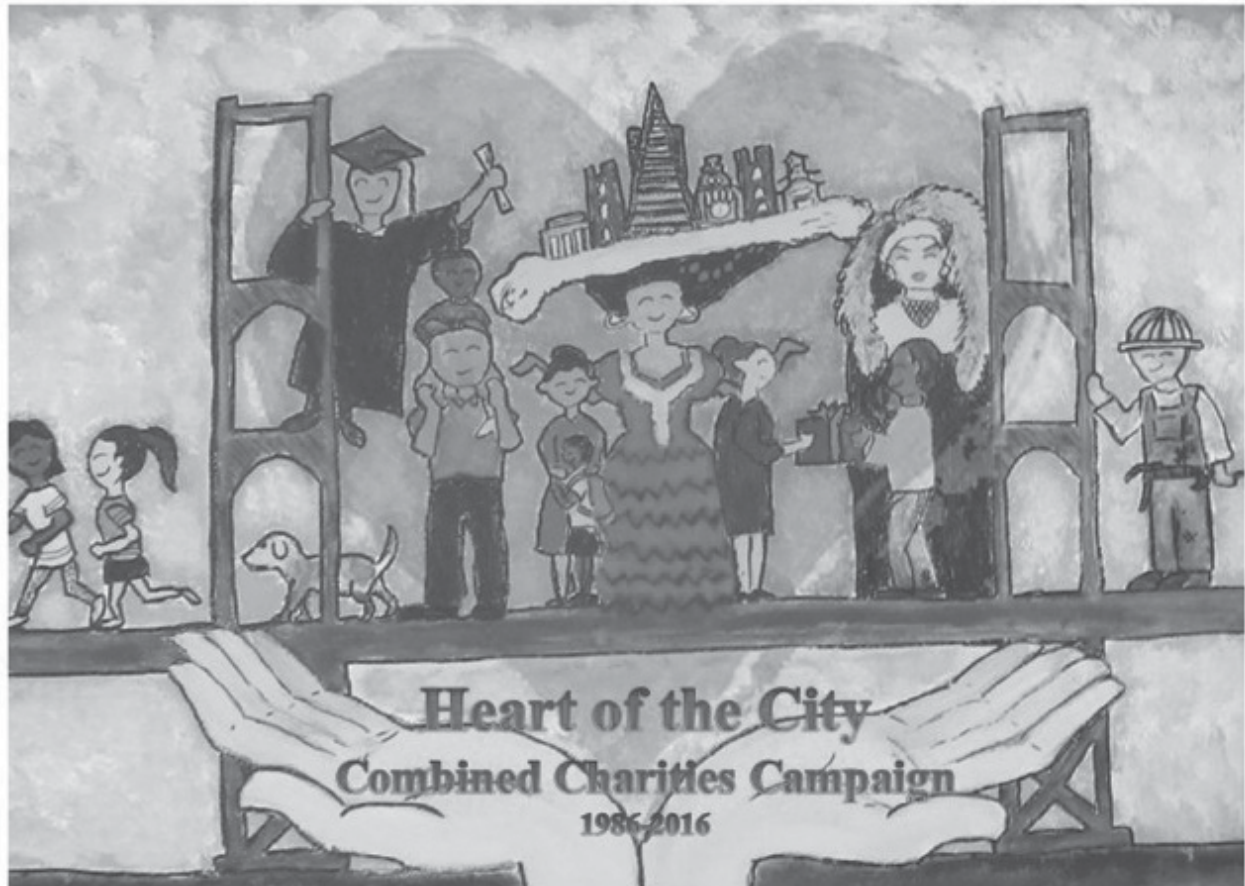

The Asian Pacific Fund is a non-profit foundation dedicated to strengthening the Asian and Pacific Islander (API) community in the Bay Area. Since 1993, we have been committed to increasing philanthropy and supporting organizations that provide vital services to those who need it the most. We also give visibility to the pressing needs of our community, many of which are hidden from view. For example:

- Asians now make up the largest ethnic group living in poverty in San Francisco.
- APIs have the highest percentage of households living in subsidized housing in San Francisco (33 percent) and Santa Clara (39 percent).
- One in 7 disconnected youth in the Bay Area (i.e. youth who are neither in school nor working) are Asian.

Asian and Pacific Islanders make up over 26 percent of the Bay Area population. Many are newer immigrants and refugees who face poverty, isolation, limited access to healthcare and other challenges. Despite the high level of need that exists within our community, non-profits who serve the API community in the Bay Area receive less than 1 percent of foundation funding.

By supporting the Asian Pacific Fund, or one of our affiliates, you will be making an investment to help address these needs and beyond for our most vulnerable Asian and Pacific Islander community members.

We all want the same things in life: safety and security, to raise healthy families, to pursue good lives and meaningful careers—and to pass those opportunities on to future generations.

But 1 in 4 Bay Area residents struggle to access basic needs, education, job training and the resources they need just to get by. Working across eight Bay Area counties - Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, and Solano - United Way Bay Area is committed to breaking the cycle of poverty for all residents and to building a stronger community with the help of our nonprofit, corporate, and public sector partners, and a network of thousands of donors like you.

Our **SparkPoint program** provides free one-on-one financial coaching on issues from repairing credit to job training to business skills and a personalized financial plan—all in one location. Last year, 13 SparkPoint centers throughout the Bay Area helped 5,504 individuals to save money, manage their debt, and repair and build their credit.

**211** operates 24 hours a day, in more than 150 languages. Last year, the helpline answered 191,627 calls for critical needs like emergency housing, food pantry access and utility payment assistance as well as help with elder care, child care and more.

Our **Earn It! Keep It! Save It!** program provides free tax preparation for low- and moderate-income households and puts millions of dollars back into the local economy. In 2016, more than 3,500 EKS volunteers helped return more than \$83 million in tax refunds back into the pockets of 80,970 residents.

Innovative jobs programs like **MatchBridge** help young adults identify their interests, stay engaged in school and find a path to good jobs and good pay. Last year, 7,937 young people were connected with jobs and internships through our partnership with the Mayor's Office on San Francisco Youth Jobs+.
