## VAC Report for Muni Art October 19, 2016 meeting

The second annual Muni Art Project, a collaboration between SF Beautiful and the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA), will showcase artworks from five Bay Area artists within the interior of 100 MUNI buses starting January 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017. This year's theme is "San Francisco Neighborhoods," and the artists chosen are Monica Tiulescu, Lillian Shanahan, Luis Pinto, Counterpoint Studio (Peter Tonningsen and Lisa Levine), and Todd Kurnat.


Of the over 53 applications received, ten artists were chosen to compete for the final five slots by a jury comprised of individuals of the arts community including a member of the San Francisco Arts Commission, local art gallery owner, a working artist, community arts programmer and a curator at a public art cultural center. Decisions were based upon quality of concept, expression of theme, diversity and the likelihood of the artist to be able to deliver the completed work by the November 4th deadline.


