Project Description:

Verizon Wireless proposes to install a facility at the commercial office building at 1 South Van Ness Avenue. The site has been designed to be visually unobtrusive. The facility will consist of fifteen panel antennas in five sectors, and associated RRUs, cabling, and equipment cabinets. The equipment cabinets will be inside the existing rooftop penthouse. The fifteen antennas and associated RRUs will be on the roof of the building. They will be installed within penthouse extensions designed to blend with the existing building and will be completely screened from view.
