PROCESS

Round One:

Arts Commission staff presented the qualifications of 17 artists selected from the 2017/18 Prequalified Artist Pool for the Golden Gate Park Tennis Center public art opportunity. "Yes/No" majority votes based on the criteria of Artistic Excellence and Appropriate to Project Goals yielded 9 artists to move to Round Two.

Round Two:

The Artist Selection Panel discussed the qualifications of the semi-finalists and scored each artist on the following criteria (1= low score):

- Artistic Excellence (1-10)
- Appropriate to Project Goals (1-10)

Round Two voting yielded three finalists to recommend to the Arts Commission.

The following artists received the highest scores:

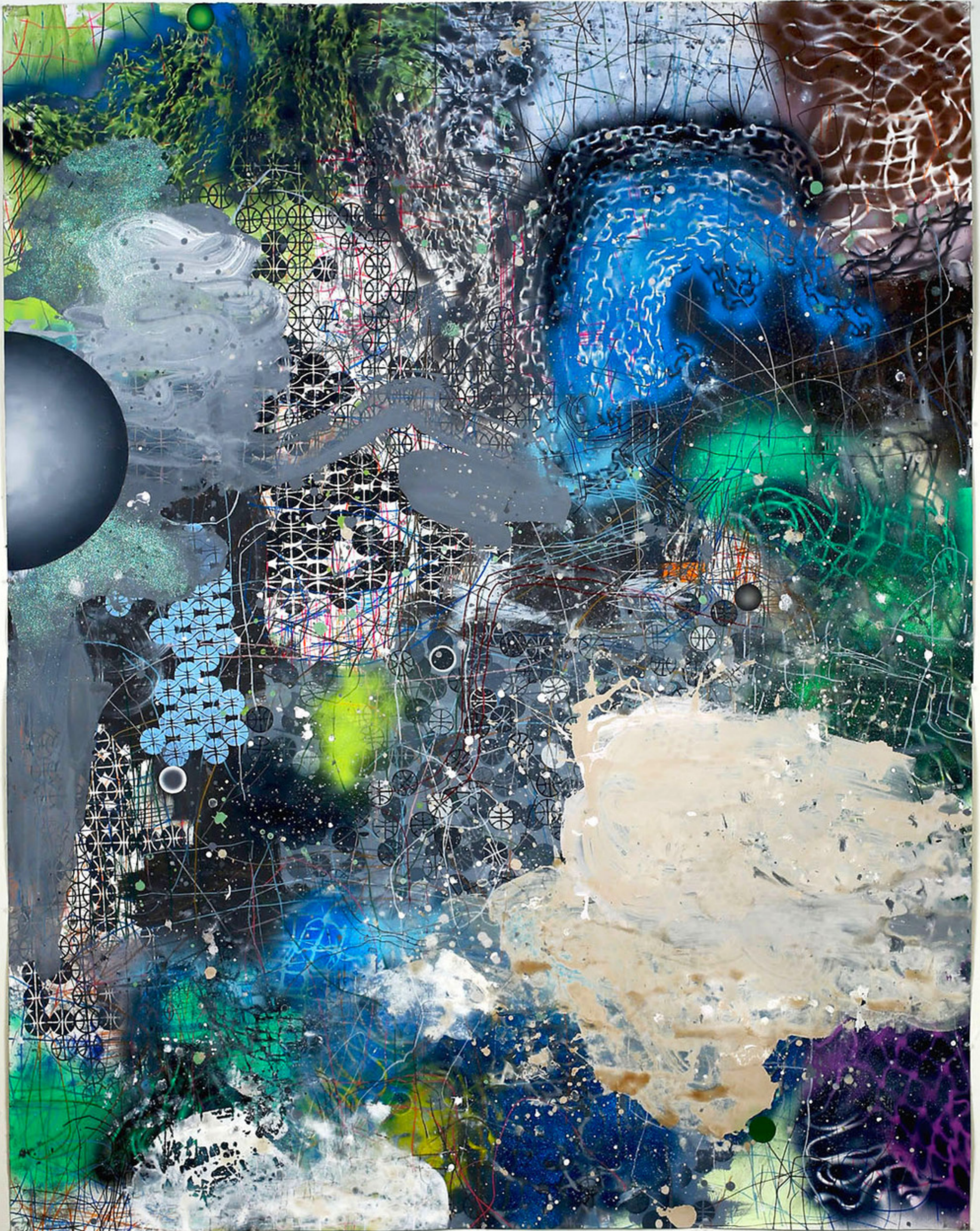



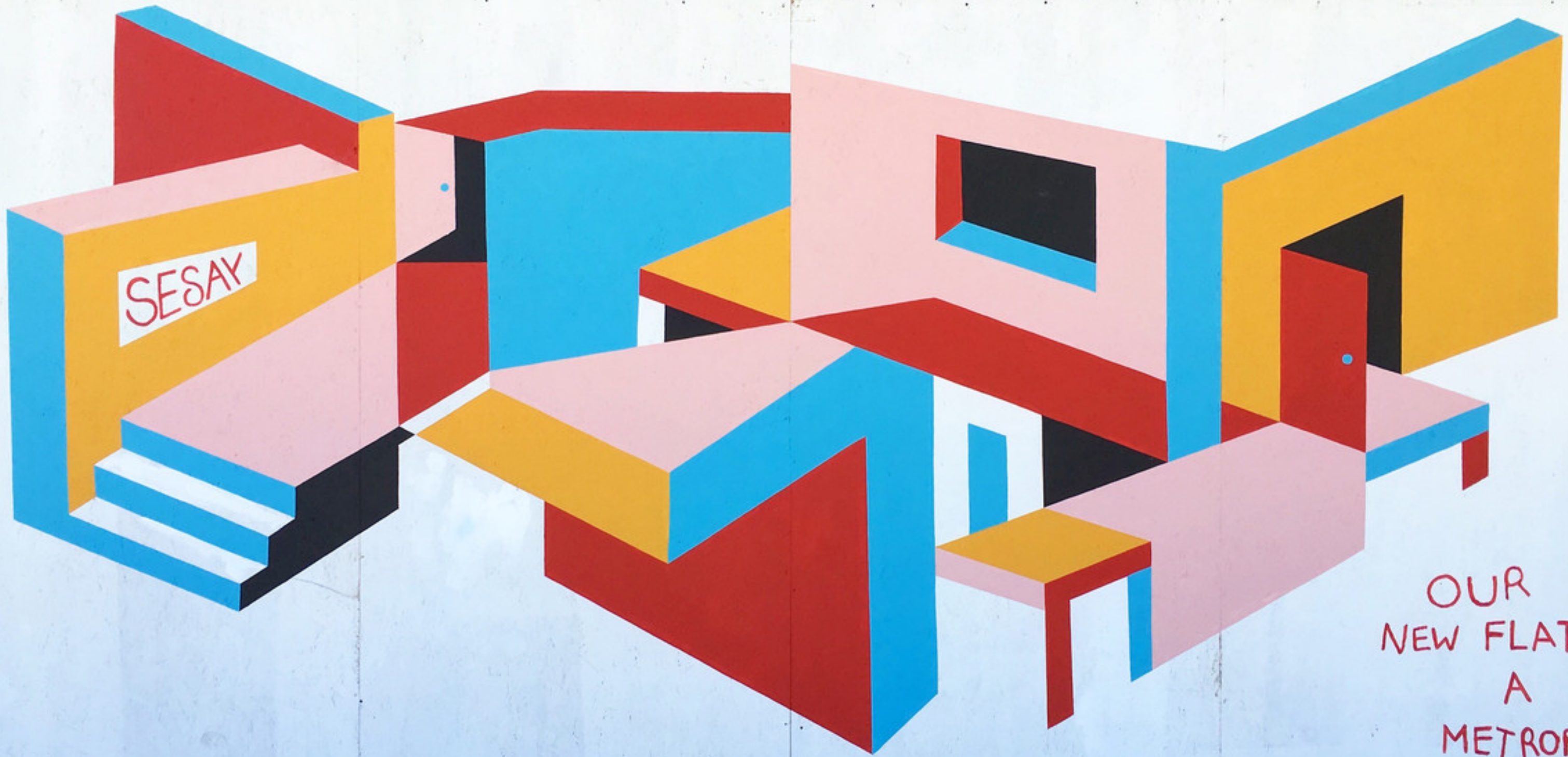
