**NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A GRANT**

The protest must be signed by an individual authorized to represent the respondent, and must cite the law, rule, local ordinance, procedure or NOFA provision on which the protest is based. In addition, the protestor must specify facts and evidence sufficient for the City to determine the validity of the protest.
