Public Comment August 29, 2013 Board of Craftsmen Examiners:

I won a hearing before the Board of Permits and Appeals on July 15, 2013. Two weeks ago, I had a meeting with Rebecca Krell. I asked for a letter from the San Francisco Arts Commission stating their position on this Appeal. To date, I have not received this letter. I sent a few emails to Krell which were unanswered.

Howard Lazar filed a concurrent civil case which was dismissed for lack of service and evidence. Clearly, Lazar likes to invent situations which have not taken place.
