

To be read out loud at the public comment section of the November 14, 2012 Street Artist meeting of the San Francisco Arts Commission:

These meetings have not been run in accordance with the law for years. Howard Lazar is responsible for allowing one person-Mike Addario to monopolize discussion; speak for over one hour under public comment and to slander and personally attack people with no evidence.

In 2008, retired SFPD Inspector Rich Leon was slandered by Addario. Leon told Addario in the hallway in City Hall to stop this. He put in a call to Lazar that was not returned. I have had to change my name as this slander posted on the Internet. My family was harassed by Addario and it is time for it to stop. The few times I was able to get Lazar on the phone about this, he wanted to fill me in the on the on-going antics of Addario. Lazar has never been one to admit responsibility for a problem (his inability to run the Street Artist meetings in accordance with the law) or seek to solve an issue he created.

Lazar was again at fault in 2008, when he tells me to, "call him when there is a quorum for a meeting". When I called 415-252-2583 (Lazar's phone) a female answered. She said things like, "Paula, you are going to jail", or sung gospel music to me. A few months later, I was arrested and told I was stalking someone I do not know-Evelyn Russell. This was at a date and time when I was not even in California. During the 45 days I spent in the SF County Jail-Nick Gregaratos of the SFSD got a letter from Lazar noticing me of the, "phones rolling over". This was **AFTER** the arrest. Russell never came to court and I commuted from the East Coast for 2 year to make court dates. This is Lazar fault. He should be held accountable. There was a 50 yard no contact order which Lazar turned into barring me from City Hall and 25 Van Ness Ave. I find it amazing how he is able to write and interpret local law-at will. I have not received records pertaining to Russell's promotion from a clerk/typist to a Curator I. Amazing how far someone can go in your organization with just an Associates Degree from Vista College in

Berkeley.

From May 2012, I am told I am stalking Brian Smith. I do not know this person. When I ask via email for evidence of this-I get nothing. I get duplicate emails where he copies every employee of your organization and does not answer the question. This is, "sandbagging". He has never responded to Nick Gregaratos, Victor Pacheco or the many lawyers who have called since May 2012.

I have spoken 4 times since May 2012 under public comment. My comments have not been posted and the minutes have not posted in a timely manner. The CD audio copies have gaps in the them. The records I received are incomplete.

In summary, I find the bottom up management of Lazar to be annoying and boring. He is responsible for the majority of the problems in the Street Artist program, never seeks to solve the problems he creates and spends most of his time either covering up, shifting blame or avoiding the issue. Lazar is past the mandatory retirement age and should retire.
