




Of 2,054 Reports Submitted In FY 2011-12, 94% Were Submitted Two or More Days Before Court Date

Number of PSIs Ordered Has Decreased 47% Since 2008




^{* 2012} Number of PSIs ordered is annualized based on PSIs ordered from January – June 2012 (814).


