b. BOS File No. 230332 - Hearing - Human Trafficking in San Francisco 2021 Report

YC Staff gave an update on the incident about the Dolores Hillbomb. Commissioner Listana and Vice Chair Barker Plummer gave an overview of the incident from different perspectives.

TJ committee members agreed to write a statement and inquire information regarding arrest of youth in the hill bomb. They wanted to address the way some of the youth acted during the incident and how SFPD used force on youth who were bystanders.

Letters to send to Rec and Park, SFMTA, SFPD, and others involved in the decision making on the arrests. Tj to also gather feedback from the youth impacted by the event.
