REVIEW OF ALLEGED STREET ARTIST VIOLATION/AUTHORIZATION OF CERTIFICATION

On June 14, 2017, I, Howard Lazar, Program Director of the Street Artists Program met with Street Artist **Jeffrey Potter** to review the report filed with the Arts Commission alleging that the above Street Artist violated the Street Artist Ordinance on the following dates and in the following manner:

May 20, 2017, Market Street near Steuart Street: Improper Conduct of Business: physically assaulting a street artist (Jessica Harrigfeld) en route to street artist business location

The above Street Artist states that from now on he will abide by all of the regulations of the Street Artist Ordinance, the rules of the Arts Commission's lottery space-assignment system, and the rules and policies of the Arts Commission's Street Artists Program, and will not conduct business in a disorderly, improper or hazardous manner.

Furthermore, the above Street Artist states that he fully understands the provisions of the Street Artists Ordinance pertinent to his certification and conduct as a Street Artist.

With the assurance, I, on behalf of the Executive Director (Director of Cultural Affairs) of the Arts Commission, do hereby authorize the issuance of a certificate to the above Street Artist.
