
If your child has as there are two important forms your child needs to have at school:

An ASTHMA EMERGENCY CARE PLAN must

be on file for all SFUSD students with asthma in K-12th grades. These plans tell school staff about your child's specific asthma triggers, medications, and what to do in an emergency.



- A MEDICATION FORM

is required to allow for your child to carry and use their asthma medicine at school.

PARENTS OF CHILDREN ATTENDING PRE-SCHOOL

in the SFUSD Child Development Program MUST contact their site manager directly to discuss asthma or any other healthcare needs.

Step 1 Get copies of the Asthma Emergency Care Plan and the Medication Form. Get the forms from your:

- School Packet
- School secretary
- School principal
- School nurse
- Download from www.sfgov.org/asthma



Step 2 Ask your child's medical provider to fill out and sign the forms.

Step 3 Take the signed forms back to the school OR ask your child's medical provider to fax them in to your school.
