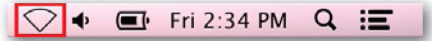




Wi-Fi guide for MAC

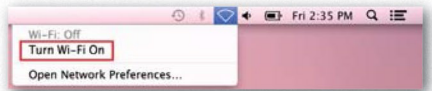
Locate the wireless connection icon found in the top right bar on your screen.



Click on the icon to open your connections.

If you have disabled Wi-Fi, click the option "Turn Wi-Fi on".

Locate "#SFWiFi" and select this network.

The San Francisco FREE WIFI web page opens. From this page, you can access the service terms and conditions.



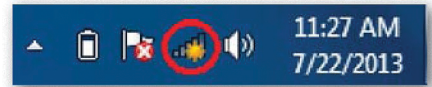

- 1 Locate the wireless connection icon found in the bottom rightbar on your screen.

- 2 Available networks within range of your PC are displayed.

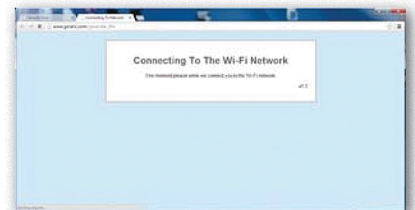


- 3 Select “#SFWiFi” and click connect.
