RE: San Francisco General Hospital Acute Care Building Two-Dimensional Artwork Program

At the March 3, 2014 meeting of the full Arts Commission, Resolution # **0303-14-083** was passed approving an honorarium in the amount of \$1,000 to artists selected for the Two-Dimensional Artwork Program at General Hospital Acute Care Building, in return for license to the City to make a reproduction of their artwork for display in public waiting rooms and corridors at the Hospital. Since the approval, it has become a Public Art Program standard to pay \$1,500 per artwork for the license to reproduce. This is consistent with the fees approved by the Commission for artwork reproduction for San Francisco International Airport. In addition, each artist would be reimbursed up to \$400 for expenses related to transporting their original artwork to be scanned and digital scanning services if required for reproductions.
