First Meeting of the Planning Committee for the SF Arts Commission and SF SAP - 80th & 40th Anniversary in 2012

Held on Friday 05/20/11 at Justin Herman Plaza. Meeting called for 10:00 am (on two email tree lists for the past week and a half)

Present: ED Howard Lazar, Liason Committee member Tad Sky, volunteers Lynn Vandenberg and John Tunui

Start time: 10:10 am

1. AGENDA: a) Set a date in 2012, b) Layout of plaza

2. a). A one day event was decided upon in early summer 2012. Two dates suggested were: Saturday June 9th and Saturday June 30th 2012. Two dates were suggested so that when Howard negotiates with Boston Properties and Rec. & Park, we would have a back up date, in case one those dates was already booked.

b). It was decided that we would utilize the stage area and lower plaza as an add on to our regular Saturday market where by our display areas could spread to the lower plaza.

3. Additional discussion points.

(i) Brief schedule was proposed: 10:00am to 11:45 am - light music
 Noon - speakers; Howard Lazar, Luis, Supervisors, Mayor etc.
 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm - light music

(ii) Musicians in the SAP would be asked to perform, as well as friends of the SAP (non paying)

(iii) Education, through demonstration of crafts in order to garner more funding for this event.

(iv) A video of our 40th and 80th years to play continuously at the plaza.

(v) Banners to hang from lamp posts around plaza starting in January 2012.

(vi) We would also allow the food carts who may still be in the plaza by then, such as the sushi cart. We will not recruit any other food vendors. Food vendors will feature prominently eg near stage and they still pay Rec. & Park/Boston Properties regular fees. (We can not collect rent).

(vii) Funding to come from The Arts Commission Administration Fund. No extra monies can be charged to the license fees for the anniversary celebrations.
