



FY13 INDIVIDUAL ARTIST COMMISSIONS (IAC)

- ◆ IAC funds artists with projects that generate new creative work with a public presentation.
- ◆ Alternate disciplines each year. FY12 funded dance, music, and theater. FY13 funds visual, literary and media arts.
- ♦ 3 separate discipline-based panels with 3-4 panelists each.
- ◆ Criteria for Evaluation: Artistic Excellence, Project Merit, Artist's History and/or Promise, and Public Benefit




Artists of Color



- 38% of the Applicant Pool identify as Artists of Color
- 51% of the Grantee Pool identify as Artists of Color

IAC Artist of Color Demographics: Grantee vs Applicant




Grantee Ethnic Breakdown:

ASIAN AMERICAN includes Filipino, Singaporean, South Asian, Palestinian, Iranian, Vietnamese, Chinese

LATINO includes Mexican, Columbian BI/MULTI-RACIAL includes Asian, Native American

IAC Demographics: Grantee vs Applicant



Grantee Pool:

- 48 out of 71 applicants identify as Women $\sim 68\%$
- 21 out of 71 applicants identify as LGBTQ ~ 30%
- 1 out of 3 applicants identify as Disabled ~ 33%

Majority of IACs must fund

◆ 32 out of 35 recommended applicants are from historically underserved communities named in the Cultural Equity Endowment Fund legislation: African American, Asian American, disabled, Latino, lesbian and gay, Native American, Pacific Islander, and women.
