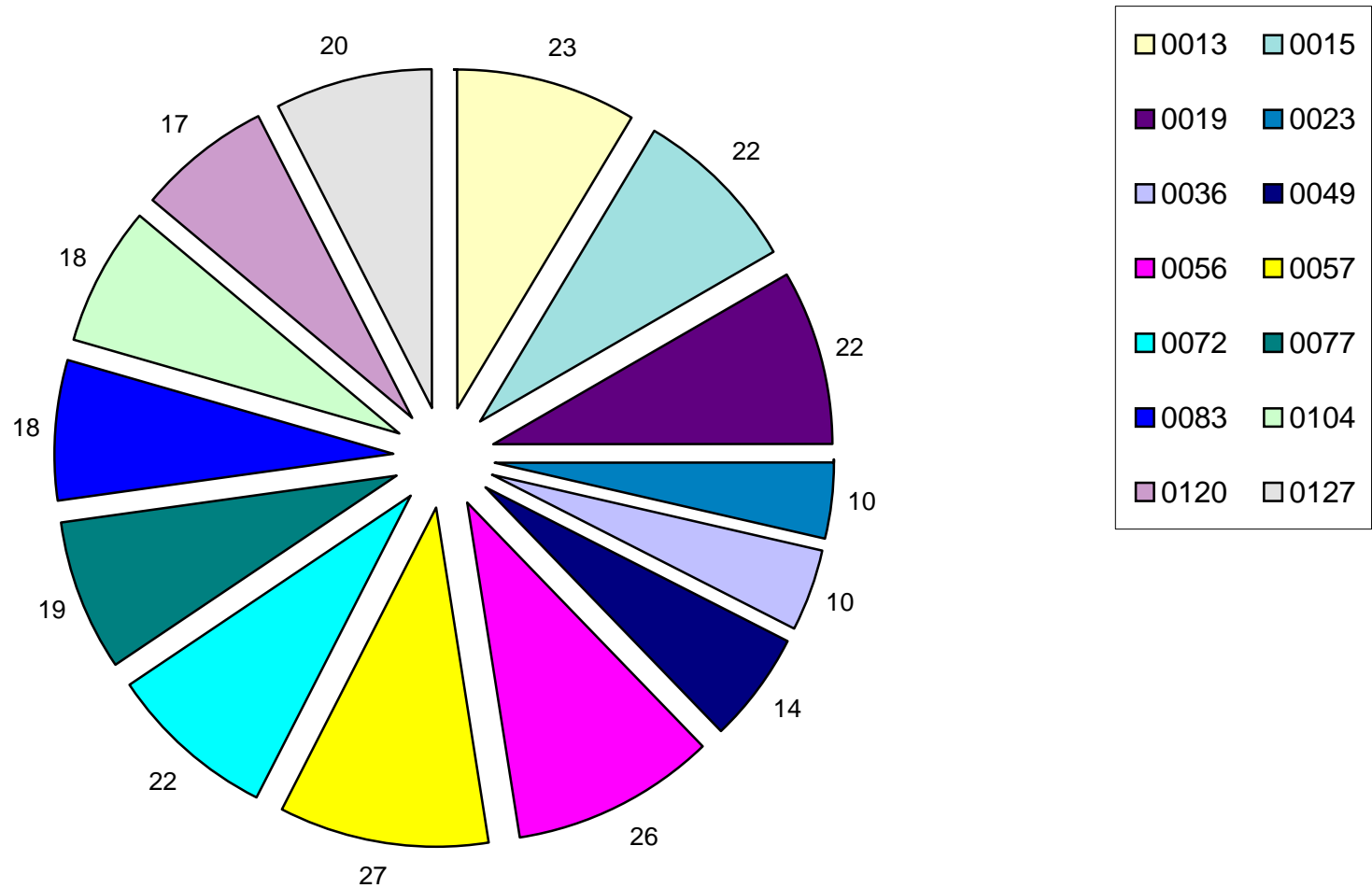

Average Case Closures by Number: 10 or 3 cases per month per