**PROCESS**

Round One:

Arts Commission staff presented the qualifications of 24 artists selected from the 2015 Moscone Expansion Howard Street and West Bridge RFQ and the 2016 Moscone Expansion West Bridge RFQ for the Moscone Expansion West Bridge public art opportunity. "Yes/No" majority votes based on the criteria of Artistic Excellence and Appropriate to Project Goals yielded 12 artists to move to Round Two.

Round Two:

The Artist Selection Panel discussed the qualifications of the semi-finalists and scored each artist on the following criteria (1= low score):

- Artistic Excellence (1-10)
- Appropriate to Project Goals (1-10)

Round Two voting yielded three finalists and one alternate to recommend to the Arts Commission.
