Domestic Violence is an incident and/or pattern of behavior used . . . often including the threat or use of violence or coercion.

A. Definitions

- 1. Domestic violence occurs:
- 2. Domestic violence includes
 - a. Attempting to cause
 - b. Making explicit threats
 - c. Forcing a family

B. Protocols

- 1. Self-disclosure of Domestic Violence
- 2. When a Domestic Violence Incident Occurs
 - a. If a domestic violence incident occurs
 - b. The victim may remain in the shelter
 - c. If the family chooses not to exercise this option, they must exit the

shelter. Thefamily will also be ineligible to stay in DSHHS-funded shelters for 10days after date of incident.

- 3. Exits From Family Shelters
 - a. Where the family chooses to exit, family shelter staff will provide
 - b. For families placed out of San Francisco County . . . (school, appointments, legal, employment) for ten days.

c. Shelter providers shall consider extenuating circumstances that affect the victim's safety, including verification of a perpetrator's incarceration with a law enforcement agency where warranted in individual cases.

- 4. Procedures to Contact Law Enforcement Agencies for the Provision of
 - a. Compass Connecting Point and family shelters must report a domestic

5. Shelter Grievance Policy

a. Except in extenuating circumstances (see #3c above), victims who refuse to seek an EPO or Civil Restraining Order . . . in accordance with the Shelter Grievance Policy and be provided a copy of the grievance and appeal procedures.

- 6. Lethality Assessment Upon Intake to Evaluate All Families for Risk of Domestic Violence
- 7. Staff Training on Domestic Violence and Other Crisis Situations

a. All family shelter provider staff will continue to receive training in crisis intervention, de-escalation, the dynamics of Domestic Violence relationships and how to support families experiencing domestic violence. Family shelters are required to submit a list of relevant staff trainings, and attendees, that have been completed by shelter staff to DSHHS on a semiannual basis.
