



## Summary Comparison of Minimum Compensation Ordinance and Health Care Accountability Ordinance

The following chart is a **general** comparison of the two ordinances, including what contracts they apply to, what vendors they apply to, what employees they apply to, and what benefits they require. To keep the chart short and readable, the chart covers only the main points of comparison and omits a lot of detail.

<b>What are the required benefits for covered employees?</b>	The MCO requires Contractors to provide: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a minimum hourly gross compensation wage rate. The minimum wage rate may change from year to year and Contractor is obligated to keep informed of the then-current requirements. (Sec. 12P.3)</li> <li>• 12 days paid time off per year. (Sec. 12P.3(a)(2))</li> <li>• 10 days unpaid time off per year. (Sec. 12P.3(a)(3))</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For most covered employees, provide health coverage or <u>pay the City</u> \$4.50 per hour. (Sec. 12Q.3)</li> <li>• For covered employees who do not live in SF and do not provide services in SF, at the Airport, or at the San Bruno jail, provide health coverage or <u>pay the employee</u> \$4.50 per hour. (Sec. 12Q.3)</li> <li>• For employers that choose to make payments, the total payment per employee is not to exceed \$180 per week.</li> </ul>
<b>Who is a “covered employee”?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Works on the City contract at least 4 hours per week during the pay period in or outside of San Francisco or on property owned by the City. (Sec. 12P.2(i)) and not at San Francisco Intl. Airport.</li> <li>• Works on the City contract at least 10 hours during a 2-week pay period at San Francisco Airport. (Sec. 12P.4)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Works at least 20 hours per week in any month on the City contract. (Sec. 12Q.2.9)</li> </ul>

(Sec. 12P.2)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Service contracts lasting 1 year or more. Leases on City property within the San Francisco city limits and at the Airport. Contractors doing work for City tenants and subtenants. (Sec. 12Q.2.4(a) and (b)).</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>October 8, 2000</li> <li>Amendments: October 14, 2007</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>July 1, 2001</li> <li>Amendments: April 23, 2006</li> </ul>
