PROCESS

Round One:

Arts Commission staff presented the qualifications of 20 artists selected from the 49 South Van Ness Public Art Project Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the 49 South Van Ness Interior Prefunction Gallery Wall public art opportunity. "Yes/No" majority votes based on the criteria of Artistic Excellence and Appropriate to Project Goals yielded 13 artists to move to Round Two.

Round Two:

The Artist Selection Panel discussed the qualifications of the semi-finalists and scored each artist on the following criteria (1= low score):

- Artistic Excellence (1-10)
- Appropriate to Project Goals (1-10)

Round Two voting yielded three finalists to recommend to the Arts Commission.

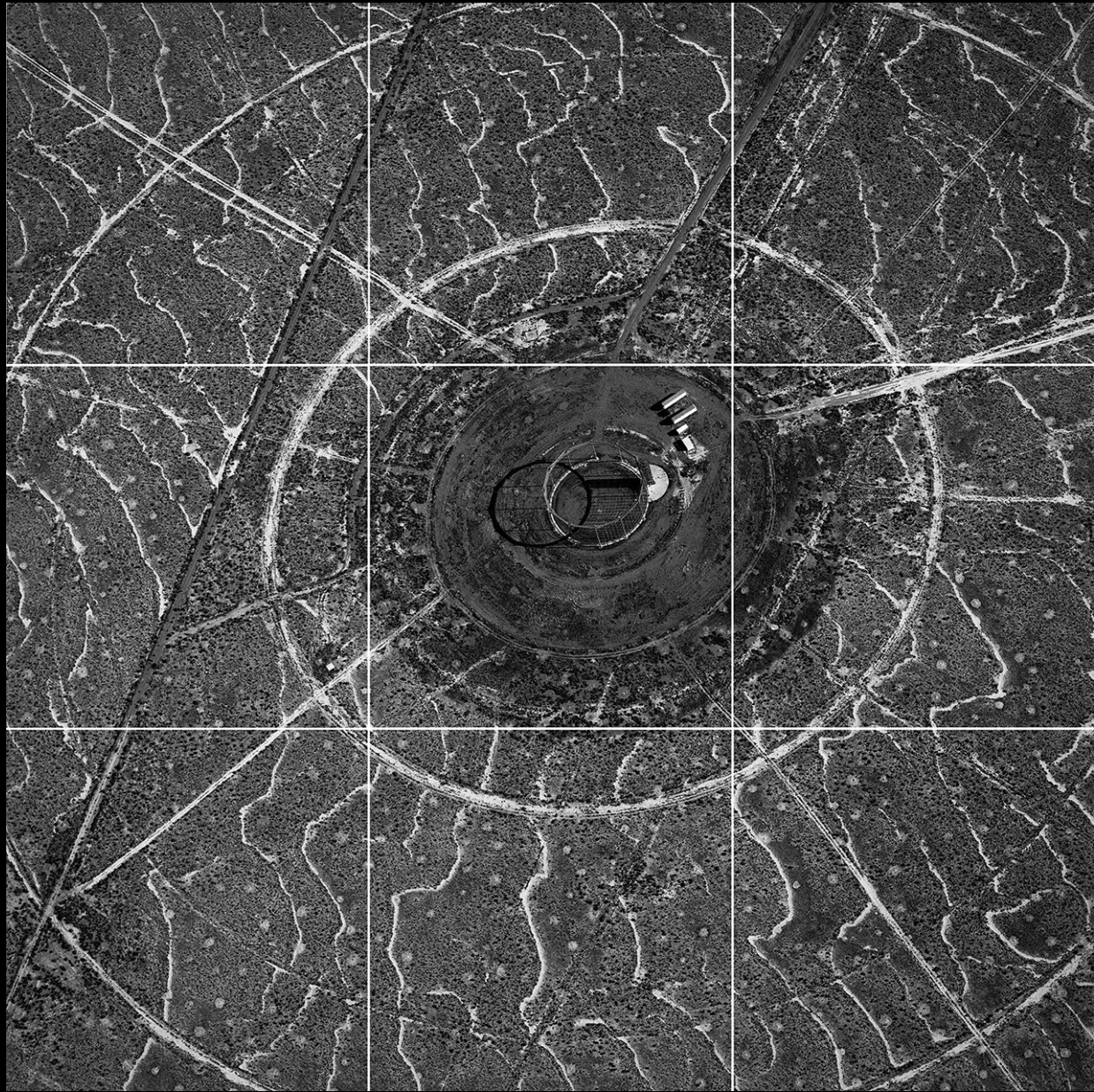

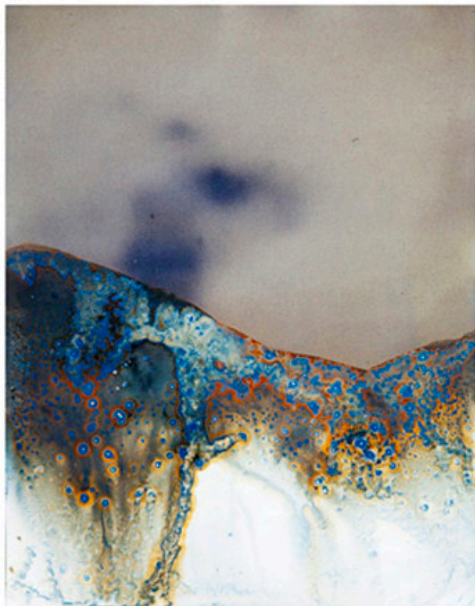
