


# SFO REACH INTERNATIONAL TERMINAL BOARDING AREA G PUBLIC ART PROJECT OUTLINE



## **BACKGROUND**

San Francisco International Airport is planning to renovate and refresh strategic areas of the International Terminal interiors for an improved passenger experience. This work will include enhancements to recompose, ticketing, concessions, concourse lounges and hold rooms.

### **ART OPPORTUNITIES**

The art opportunity for Boarding Area G will be three commissioned sculptures for a new outdoor terrace at the end of Boarding Area G.

## **PROJECT GOAL**

The artwork will enhance the planned spaces and contribute to the quality and diversity of the Airport's existing art collection.

## **PROJECT BUDGET**

The total IT REACH art enrichment allocation is \$1,300,000. The high-level budget breakdown is as follows:

Admin Fee: \$260,000Conservation: \$130,00Contingency: \$91,000

• Architectural Support and Installation: \$200,000

• Selection costs: \$22,000

• BAG Artist Contract: up to \$597,000

#### ARTIST RECRUITMENT APPROACH AND ELIGIBILITY

Arts Commission staff will select a short list of artists from the 2017/2018 Prequalified Artist Pool and the SFO T1 Redevelopment Prequalified Artist Pool.

## **ARTIST SELECTION PROCESS**

The short list of qualified artists will be presented to the SFO Integrated Sculpture Artist Selection Panel consisting of one IT REACH design professional, one Arts Commissioner, two members of the SFO project team(s) and three arts professionals. The panel will identify three finalists who will be invited to develop conceptual site-specific proposals for the BAG terrace artwork. These finalists will be paid an honorarium of \$3,000, exclusive of travel expenses, for development of a proposal. The SFO Integrated Sculpture Artist Selection Panel will reconvene to consider the finalists' proposals in an interview format and will select one artist and an alternate for the project for recommendation to the Arts Commission.
