2. *Action. Motion to recommend for adoption the following criteria changes made at the January 21, 2014 Criteria meeting (additions are underline bold; deletions are *italics*):*

Leathercraft (Including Belts, Bags, Accessories and Soft Clothing)

All tooling must be done by hand. No machine design work, or commercially "rolled" or "clicker" is allowed. Sewing machine applied designs are allowed. No belt buckle may be sold separately unless it is made by the

craftsperson. ~~A commercially manufactured buckle must be subordinate to the leatherwork. A commercially manufactured belt buckle may be permissible as attached to a belt created by the artist when the buckle has been determined to be an integral part of or ^{(a) (b)} subordinate to the total design of the belt.~~ Buckles and Belts: No commercially manufactured buckle may be displayed without being functionally attached to a certified belt.

2A. Committee discussion re: Belts, Buckles and proportion of belt elements.

2B. Kye Rorie, St. Artist, shared Belt/Buckle affixing elements w/ committee. Mr. Rorie also explained the mechanics of display, costs inherent in making belts

2C. Susan Tibbon made a motion to propose language as noted above, and below (a) + (b).

a.) is no wider than twice the width of the belt.

b.) one foot of the belt (not including the buckle) is displayed.

5b.) Millinery A hat body must be significantly altered in form by the artist.

5c.) Miscellaneous Items
Any craft which takes a material and changes it into an entirely different shape, design, form or function is acceptable as a handcraft. Any purchased kit is not acceptable.

5d.) Musical Instruments must be handmade or significantly altered by the artist.

5e.) Painting and Drawing All works are acceptable, as long as the artist is the maker. For reproductions of artists own work, see criteria for printmaking.

5f.) Papermaking. Handmade paper is acceptable if the artist works from the raw materials to the final product.
