The project, located within the San Francisco Botanical Garden at Strybing Arboretum, includes demolition of an existing 4,642 sf greenhouse, associated pavement and ancillary structures, and construction of a new 9,830 sf nursery facility. The new facility will include a greenhouse, shadehouse, headhouse, support space, outdoor nursery space, and an outdoor learning court. Total project site is ~2.5 acres. The project will be funded by the San Francisco Botanical Garden Society and will be given as a gift in place to the City & County of San Francisco upon completion.