investigator

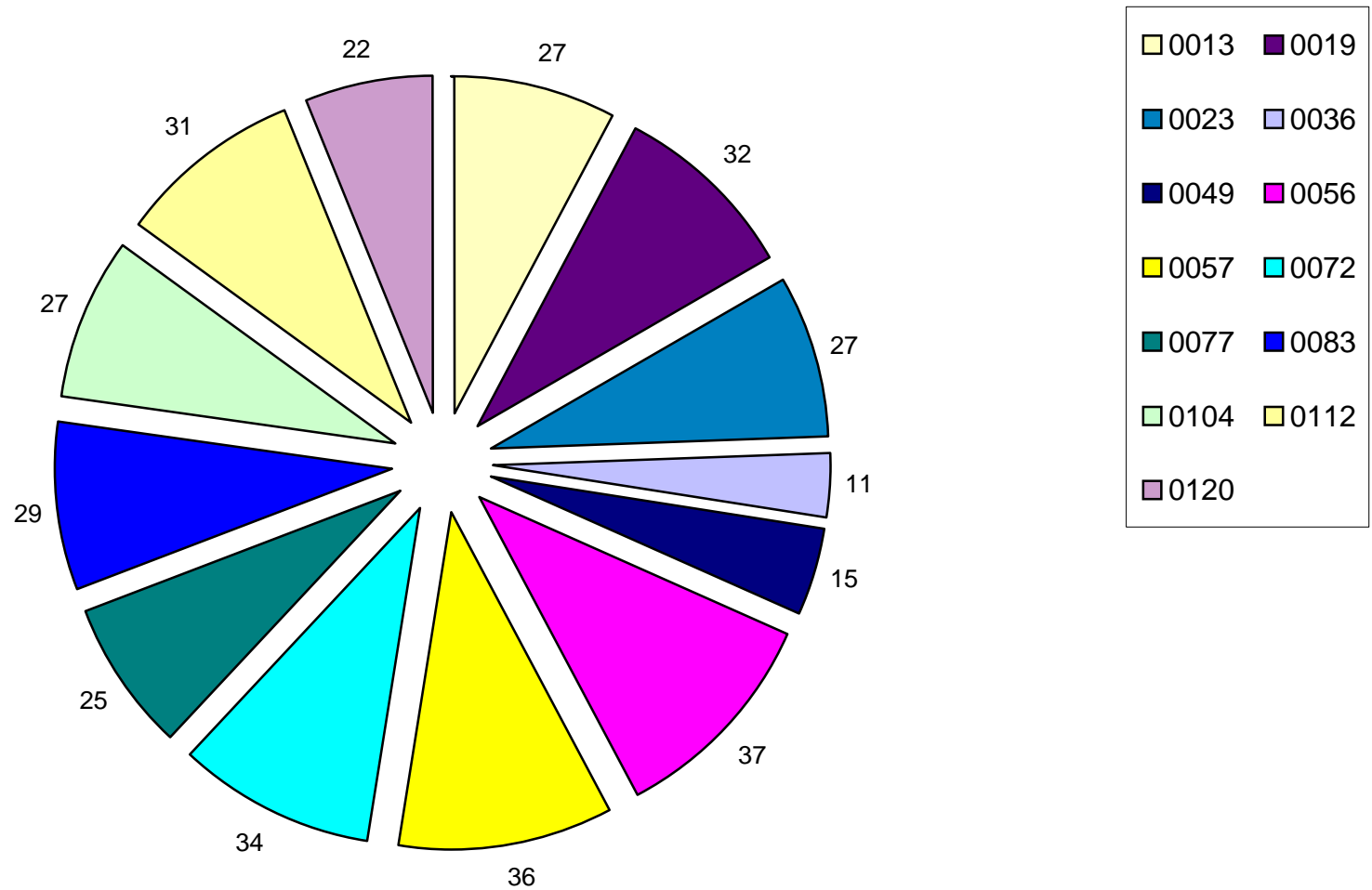
OCC Weighted Closures - Second Quarter 2016 