In compliance with the City of Colma Planning Design Standards, all site, building and landscape design elements should be in a Spanish/Mediterranean revival style. The site is on a narrow PUC's right-of-way behind the Kohl's Department store and about 10' below the adjacent Serramonte Boulevard. The building have incorporated a simple massing highlighted with a tower structure facing Serramonte Blvd. The tower signifies the building presence and also helps to screen the roof top utilities from the public view. Other building elements incorporated in the design include a pitched terra-cotta tile roof with a stucco wall finish. All openings are recessed to convey the thickness of the masonry
