7. **File No. 22020**: Complaint filed by Sergei Severinov against the Police Department for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21(c), by failing to respond to a public records request in a timely and/or complete manner.

Sergi Severinov (Petitioner) provided a summary of the complaint and requested the Committee to find a violation. Mr. Severinov stated that between July 14 and July 17, 2023 he received records from the police department which included emails not drafted by him. Mr. Severinov concluded that those email records had never before been disclosed to him.

Lt. William Toomey (Police Department) (Respondent), was not present and did not inform the SOTF Administrator of their absence.

A question and answer period occurred. The parties were provided an opportunity for rebuttals.

Action: Moved by Chair LaHood, seconded by Member Pilpel, to continue the matter to the December 19, 2023 Compliance and Amendments Committee meeting and requested the SOTF Administrator confirm the Respodent's attendance at the meeting.

8. **File No. 23030** Complaint filed by Michael Turon against the Assessor-Recorder's Office for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.25 by failing to respond to an Immediate Disclosure Request in a timely and/or complete manner; 67.25; by failing to keep withholding to a minimum; CPRA 6253(b) by failing to provide "exact copies of records; CPRA 6253.9 by failing to provide the "electronic format in which you hold the information; CPRA 6254.5 by withholding exemptions already waived by providing the records to the public before this request.

Michael Turon (Petitioner) was not present for the hearing and did not notify the SOTF Administrator of their absence.

Derek Ah Nin (Assessor-Recorder's Office) (Respondent) was present.

Action: Moved by Chair LaHood, seconded by Member Wolfe, to continue the matter to the Call of the Chair.

9. **File No. 23085**: Complaint filed by Mike Spencer against the District Attorney for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21, by failing to respond to a records request in a timely and/or complete manner.

Mike Spencer (Petitioner) provided a summary of the complaint and requested the Committee to find a violation. Mr. Spencer stated that he is requesting records regarding the Gary Murphy murder of June 12, 1998 and has received nothing. Nikki Moore, (District Attorney's Office) (Respondent), provided a summary of the department's position. Ms. Moore referred to the response letter provided which lays out the department's timeliness violation and concludes that after conducting a search for the requested records, the District Attorney's Office was unable to locate them.

A question and answer period occurred. The parties were provided an opportunity for rebuttals.

Action: Moved by Member Pilpel, seconded by Member Wolfe, to find that the SOTF has jurisdiction, that the requested records are public and referred the matter to the SOTF for hearing with no recommendation. The Committee requested that the SOTF Deputy City Attorney provide confidential advice to the SOTF regarding the District Attorney's position prior to hearing the matter at the full SOTF>. 10. **File No. 23086:** Complaint filed by Mike Spencer against the Police Department for allegedly violating Administrative Code (Sunshine Ordinance), Section(s) 67.21, by failing to respond to a records request in a timely and/or complete manner.

Mike Spencer (Petitioner) provided a summary of the complaint and requested the Committee to find a violation. Mr. Spencer stated that he is requesting records regarding the Gary Murphy murder of June 12, 1998. Mr. Spencer stated that he received an incident report from 2020 and the prosecution memo written by a retired detective.

Lt. William Toomey (Police Department) (Respondent), was not present for the hearing and did not notify the SOTF Administrator of their absence.

A question and answer period occurred. The parties were provided an opportunity for rebuttals.

Action: Moved by Member Wolfe, seconded by Member Pilpel, to find that the SOTF has jurisdiction, find that the requested records are public and referred the matter to the SOTF for a hearing with no recommendation.
