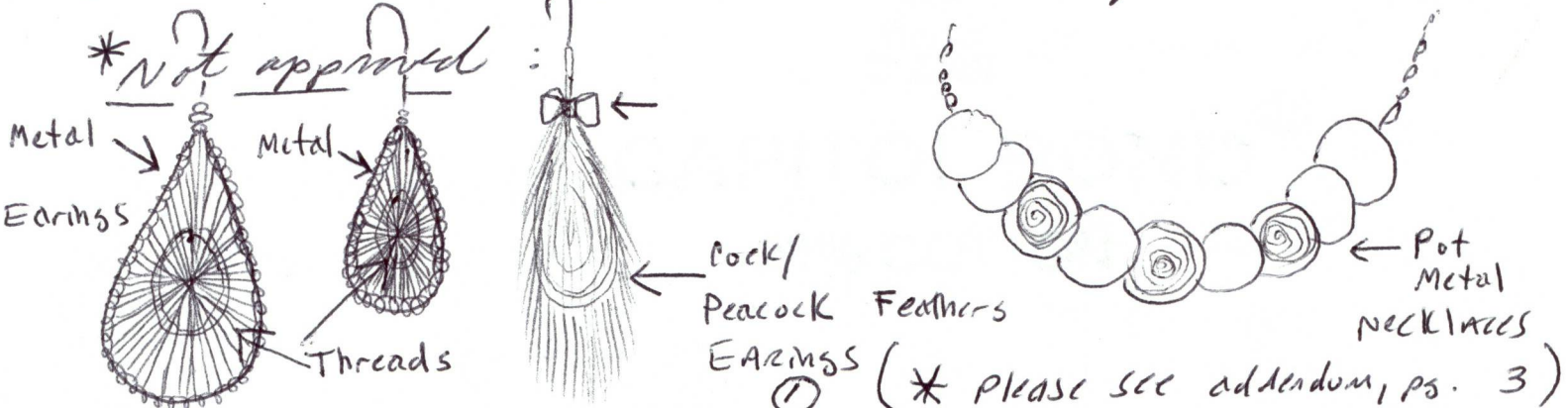

Addendum: TO screening of Artist Mame Fama Thiam

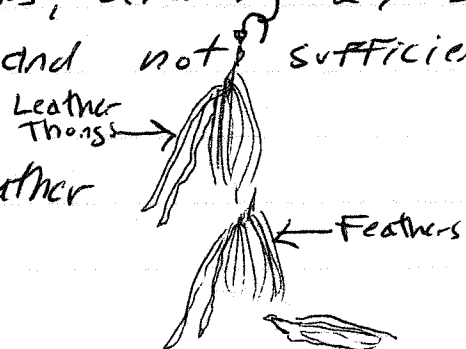
Public Comment: Paula Datesh, MS. Datesh shared w/ committee members that artist Thiam displays large quantities of costume jewelry which may come from wholesale entities in New York and/or Los Angeles.

Artist Thiam shared w/ committee members that Public Comment was a result of a personal vendetta and that work displayed was indeed artist created.

Committee members observed that Artist Thiam presented three receipts dated 19 and 4 September. Receipts did not reflect artist's considerable stock. Receipts reflected leather bracelets which given receipt notation appeared to be commercial items.

Artist Thiam was unable / unwilling to create unique items from raw stock, as raw materials presented did not match finished items. What finished items that were presented (please see drawings, minutes, screening 27 Sept '12) were commercial in nature and not sufficiently transformed by artist.

Triple Feather / leather earrings were approved.