by Investigator

CASE COMPLEXITY WEIGHTED ON A 1 TO 5 SCALE

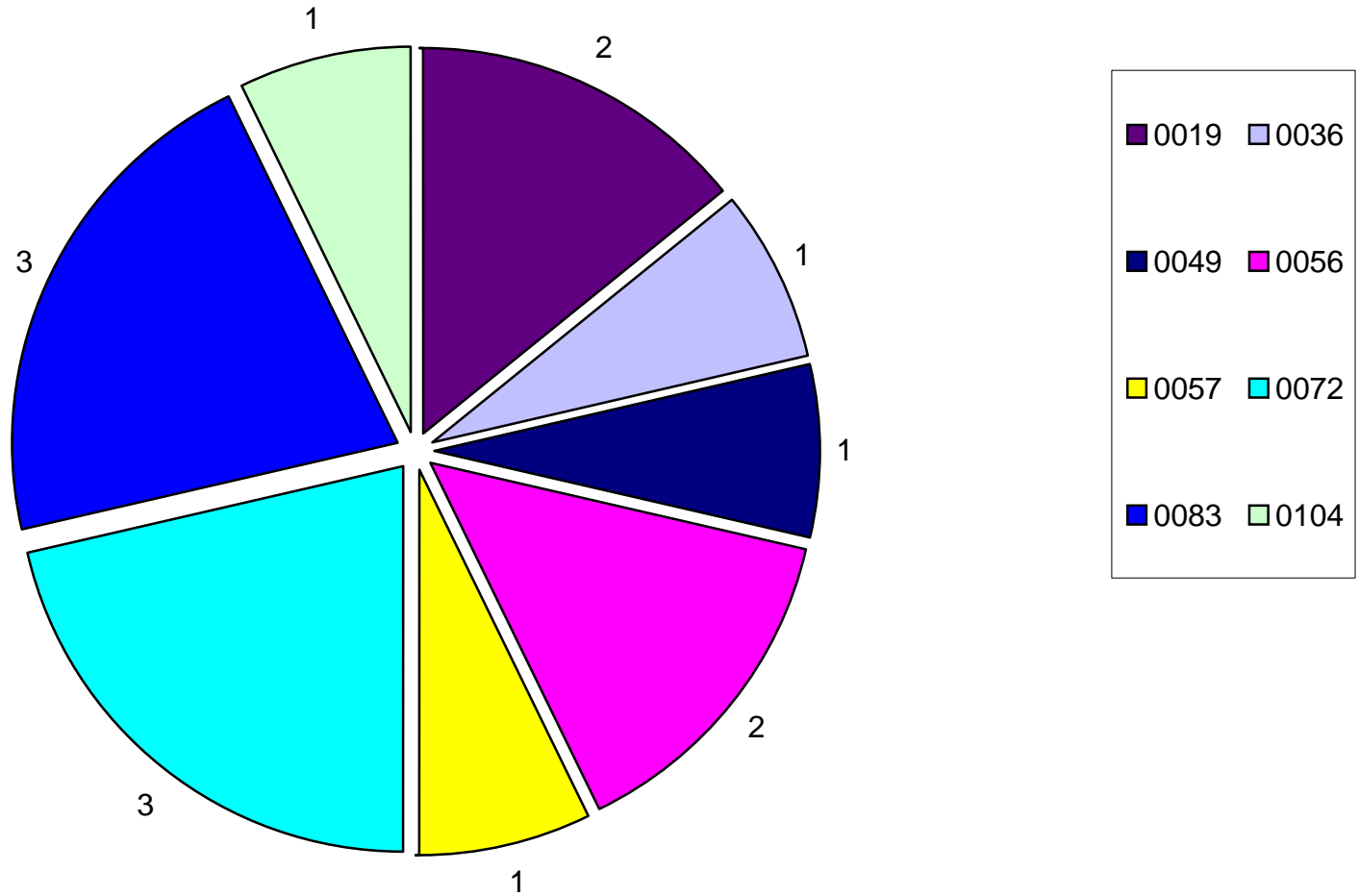
