

RFQ#APD2022-02 Sex Offender Containment Model Treatment Services Questions and Answers

1) Do treatment services have to occur within the confines of the city of San Francisco?

SFAPD prefers that services occur within the City & County of San Francisco, as the majority of SFAPD clients reside in San Francisco and may not be able to travel outside of it for different reasons. It is also possible to provide services outside of San Francisco City and County limits; please explain if this applies to your agency in your Proposal.
