Hi Tad, Maria and John,

Please see the attached BART spaces proposal that I started making. I wanted to get your edits/opinions before I kept going.

A few questions to consider:

1. Where exactly are the spaces? I used the previous proposal as a guide with the help of Google Maps. Do they line up with the cross walk as I've put them in?
2. Should the muni platform be shown?
3. Is there any space between the toilet and space B7/B8?
4. What are the spaces between the groups of spaces themselves (ex: the space between B1A and B1B, space between B1 and B2, etc).
5. What's the distance between the spaces and the hotel?
6. What's the distance between the spaces and the street?
7. What is the distance of the 'openings' that you've marked on your map (between B1B and B1; between B10 and B11)?
8. Are there any fire hydrants or poles that need to be inserted?

Note – I haven't marked the dimensions of the spaces yet because I wanted to figure out where exactly to place them first.

Thanks for your help! Ideally we would love to get this done asap so we have it in time for the February SAPC meeting.

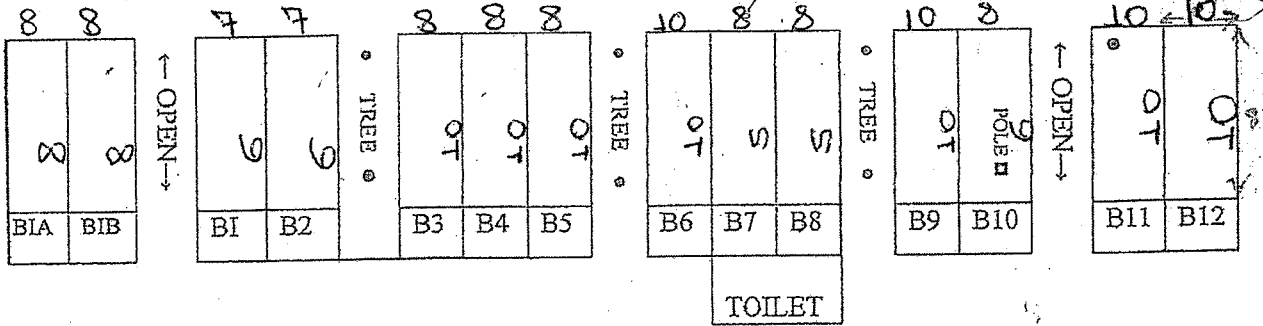

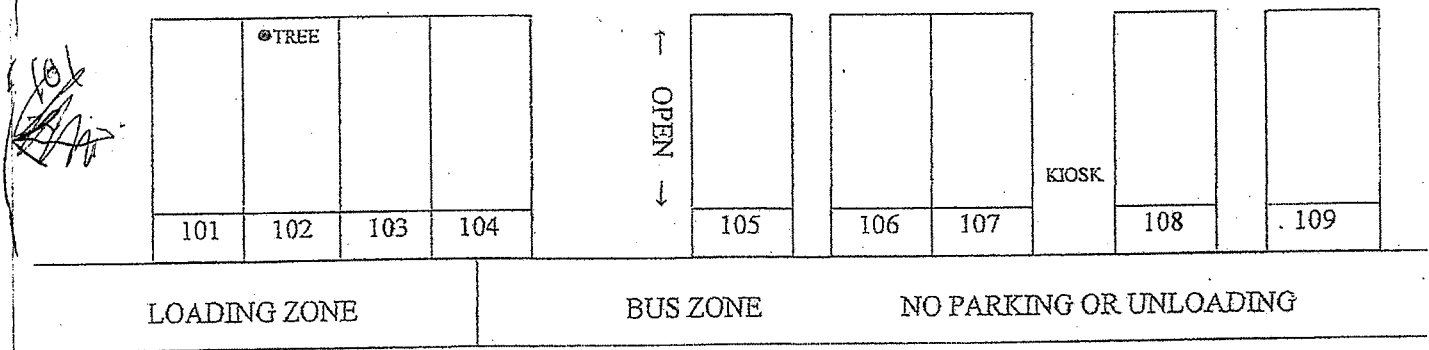

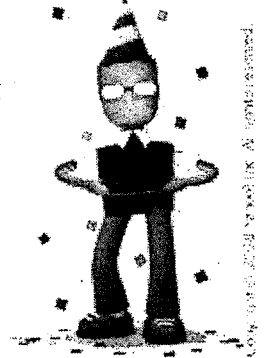
Tad, please convey our thanks to Maria. Okay, so we'll request SIX (6) new spaces. Sounds great.

Hello, Tad and Maria,

Yes, definitely we will place this on the February 22<sup>nd</sup> agenda.

