6	UCSF announced sudden plans to close New Generations, one of the few clinics serving teens in the
7	Mission, Bayview, Excelsior, and Visitacion Valley communities, which has the potential to leave
8	young women and men of color without needed reproductive health education and access to birth
9	control, pregnancy testing, and testing for sexually transmitted infections. The clinic served as a
10	primary referral site for school nurses for students in need of reproductive health services and has
11	been a place that youth felt most comfortable going for confidential services because the clinic only
12	serves youth. The clinic is slated to be closed by in Summer 2016.
13	
14	The Youth Commission urges the Board of Supervisors to form a youth-inclusive work group with
15	afterschool meetings to plan for ways to connect teens to services without interruption in their
16	reproductive health services, as well as review the needs of San Francisco teens in Southeast
17	neighborhoods for reproductive health services in a confidential youth-oriented environment.
