Cassette Tapes (also CDs/DVDs):

Cassette Tapes (also CDs/DVDs):

In its examination, the Advisory Committee shall listen to the tape (or CD/DVD) for which the artist seeks certification and shall hear and view the live performance. A copy of the artist's tape shall be given to the Street Artists Program and shall be part of the artist's file. The artist's tape must be copyrighted with the Copyright Office, Library of Congress, and a photocopy of the copyright form(s) shall be given to the Street Artists Program and shall be part of the artist's file. The artist/performer of the tape shall not have to be the author of the performance. Other artist/performers involved in the recorded performance may be eligible for certification to sell the tape under the following conditions: (a) the performer(s) must apply for certification as family unit members with the primary artist of the tape. ("Family Unit": two or more persons jointly engaged in the creation or production of an art or craft item, no one of whom stands in an employer-employee relationship to any of the other members thereof): (b) a technician involved in the recording of the performance may be considered as a "family unit" member if the technician uses the technology as an instrument in the performance.