OCC Weighted Closures - Second Quarter 2015 by Investigator

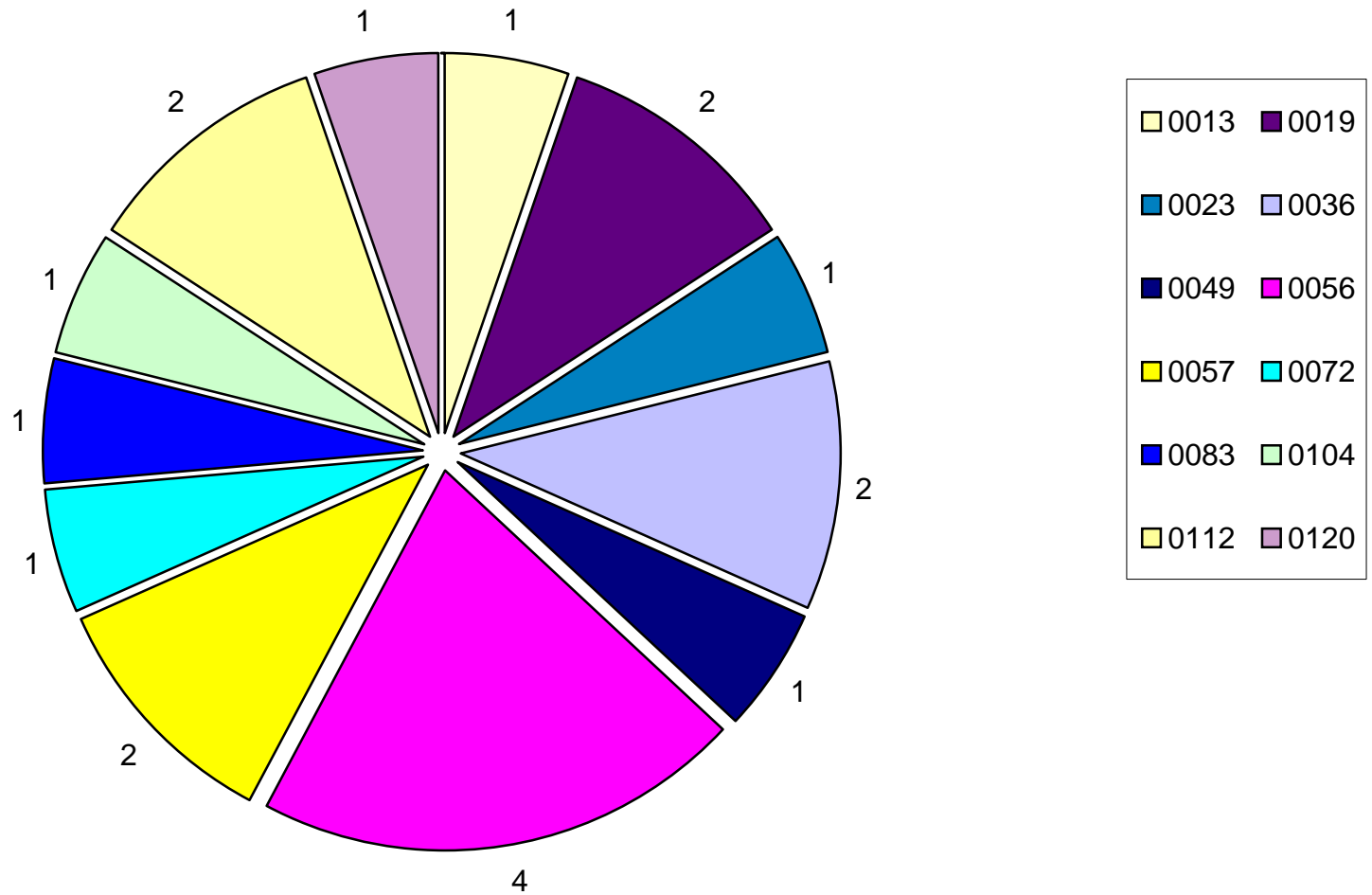