Please confirm my understanding of this proposal. My understanding is that in actuality we would be proposing legislation for four (4) new spaces, because there are already eight (8) spaces known as the "BART/DRUMM spaces" that were designated a long time ago for artists to sell around the BART wall; but since obstructions by the wall have prevented selling there, the artists have already situated the eight (8) spaces east of the BART wall (and the shoeshine stand) and parallel to the curb of Market Street. We would now be asking for four (4) additional spaces to be in line with the eight (8) spaces.

Furthermore, our legislation would provide for the four (4) spaces and the existing eight (8) spaces to be exempt from the 3' x 4' regulations because the spaces would range from 5' x 8', 6' x 7', to 10' x 10'.

Am I correct in all this?

Thank you for your excellent drawing of the spaces. Would you please make a birds-eye view drawing of the 12 spaces in relation to the entire Market Street sidewalk from Drumm to Steuart streets, showing the hotel, the cafes, and the existing "Café Spaces"?

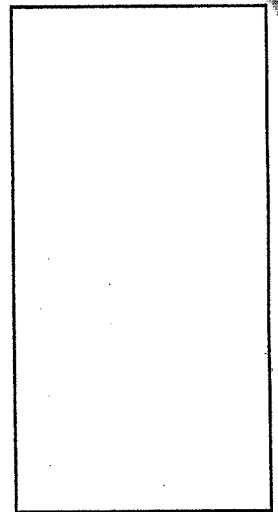

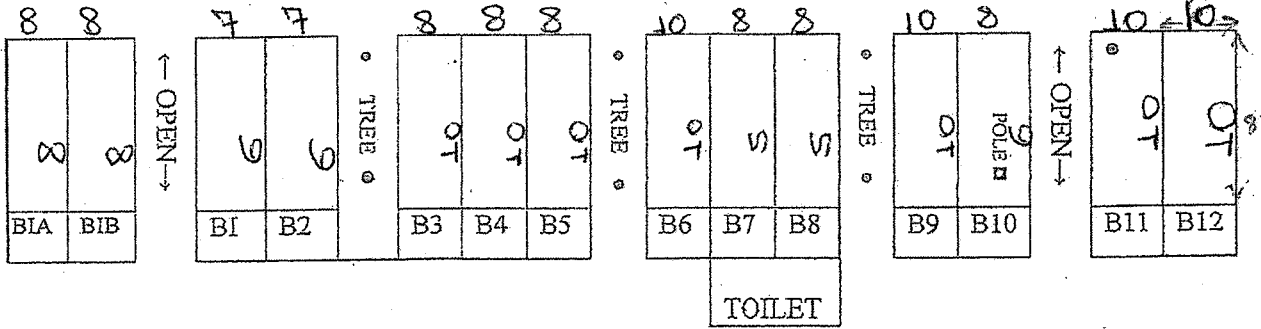

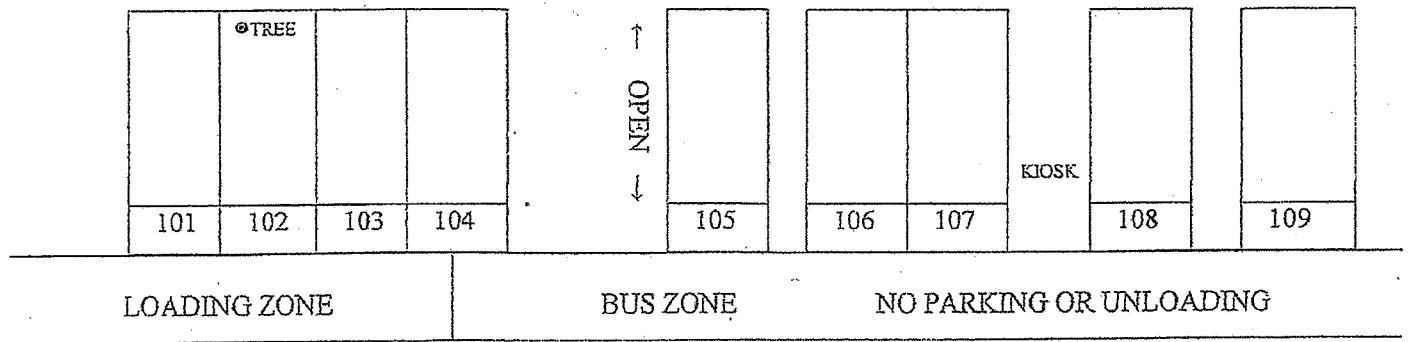
