














Schematic of Macrame Pattern





Sky excerpt turned into color swatches



REFERENCES & INSPIRATIONS

"The world is blue at edges and in its depths. This blue is the light that got lost. Light at the blue end of the spectrum does not travel the whole distance from the sun to us. 


